**YESTERDAY:** The Curve dropped the first game of the road trip, 5-3, to the RubberDucks. Akron took a 1-0 lead in the second, but Altoona answered with a two-out double by **Kevin Newman** in the third, and **Erich Weiss** brought him in with a triple to tie the game. The RubberDucks plated two runs in the third and single runs in the fourth and sixth to pull ahead, 5-1. Weiss brought in a run with a groundout in the seventh and **Jon Schwind** followed with an RBI double to pull the Curve within two runs. **Jhondaniel Medina** worked a scoreless eighth inning out of the pen with two strikeouts. **Brandon Waddell** allowed six walks and four runs in 4.2 innings. Clint Frazier and Claudio Bautista each homered for Akron.

**TONIGHT:** The Curve continue a seven-game road trip with the second of four games against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. In their last meetings, Altoona took two of three games against Akron at Canal Park from May 31-June 2. The Curve hold a half-game lead over the 'Ducks for first place in the E.L. Western Division. Akron leads the season series, 9-5.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Tyler Eppler** makes his 17th start of the year for the Curve. Last time out, he picked up a win over Bowie with six scoreless, four-hit innings and matched a career-best six strikeouts. He last faced Akron at PNG Field on May 25 and was tagged with a loss after allowing a nine earned runs on 10 hits in three innings. He pitched at Canal Park in a no-decision on May 1 and gave up two runs on five hits with season highs in walks (3) and strikeouts (6). The Texas native is in his third professional season following his All-Conference career at Sam Houston State, and briefly appeared with the Curve at the end of last season. *For more on Eppler, see page two.*

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander D.J. Brown makes his 11th start of the season for the RubberDucks, his 18th overall appearance and his third against the Curve. Last time out, Brown worked five scoreless innings at Erie on Thursday. He allowed three earned runs in seven innings in a win at Altoona on May 25 with a season-high eight strikeouts. He also made a relief appearance against the Curve on April 11 and allowed one run in two innings with four strikeouts. As a starter, Brown is 3-2 with a 4.36 ERA in 10 outings. In his seven relief appearances, he is 1-1 with a 1.25 ERA. Brown was selected in the 39th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the Cleveland Indians out of James Madison University.

**MIGHTY DUCKS:** The Curve have a 165-206 record against Akron all time, the worst record for Altoona against any Eastern League opponent. The Curve are 5-9 against Akron this year, including a 2-5 mark at Canal Park. Since 2005, Altoona is 104-146 against Akron in the regular season, with a 41-76 record at Canal Park. The Curve have posted a winning record in Akron just twice since 2005, going 6-5 in 2013 and 6-4 in 2010. The Curve are also 1-7 in playoff games in Akron, dating back to their first postseason meeting in 2003.

**SHINING STARS:** The 2016 Eastern League All-Star teams were announced on Thursday, and four Curve players made the Western Division squad. Right-handed pitcher **Tyler Eppler**, lefty reliever **Jared Lakind** and first baseman **Edwin Espinal** each earned their first All-Star nods. Outfielder **Harold Ramirez** picked up his second All-Star nod and first since 2013 in the New York-Penn League. The 2016 Eastern League All-Star Game will be played on Wednesday, July 13 at Akron's Canal Park.

**EDWINNING:** First baseman **Edwin Espinal** is batting .352 (38/108) since May 26 with six doubles and four homers while striking out just ten times. His .310 season average does not qualify for the league leaderboard. He led Florida State League first basemen with a .995 fielding last season, and currently has a .997 mark at first in 2016.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** The Curve are 39-2 this season when leading after seven innings, ranking third-best in the Eastern League. Lefty relief pitcher **Jared Lakind** has gone 3-0 with a 0.61 (2 ER/29.2 IP) ERA in 21 games since May 1 with 20 scoreless outings. **Montana DuRapau** sits second in the league in saves with 14 in 15 tries. **Brett McKinney** is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (4 ER/17.1 IP) in eleven outings since June 1 with 19 strikeouts.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 44 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (42), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (40) and Steven Moya (35).

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** The Altoona season roster has an average age of 23.5, the youngest of any team in the Eastern League. The two youngest players on the current Curve roster are both 21 and are also the two highest-ranked prospects: **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**. Aside from **Jhondaniel Medina**, who has made multiple trips to join Indianapolis this season, and **Tomas Morales** (two games at Triple-A), no players on the current roster have played above Double-A at any point in their professional careers.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24).

**MOVIN' UP:** The Curve have seen seven players promoted to Triple-A in 2016, all for the first time in their careers. RHP **John Kuchno** was promoted on April 15. RHP **Jhondaniel Medina** has been promoted to Indianapolis three times this season. RHP **Frank Duncan** went up on May 10, and after a one-start return to Altoona, went back to Indianapolis on June 3. RHP **Dovydas Neverauskas** was promoted to Triple-A for the first time on June 16. OF **Austin Meadows** was sent up to Triple-A on June 18. 1B/OF **Jose Osuna** moved up to Triple-A on June 30. Curve catcher **Jin-De Jhang** earned a call-up to Triple-A Indianapolis on Monday.
