YESTERDAY: The Curve lost to the RubberDucks, 8-4, for their third straight defeat at Canal Park this week. Anderson Feliz gave the Curve a lead with a two-run double in the first, but Akron stormed back with six runs in the second and a run in the third. Stetson Allie hit a two-run homer in the fifth to close the gap to two, but Akron plated another run in the seventh to cap the scoring for the night. Alex McRae allowed six earned runs on eight hits in 1.1 innings. Jhondaniel Medina allowed one hit over his two scoreless innings with three strikeouts. Montana DuRapau tossed a 1-2-3 eighth with a strikeout.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue a seven-game road trip with the finale of four games against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. In their last meetings, Altoona took two of three games against Akron at Canal Park from May 31-June 2. The 'Ducks hold a half-game lead over the Curve for first place in the E.L. Western Division. Akron leads the season series, 11-5.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Clay Holmes** makes his 17th start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he gave up one earned run and five hits over seven innings in a win against Bowie on Saturday. He has won each of his last six decisions, spanning ten starts since May 11. Over his last four starts, Holmes is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24 IP) with 26 strikeouts. Holmes is tied for the team lead with seven wins, has pitched the second-most innings (86.0) on the team, sits second in strikeouts (63) and tied for the second-best WHIP (1.44) in the current starting rotation. The Pirates' 15th-ranked prospect entering this season, Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. *For more on Holmes, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Nick Pasquale makes his fourth start of the season for the RubberDucks. Last time out, he allowed one earned run on two hits and five walks over five innings in a no-decision at Erie on Saturday. He picked up a win in his Double-A debut on June 18 against New Hampshire, allowing one earned run in 5.1 innings. He was charged with a loss his next time out against Trenton on June 25, allowing four earned runs in five innings. Pasquale began the year with A-Adv. Lynchburg and went 2-1 with a 2.03 ERA in eight games (five starts).

MIGHTY DUCKS: The Curve have a 165-208 record against Akron all time, the worst record for Altoona against any Eastern League opponent. The Curve are 5-11 against Akron this year, including a 2-7 mark at Canal Park. Since 2005, Altoona is 104-148 against Akron in the regular season, with a 41-78 record at Canal Park. The Curve have posted a winning record in Akron just twice since 2005, going 6-5 in 2013 and 6-4 in 2010. The Curve are also 1-7 in playoff games in Akron, dating back to their first postseason meeting in 2003.

SHINING STARS: The 2016 Eastern League All-Star teams were announced on Thursday, and four Curve players made the Western Division squad. Right-handed pitcher **Tyler Eppler**, lefty reliever **Jared Lakind** and first baseman **Edwin Espinal** each earned their first All-Star nod. Outfielder **Harold Ramirez** picked up his second All-Star nod and first since 2013 in the New York-Penn League. The 2016 Eastern League All-Star Game will be played on Wednesday, July 13 at Akron's Canal Park.

HELLO, NEWMAN: A first-round pick for the Pirates out of Arizona in last summer's draft, shortstop **Kevin Newman** was promoted to Altoona on June 18. He had two hits in his Altoona debut on June 18 against Hartford, but went 0-for-4 in his second game the following night. Since then, he has compiled a career-best 14-game hitting streak, the second-longest for a Curve player this year and longest active streak by an active Eastern League player. During the streak, Newman is hitting .373 (19/51) with six doubles during the streak.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve are 39-2 this season when leading after seven innings, ranking third-best in the Eastern League. Lefty relief pitcher **Jared Lakind** has gone 3-0 with a 0.61 (2 ER/29.2 IP) ERA in 21 games since May 1 with 20 scoreless outings. **Montana DuRapau** sits second in the league in saves with 14 in 15 tries. **Brett McKinney** is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP) in 12 outings since June 1 with 22 strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 45 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (42), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (40) and Steven Moya (35).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28).

Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8), Holmes (19), Barnes (24).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Ten Curve alumni have debuted in the Majors this year, raising the franchise's total to 133 MLB players. On May 16, **Alen Hanson** (2013-14) debuted with the Pirates. **Jameson Taillon** (2012-13) pitched for the Pirates on June 8, while **A.J. Morris** (2014) debuted with the Cincinnati Reds on May 24. **Adrian Sampson** (2014) got his first start for the Seattle Mariners on June 18. **Jacob Stallings** (2012/2015) debuted on June 19 with the Pirates against the Cubs. **Adam Frazier** (2015) singled in his first MLB at-bat in his Pirates debut on June 24. **Chad Kuhl** (2015) earned his first MLB win in his debut on June 26 against the Dodgers. After 13 minor league seasons, reliever **Dustin Mollenken** (2009-10) debuted for Detroit in Cleveland on July 4. Lefty pitcher **Steven Brault** (2015) made his first MLB start for Pittsburgh on July 5 at St. Louis. Top prospect **Tyler Glasnow** made his first MLB start this afternoon for the Pirates at St. Louis.
