**YESTERDAY:** The Curve had their six-game winning streak snapped with a 4-1 loss to the Baysox. Bowie scored all four of its runs in the first inning against **Tyler Eppler**, with solo home runs by Julio Borbon and Caleb Joseph and back-to-back RBI doubles by Joey Terdoslavich and Austin Wynns. The Curve got on the board with an RBI groundout in the top of the seventh by **Edwin Espinal**. Eppler recovered after the first and did not allow another run over his 6.1 innings, but did match a career high with 11 hits allowed. **Josh Smith** pitched 1.0 scoreless inning and **Brett McKinney** recorded two outs in the eighth.

**CURVE VS. BAYSOX:** The Curve wrap up the six-game road trip with the rubber game of the series in Bowie, Md. against the Baysox, the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This weekend's set marks the last of two trips to Bowie this year for the Curve, who took three of four from the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium in late-May. The two teams met in last year's E.L. Western Division Series, which the eventual E.L. champion Baysox won, 3-1. The Curve have won seven of their last nine games. The Baysox have lost five of their last eight.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Alex McRae** makes his fourth Double-A start for the Curve. Last time out, he earned his first Double-A win after holding Binghamton to two earned runs in 5.2 innings on Tuesday to open the road trip. In his previous start, he allowed a season-worst eight runs on 11 hits in just 3.2 innings against New Hampshire. He made his Double-A debut on June 10 at Reading and surrendered seven runs on four homers in 3.2 innings. He was promoted on June 10 from A-Adv. Bradenton, where he went 3-4 with a 2.69 ERA in twelve starts. McRae is in his third professional season after being selected in the tenth round in 2014 by the Pirates out of Jacksonville University, where he was a two-way player (starting pitcher, third base, first base, designated hitter).

**FOR BOWIE:** Lefty John Means makes his sixth start for the Baysox and second against Altoona. He faced the Curve on May 28 in Bowie in his Double-A debut and gave up four earned runs in 5.1 innings in the loss. Last time out, he did not receive a decision after allowing four earned runs in 4.2 innings at Erie last Sunday. In nine starts for A-Adv. Frederick, Means went 5-0 with a 1.80 ERA and struck out 54 in 50.0 innings. He threw a seven-inning no-hitter last season on July 31 for Delmarva against Charleston. Means is in his third professional season after being drafted by the Orioles in the 11th round in 2014 out of West Virginia University.

**DUCK HUNT:** The Curve have won six of seven games and currently sit nine games over .500, a half-game back of the division-leading Akron RubberDucks, the closest they have been to the top of the division this season. Over the last seven games, the Curve offense has hit .327 (80/245), scored 37 runs (5.3/game) and hit .356 (26/73) with runners in scoring position. The pitching staff has posted a 2.81 ERA (20 ER/64 IP). Altoona starting pitchers are 5-1 with a 2.98 ERA (14 ER/42.1 IP), while the bullpen has gone 1-0 with a 2.49 ERA (6 ER/21.2 IP).

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Curve are 35-1 this season when leading after seven innings, tied for the best in the Eastern League. Lefty relief pitcher **Jared Lakind** pitched 25.1 consecutive scoreless innings, a new franchise single-season record, but had that streak snapped with two runs allowed on Thursday at Binghamton. It ended a stretch of 17 straight scoreless outings. **Montana DuRapau** sits tied for second in the league in saves with 12 in 13 tries. **Brett McKinney** is 1-1 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER/12.2 IP) in eight June outings with 14 strikeouts.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 44 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Dean Green (41), Jake Fox (39), Quincy Latimore (38) and Steven Moya (35).

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.5, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. New Hampshire (26.0) has fielded the oldest roster. The two youngest players on the current Curve roster are both 21 and are also the two highest-ranked prospects: **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**. No players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30).

**MOVIN' UP:** The Curve have seen five players promoted to Triple-A in 2016, all for the first time in their careers.

On May 16, **Alen Hanson** (2013-14) debuted with the Pirates. **Jameson Taillon** (2012-13) pitched for the Pirates on June 8, while **A.J. Morris** (2014) debuted with the Cincinnati Reds on May 24. **Adrian Sampson** (2014) got his first start for the Seattle Mariners on June 18. **Jacob Stallings** (2012/2015) debuted on June 19 with the Pirates against the Cubs. **Adam Frazier** (2015) singled in his first MLB at-bat in his Pirates debut on June 24.
