YESTERDAY: Clay Holmes sat down the final 14 batters he faced and allowed just one run on two hits in six innings of work while striking out six in the series opener against Binghamton, but Amed Rosario crushed a two-run triple to straight-away center field against Miguel Rosario in the top of the eighth as the B-Mets came from behind to defeat the Curve, 3-2. Erich Weiss went 2-for-4 and scored a run. Reese McGuire and Jose Osuna each had RBI hits.

CURVE VS. B-METS: The Curve continue a seven-game homestand with the second of three games against the Binghamton Mets, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This week's series marks the fourth of five sets between the two teams in 2016. The Curve won two-of-three games in Binghamton in May and swept the B-Mets last week at NYSEG Stadium. Binghamton won two-of-three in Altoona June 3-5. The Curve have won eight of their last eleven games, but fell back into second place after last night's loss coupled with Akron's victory. The B-Mets dropped six straight games from June 17-23, including the sweep by the Curve, but bounced back to sweep Richmond.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Cody Dickson makes his 14th start of the year and third against Binghamton. Last time he $faced\ the\ B-Mets,\ Dickson\ won\ his\ sixth\ game\ of\ the\ season,\ allowing\ four\ runs\ on\ seven\ hits\ in\ six\ innings\ of\ work$ with four walks and four strikeouts. On June 17, Dickson was charged with his first loss since April 21 after allowing three earned runs in 5.1 innings against Hartford. Over six starts from May 7-June 12, Dickson went 5-0 with a 1.13 ERA (5 ER/39.2 IP) and did not allow more than one earned run in a start. In his last nine starts since May 7, Dickson is 6-1 with a 2.16 ERA (12 ER/50.0 IP). Last year, Dickson went 12-7 with a 4.13 ERA in 27 starts for the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders, leading the team in wins for the season. The Arlington, Texas native was selected in the fourth round in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Sam Houston State, where he was teammates for one season with fellow Altoona starter Tyler Eppler. FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Josh Zeid makes his fourth start of the season for the B-Mets after being signed as a free agent on June 8 with the Mets' organization. Last time out, Zeid allowed five runs (four earned) on six hits over five innings against the Curve in picking up his second consecutive loss of the season. On June 17, the Connecticut native dropped his first decision of the year at Trenton, allowing five runs on six hits over 5.2 innings. Zeid's only victory came in his first start on June 11 against Hartford, allowing no runs on four hits and six strikeouts in 6.2 innings against the Yard Goats. A 10th round selection out of Tulane by Philadelphia in 2009, Zeid has logged 48.1 innings (48 games) in the Majors with the Astros.

DUCK HUNT: The Curve have won seven of ten games and currently sit nine games over .500. The Curve sat in first place in the Western Division for the first time this year on Monday, but a loss to the B-Mets and an Akron victory put the RubberDucks back atop the standings. Over the last eight games, the Curve offense has hit .310 (98/316), scored 44 runs (5.5/game) and hit .345 (30/87) with runners in scoring position. The pitching staff has posted a 2.78 ERA (25 ER/81 IP). Altoona starting pitchers are 6-1 with a 2.77 ERA (17 ER/55.1 IP), while the bullpen has gone 1-1 with a 2.70 ERA (8 ER/26.2 IP).

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve are 36-2 this season when leading after seven innings, tied for the second-best in the Eastern League. Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind pitched 25.1 consecutive scoreless innings, a new franchise singleseason record, but had that streak snapped with two runs allowed on Thursday at Binghamton. It ended a stretch of 17 straight scoreless outings. Montana DuRapau sits second in the league in saves with 13 in 14 tries. Brett McKin- \boldsymbol{ney} is 1-1 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER/12.2 IP) in eight June outings with 14 strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 44 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third alltime. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Dean Green (41), Jake Fox (40), Quincy Latimore (38) and Steven Moya (35).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.5, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. New Hampshire (26.0) has fielded the oldest roster. The two youngest players on the current Curve roster are both 21 and are also the two highest-ranked prospects: Reese McGuire and Harold Ramirez. No players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Kevin Newman (11), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and Jose Osuna (30).

MOVIN' UP: The Curve have seen five players promoted to Triple-A in 2016, all for the first time in their careers. RHP John Kuchno was promoted on April 15. RHP Jhondaniel Medina has been promoted to Indianapolis three times this season. RHP Frank Duncan went up on May 10, and after a one-start return to Altoona, went back to Indianapolis on June 3. RHP Dovydas Neverauskas was promoted to Triple-A for the first time on June 16. OF Austin Meadows was sent up to Triple-A on June 18.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Seven Curve alumni have debuted in the Majors this year, raising the franchise's total to 130 MLB players. On May 16, Alen Hanson (2013-14) debuted with the Pirates. Jameson Taillon (2012-13) pitched for the Pirates on June 8, while A.J. Morris (2014) debuted with the Cincinnati Reds on May 24. Adrian Sampson (2014) got his first start for the Seattle Mariners on June 18. **Jacob Stallings** (2012/2015) debuted on June 19 with the Pirates against the Cubs. Adam Frazier (2015) singled in his first MLB at-bat in his Pirates debut on June 24. Chad Kuhl (2015) earned his first MLB win in his debut on June 26 against the Dodgers.

Over six starts from May 7-June 12, Dickson went 5-0 with a 1.13 ERA (5 ER/39.2 IP) and did not allow more than one earned run in a start. In his last seven starts since May 7, Dickson is 5-1 with a 1.60 ERA (8 ER/45.0), the second-lowest ERA among Pittsburgh's MiLB starters in that span (trailing Tyler Glasnow's 1.40 ERA in 10 starts).

Made Double-A debut with the Curve on 4/11 v. AKR...Walked career-worst seven batters and surrendered two home runs in loss...Picked up no-decision after five scoreless innings, allowing just two hits, on 4/16 @ RIC...Matched a career-high with 10 hits allowed in a no-decision on 4/25 v. Two-time letter winner at Sam Houston State...Compiled a 17-11 record in three-year college career...Went 9-5 with a 4.26 ERA and 91 strikeouts in 18 appearances (15 starts) as a junior with the Bearkats in 2013...His 91 strikeouts were the fifth-most in school history in a single season...Ended 2013 season with a 28.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest in school history at the Division I level and second-longest ever...Teammates at Sam Houston State in 2013 with Pirates minor league pitcher and 2015 Curve Tyler Eppler.. Went 4-5 with a 3.25 ERA as a sophomore in 2012...Went 4-1 with a 4.34 ERA and 52 strikeouts over 14 games (11 starts) as a freshman in 2011...Combined to go 15-6 over junior and senior seasons at Mansfield Summit (Texas) HS...Set school record for career wins...
