YESTERDAY: The Curve beat the SeaWolves, 3-2, to pick up their fourth straight win. Erie took a 1-0 lead in the first against Alex McRae, but he settled in to hold them off the board the rest of his seven innings and earned his fourth win. **Stetson Allie** singled in the tying run in the fifth inning, and **Anderson Feliz** gave the Curve the lead with an RBI single in the seventh. **Eric Wood** padded the lead with an RBI single in the eighth. **Barrett Barnes** went 3-for-4 with two doubles and two runs scored. Montana DuRapau closed out his 17th save of the season.

TONIGHT: The Curve play the second in a three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Curve enter having won four straight games on the heels of a season-worst seven-game losing streak. Last night's Altoona win moved the Curve back in front of Harrisburg for first in the E.L. West. Erie has lost six of its last eight games, including dropping three of four at Bowie heading into the series at PNG Field.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Clay Holmes makes his 20th start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he allowed five earned runs in four innings in a loss against Akron on Thursday. In his previous six starts since June 16-July 15. Holmes went 3-1 with a 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35 IP) with 34 strikeouts and did not allow more than two earned runs in a start. Holmes is tied for the team lead with eight wins, second with 74 strikeouts and has logged the third-most innings with 101.0. The Pirates' 15th-ranked prospect entering this season, Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. For more on Holmes, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Myles Jaye makes his 21st start of the year for the SeaWolves. Last time out, he allowed four earned runs in four innings in a loss against Bowie on Thursday. It was his first start since he logged 8.1 scoreless, two-hit innings with no walks and 11 strikeouts in a win at Akron on July 16, helping him earn his second Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award this season. He last faced the Curve on July 8 in a no-decision at Jerry Uht Park and allowed two earned runs in six innings with eight strikeouts. In two starts this year against the Curve, Jaye is 0-1 with a 2.77 ERA.

NOT SO DREARY AGAINST ERIE: The Curve are 24-11 against the SeaWolves since the start of the 2015 season, including starting the season 8-0 against Erie last season. The Curve currently have won four straight games against the SeaWolves, including a three-game sweep in Erie from July 8-10.

JECKYLL AND HYDE: The Curve ended a season-worst seven-game losing streak on Friday night with a win over Akron. The Curve were outscored 33-12 over the seven games and did not score more than two runs in a game. In the four wins since, the Curve outscored Akron and Erie, 25-12. The Curve are eleven games over .500 and have outscored opponents 450-440 overall. During the six-game winning streak from July 7-July 15 (G1), the Curve outscored their opponents, 39-11. They have outscored opponents 99-61 in the eighth inning or later this season and have 23 total come-from-behind wins, while going 48-2 when leading after seven innings, the second-best mark in the league.

GRIN AND BARRETT: After hitting .249 through 70 games, Barrett Barnes went on an 11-game hitting streak from July 5-July 19. Since the beginning of that streak, he has raised his average to .300, tied for sixth in the E.L. Since July 5, Barnes is batting .484 (30/62), tops in the Pirates org. and in the E.L., with hits in 17 of 18 games.

HELLO, NEWMAN: A first-round pick for the Pirates out of Arizona in last summer's draft, shortstop Kevin Newman was promoted to Altoona on June 18. He had two hits in his Altoona debut on June 18 against Hartford, but went 0-for-4 in his second game the following night. After that game, he compiled a career-best 17-game hitting streak, the second-longest for a Curve player this year. His streak surpassed Gorkys Hernandez (2010) and Starling Marte (2011) for the seventh-longest in Altoona franchise history on July 9. During the streak, Newman hit .371 (26/70) with seven doubles. He clubbed his first Double-A homer on July 19 against Hartford. He at least one hit in 24 of his 31 games with an at-bat so far with Altoona and has scored at least one run in 21 of those 30 games with an at-bat.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 47 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third alltime. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (43), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (41) and Steven Moya (35).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Reese McGuire (5), Harold Ramirez (6), Kevin Newman (11), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Five players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Ramirez (5), McGuire (6), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Eleven Curve alumni have debuted in the Majors this year, raising the franchise's total to 134 MLB players. On May 16, Alen Hanson (2013-14) debuted with the Pirates. Jameson Taillon (2012-13) pitched for the Pirates on June 8, while A.J. Morris (2014) debuted with the Cincinnati Reds on May 24. Adrian Sampson (2014) got his first start for the Seattle Mariners on June 18. Jacob Stallings (2012/2015) debuted on June 19 with the Pirates against the Cubs. **Adam Frazier** (2015) singled in his first MLB at-bat in his Pirates debut on June 24. **Chad Kuhl** (2015) earned his first MLB win in his debut on June 26 against the Dodgers. After 13 minor league seasons, reliever Dustin Molleken (2009-10) debuted for Detroit in Cleveland on July 4. Lefty pitcher Steven Brault (2015) made his first MLB start for Pittsburgh on July 5 at St. Louis. Top prospect Tyler Glasnow (2015) made his first MLB start on Thursday for the Pirates at St. Louis. First baseman Josh Bell (2014-15) singled in his debut for the Pirates against the Cubs on Friday night at PNC Park.
