YESTERDAY: The Curve split a double-header with the Harrisburg Senators. Altoona won the first game, 5-0, behind six scoreless innings pitched by rehabbing Pirates pitcher Ryan Vogelson, who allowed just two hits. Stetson Allie and Eric Wood each homered in the game. Harrisburg won the night cap, 3-2. A two-run homer by Wood in the seventh brought the Curve within a run, but Wander Suero finished the game for the Senators. Shawn Pleffner hit a solo homer for the Senators in the sixth that provided the eventual game-clinching run. The loss in game two for the Curve snapped a six-game winning streak.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue their series with the Harrisburg Senators with the fourth of five games in the series at PNG Field. Altoona and Harrisburg met to open the 2016 season at PNG Field, and the teams have not met since a three-game series on April 18-20 at FNB Field.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Cody Dickson makes his 18th start of the year for the Curve and first against Harrisburg. Last time out, he allowed one earned run over six innings in a no-decision at Erie last Friday. Over six starts from May 7-June 12, Dickson went 5-0 with a 1.13 ERA (5 ER/39.2 IP) and did not allow more than one earned run in a start. In his last 12 starts since May 7, Dickson is 7-1 with a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP). Last year, Dickson went 12-7 with a 4.13 ERA in 27 starts for the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders, leading the team in wins for the season. The Arlington, Texas native was selected in the fourth round in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Sam Houston State, where he was teammates for one season with fellow Altoona starter Tyler Eppler. FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Phillips Valdez makes his seventh start of the year for the Senators and first against the Curve. Last time out, he was charged with a loss after allowing six earned runs in four innings at Akron last Saturday. He has allowed four or more earned runs in four of his six starts so far for Harrisburg. He began the season with A-Adv. Potomac and went 6-3 with a 3.74 ERA in 11 starts.

ELIAS RETURNS: 2014 Altoona Curve MVP Elias Diaz is set to begin an MLB rehab assignment with the Curve tonight. He made his Major League debut for the Pirates last September, but was placed on the disabled list on April 3 with a right elbow strain. He had elbow debridement surgery. Diaz began his rehab work with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders on July 4 and posted a .391 batting average in his seven games, including knocking seven combined hits in his last two games before having his rehab assignment transferred to Altoona on Saturday. Diaz was an Eastern League All-Star in 2014 and hit .328 with six homers in his 91 games.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve are 13 games over .500 and outscored their opponents 415-399. The Curve have also outscored opponents 98-46 in the eighth inning or later this season and have 21 total come-from-behind wins.

HELLO, NEWMAN: A first-round pick for the Pirates out of Arizona in last summer's draft, shortstop Kevin Newman was promoted to Altoona on June 18. He had two hits in his Altoona debut on June 18 against Hartford, but went 0-for-4 in his second game the following night. After that game, he compiled a career-best 17-game hitting streak, the second-longest for a Curve player this year. His streak surpassed Gorkys Hernandez (2010) and Starling Marte (2011) for the seventh-longest in Altoona franchise history on July 9. During the streak, Newman hit .371 (26/70) with seven doubles. He's scored a run in 15 of 22 games played for the Curve so far.

EDWINNING: First baseman Edwin Espinal is batting .338 (44/130) since May 26, the fourth-highest average in the Pittsburgh system since then, with nine doubles and four homers while striking out just 15 times. His .307 season average does not qualify for the league leaderboard. He led Florida State League first basemen with a .995 fielding last season, and currently has a .997 mark at first in 2016.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve are 44-2 this season when leading after seven innings, the second-best in the Eastern League. The team is also 42-1 when leading through eight innings. Lefty relief pitcher Jared Lakind has gone 3-0 with a 0.81 (3 ER/33.1 IP) ERA in 23 games since May 1 with 21 scoreless outings. Montana DuRapau sits second in the league in saves with 15 in 16 tries. Brett McKinney is 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER/21.0 IP) in 13 outings since June 1 with 24 strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 46 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (42), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (41) and Steven Moya (35).

Two-time letter winner at Sam Houston State...Compiled a 17-11 record in three-year college career...Went 9-5 with a 4.26 ERA and 91 strikeouts in 18 appearances (15 starts) as a junior with the Bearkats in 2013...His 91 strikeouts were the fifth-most in school history in a single season...Ended 2013 season with a 28.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest in school history at the Division I level and second-longest ever...Teammates at Sam Houston State in 2013 with Pirates minor league pitcher and 2015 Curve Tyler Eppler...Went 4-5 with a 3.25 ERA as a sophomore in 2012...Went 4-1 with a 4.34 ERA and 52 strikeouts over 14 games (11 starts) as a freshman in 2011...Combined to go 15-6 over junior and senior seasons at Mansfield Summit (Texas) HS...Set school record for career wins...Was a member of the Metro Scout League All-Star Team in Jupiter, Fla.
