SUNDAY: The Curve lost to the Harrisburg Senators, 3-2, at PNG Field. It was the third consecutive loss for Altoona. Harrisburg jumped ahead 2-0 in the first inning. Harold Ramirez and Elias Diaz drove in runs in the fourth to tie the game, 2-2, but the Senators reclaimed the lead for good in the sixth. Brandon Waddell allowed three runs over 6.2 innings. Eric Wood and Barrett Barnes each had two hits.

TODAY: The Curve open a three-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. Altoona won two-of-three games against Hartford at PNG Field from June 17-19. The Curve have lost three straight games entering play tonight. Hartford split a four-game series in Binghamton before heading to Altoona. This series was originally scheduled to be played in Hartford but was moved to Altoona because of construction delays at Dunkin Donuts Park.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Tyler Eppler** makes his 18th start of the year for the Curve. Last time out, he allowed five earned runs in a loss at Akron on July 5. Today's game marks Eppler's first start in two weeks. He last faced Hartford on June 19 at PNG Field and picked up a win after allowing one run over six innings. The Texas native is in his third professional season following his All-Conference career at Sam Houston State, where he was teammates with Curve pitcher Cody Dickson, and briefly appeared with the Curve at the end of last season. *For more on Eppler, see page two.*

FOR HARTFORD: Lefty Carlos Hernandez makes his 12th start of the year for the Yard Goats and 17th overall appearance for Hartford. He last pitched in relief against Binghamton on Saturday, working one scoreless inning with two strikeouts. His last start came on July 9 in a loss against Portland, when he allowed seven earned runs on nine hits in four innings. He began the season with Hartford, and make three appearances (two starts) for Triple-A Albuquerque, where he went 0-1 with a 1.20 ERA. Hernandez was a 35th-round pick out of West Valley College by the Oakland Athletics in 2006 and signed with Colorado as a free agent in November 2013.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve are 11 games over .500 and outscored their opponents 419-406. The Curve have also outscored opponents 98-48 in the eighth inning or later this season and have 21 total come-from-behind wins.

HELLO, NEWMAN: A first-round pick for the Pirates out of Arizona in last summer's draft, shortstop **Kevin Newman** was promoted to Altoona on June 18. He had two hits in his Altoona debut on June 18 against Hartford, but went 0-for-4 in his second game the following night. After that game, he compiled a career-best 17-game hitting streak, the second-longest for a Curve player this year. His streak surpassed Gorkys Hernandez (2010) and Starling Marte (2011) for the seventh-longest in Altoona franchise history on July 9. During the streak, Newman hit .371 (26/70) with seven doubles.

EDWINNING: First baseman **Edwin Espinal** is batting .329 (48/136) since May 26, the fifth-highest average in the Pittsburgh system since then, with 10 doubles and four homers while striking out just 17 times. His .302 season average does not qualify for the league leaderboard. He led Florida State League first basemen with a .995 fielding last season, and currently has a .997 mark at first in 2016.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve are 44-2 this season when leading after seven innings, the second-best in the Eastern League. The team is also 42-1 when leading through eight innings. Lefty relief pitcher **Jared Lakind** has gone 3-1 with a 1.31 (5 ER/34.1 IP) ERA in 24 games since May 1 with 21 scoreless outings. **Montana DuRapau** sits second in the league in saves with 15 in 16 tries. **Brett McKinney** is 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER/21.0 IP) in 13 outings since June 1 with 24 strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 46 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (42), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (41) and Steven Moya (35).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Reese McGuire** (5), **Harold Ramirez** (6), **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8), Holmes (19), Barnes (24).

Curve catcher **Jin-De Jhang** earned a call-up to Triple-A Indianapolis on Monday. Outfielder **Jonathan Schwind** joined Indy on July 9 and played in three games.
