

LAST TIME OUT: The Curve capped off the series sweep of the Erie SeaWolves with a 7-3 win to enter the All-Star  $break\ with\ a\ four-game\ winning\ streak.\ Making\ his\ first\ rehab\ appearance,\ \textbf{Ryan}\ \textbf{Vogelsong}\ allowed\ three\ runs\ on\ six$ hits in five innings of work. Jhondaniel Medina earned his first Double-A victory, working two scoreless relief innings and Edgar Santana earned his second Double-A save. Reese McGuire went 3-for-4 with three RBI. Kevin Newman saw his career-best 17-game hitting streak come to an end.

TONIGHT: The Curve open up the second half with a five-game series against the Harrisburg Senators at PNG Field.  $Altoon a and \ Harrisburg \ met \ to \ open \ the \ 2016 \ season \ at \ PNG \ Field, \ and \ the \ teams \ have \ not \ met \ since \ a \ three-game$ series on April 18-20 at FNB Field. Friday's doubleheader is in makeup of the postponed game from Saturday, April 9.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Alex McRae makes his seventh Double-A start for the Curve, Last time out, he was charged with his second straight loss after allowing six runs on eight hits in just 1.1 innings of work against Akron. Over his last two starts, the Wisconsin native has surrendered eleven earned runs (twelve total runs) and 17 hits in 6.1 innings of work. After going 0-2 with a 18.41 ERA in his first two Double-A starts, McRae went 2-0 with a 2.84 ERA in his next two starts at Binghamton and Bowie. He was promoted on June 10 from A-Adv. Bradenton, where he went 3-4 with a 2.69 ERA in twelve starts. McRae is in his third professional season after being selected in the tenth round in 2014 by the Pirates out of Jacksonville University, where he was a two-way player (pitcher, third base, first base, designated hitter).

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Boone Whiting makes his third start of the season with the Senators, and 15th overall. His last time out, Whiting took his first Double-A loss of the season against Erie, allowing five runs on ten hits in 5.2 innings of work. Whiting was promoted to Harrisburg from Adv.-A Potomac on June 27 after going 8-2 with a 3.47 ERA in 12 starts for the P-Nats.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve are a season-best 12 games over .500, and outscored their opponents 399-393 through the pre-All-Star schedule. The Curve have also outscored opponents 96-44 in the eighth inning or later this season and have 21 total come-from-behind wins.

HELLO, NEWMAN: A first-round pick for the Pirates out of Arizona in last summer's draft, shortstop Kevin Newman was promoted to Altoona on June 18. He had two hits in his Altoona debut on June 18 against Hartford, but went 0-for-4 in his second game the following night. After that game, he compiled a career-best 17-game hitting streak, the second-longest for a Curve player this year. His streak surpassed Gorkys Hernandez (2010) and Starling Marte (2011) for the seventh-longest in Altoona franchise history on July 9. During the streak, Newman hit .371 (26/70) with seven doubles. He's scored a run in 14 of 20 games played for the Curve so far.

EDWINNING: First baseman Edwin Espinal is batting .355 (43/121) since May 26 with eight doubles and four homers while striking out just 13 times. His .315 season average does not qualify for the league leaderboard. He led Florida State League first basemen with a .995 fielding last season, and currently has a .997 mark at first in 2016.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve are 42-2 this season when leading after seven innings, tied for second-best in the Eastern League. The team is also 40-1 when leading through eight innings. Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind has gone 3-0 with a 0.81 (3 ER/33.1 IP) ERA in 23 games since May 1 with 21 scoreless outings. Montana DuRapau sits second in the league in saves with 15 in 16 tries. Brett McKinney is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP) in 12 outings since June 1 with 22 strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 45 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third alltime. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (42), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (40) and Steven Mova (35),

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Kevin Newman (11), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24),

Lefty pitcher Steven Brault (2015) made his first MLB start for Pittsburgh on July 5 at St. Louis. Top prospect Tyler Glasnow (2015) made his first MLB start on Thursday for the Pirates at St. Louis. First baseman Josh Bell (2014-15) singled in his debut for the Pirates against the Cubs on Friday night at PNC Park.
