YESTERDAY: The Curve rallied from a 7-1 deficit to beat the Binghamton Mets, 8-7, on a walk-off double in the ninth by **Jose Osuna**. The Curve started with a rally in a five-run sixth inning. **Harold Ramirez** tripled in two runs, **Barrett Barnes** had an RBI double and **Justin Maffei** singled to bring the Curve within a run. Ramirez brought the tying run across to score in the ninth and scored the winning run. Beck Wheeler was charged with his first blown save of the season, and **Jared Lakind** worked a scoreless inning to improve to 3-0. **Brett McKinney** pitched two scoreless relief innings. **Cody Dickson** allowed five runs over five innings in his start.

CURVE VS. B-METS: The Curve continue the seven-game homestand with the rubber match of three games against the Binghamton Mets, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This week's series marks the fourth of five sets between the two teams in 2016. The Curve won two-of-three games in Binghamton in May and swept the B-Mets last week at NYSEG Stadium. Binghamton won two-of-three in Altoona June 3-5. The Curve have won nine of their last 12 games, and moved back into first place in the Western Division with Akron's loss last night. The B-Mets dropped six straight games from June 17-23, including the sweep by the Curve, but bounced back to sweep Richmond.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty **Brandon Waddell** makes his 10th start of the year for the Curve and 15th overall. Last time out, he set a new career high with eight strikeouts and matched a career best with seven innings pitched, holding the Baysox to three hits and no runs on Friday in Bowie. With that outing, Waddell was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He last faced the B-Mets on June 3 at PNG Field and picked up a win while allowing three earned runs over five innings with six strikeouts. He began the season with A-Adv. Bradenton and went 4-0 in five starts with a 0.93 ERA, picking up a win in each of his last four outings prior to his promotion to Double-A on May 3. Waddell won the Florida State League Player of the Month Award for April and won his first three starts with Altoona, stretching his streak to seven straight starts won overall. He was drafted in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Virginia after leading the Cavaliers to the 2015 College World Series title, pitching seven innings in the championship clincher against Vanderbilt.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-handed knuckleballer Mickey Jannis makes his 15th start of the season for the B-Mets. Last time out, He earned a win against Richmond on Friday after allowing three earned runs in six innings on Friday, his second win of the season and first since his first outing of the year on April 14, snapping a streak of 12 starts without a winning decision and three straight starts with a loss. He made three starts for Binghamton last year and went 0-2 with a 5.54 ERA. Jannis was drafted in the 44th round by Tampa Bay in 2010 but was released after the 2011 seasons and redeveloped himself as a knuckleball pitcher.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve are 36-2 this season when leading after seven innings, tied for the second-best in the Eastern League. Lefty relief pitcher **Jared Lakind** pitched 25.1 consecutive scoreless innings, a new franchise single-season record, but had that streak snapped with two runs allowed on Thursday at Binghamton. It ended a stretch of 17 straight scoreless outings. He has since tossed two scoreless, one-inning outings. **Montana DuRapau** sits second in the league in saves with 13 in 14 tries. **Brett McKinney** is 1-1 with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP) in nine June outings with 15 strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 44 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Dean Green (41), Jake Fox (41), Quincy Latimore (38) and Steven Moya (35).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.5, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. New Hampshire (26.0) has fielded the oldest roster. The two youngest players on the current Curve roster are both 21 and are also the two highest-ranked prospects: **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**. No players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Six players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24) and **Jose Osuna** (30).

MOVIN' UP: The Curve have seen five players promoted to Triple-A in 2016, all for the first time in their careers. RHP **John Kuchno** was promoted on April 15. RHP **Jhondaniel Medina** has been promoted to Indianapolis three times this season. RHP **Frank Duncan** went up on May 10, and after a one-start return to Altoona, went back to Indianapolis on June 3. RHP **Dovydas Neverauskas** was promoted to Triple-A for the first time on June 16. OF **Austin Meadows** was sent up to Triple-A on June 18.
