**SUNDAY:** The Curve dropped both games of a Sunday doubleheader to the Trenton Thunder at ARM & HAMMER Park, scoring just two combined runs on five combined hits. **Edwin Espnial** drove home **Kevin Newman** for the lone Curve run in the first game, and **Erich Weiss** drew a bases-loaded walk to plate **Barrett Barnes** in the seventh inning for Altoona's only run in game two. **Alex McRae** took his tenth straight decision in a game one loss, while **Clay Holmes** took a tough-luck game two defeat despite allowing just two hits and one earned run (three total) in the night cap.

**TONIGHT:** The Curve look to snap a four-game losing streak as Altoona begins a three-game homestand against the Richmond Flying Squirrels at PNG Field. The Curve have won 10 straight games against the Flying Squirrels, with the last Richmond victory coming on April 21 in Altoona.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Lefty **Cody Dickson** makes his 21st start of the season for the Curve and fifth against Richmond. Against Richmond this season, Dickson is 2-1 with a 2.61, and has won back-to-back outings against the Squirrels (May 7 & May 12). Last time out, Dickson allowed five runs on four hits and walked six in 2.2 innings against Erie, but was bailed out by his offense who came back to walk off against the SeaWolves. He struck out a season-high eight strikeouts on 7/22 against Akron. In his last 15 starts since May 7, Dickson is 8-1 with a 2.88 ERA (26 ER/81.1 IP). Over six starts from May 7-June 12, Dickson went 5-0 with a 1.13 ERA (5 ER/39.2 IP) and did not allow more than one earned run in a start. Last year, Dickson went 12-7 with a 4.13 ERA in 27 starts for the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders, leading the team in wins for the season. The Arlington, Texas native was selected in the fourth round in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Sam Houston State, where he was teammates for one season with fellow Altoona starter Tyler Eppler. *For more on Dickson, see page two.*

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander Kyle Crick takes the bump for Richmond, and makes his second start this season against the Curve. Crick took the loss against Altoona on April 24, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.2 innings, walking five and striking out two. Crick lost three straight games from May 29 - June 10. The Sherman, Texas native won his last outing on July 27 in Akron, allowing four runs (one earned) on three hits, striking out eight.

**JECKYLL AND HYDE:** The Curve have been a team of streaks, dating back to July 4 when they began a three-game losing streak at Akron. They answered with a six-game winning streak from July 7-July 15 (G1), outscoring opponents, 39-11. The Curve followed that with a season-worst seven-game losing streak from July 15 (G2) through July 21, during which they were outscored 33-12 and did not score more than two runs in a single game. They responded with another six-game winning streak from July 22 through July 27. The Curve are nine games over .500 and have outscored opponents 470-468. They have outscored opponents 101-67 in the eighth inning or later and have 25 total come-from-behind wins, while going 50-2 when leading after seven innings, the second-best mark in the league.

**COOLING OFF:** Over six games from July 22-27, the Curve hit .429 (78/182) and scored 44 runs (7.3/game). In the last four games in Trenton, the Altoona offense has hit just .163 (19/116) and .083 (3/36), 2 RBI with runners in scoring position with just one run in each game.

**GRIN AND BARRETT:** After hitting .249 through 70 games, **Barrett Barnes** has hit .412 (35/85) since July 5, second-best in the Eastern League with hits in 20 of 22 games, raising his average to .296, seventh-best overall in the E.L. Barnes went on a 22-game on-base streak from July 4-28, but had it snapped in Friday's loss.

**HELLO, NEWMAN:** A first-round pick for the Pirates out of Arizona in last summer's draft, shortstop **Kevin Newman** was promoted to Altoona on June 18. He compiled a career-best 17-game hitting streak, the second-longest for a Curve player this year, from June 21-July 9. It was the seventh-longest hitting streak in Altoona franchise history. Newman went 4-for-4 on July 23 against Akron, but went 1-for-14 over his next three games through July 26. Over the last three games since Wednesday, Newman has returned to form, going 5-for-16.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 48 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (45), Dean Green (41), Quincy Latimore (42) and Steven Moya (35).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features four of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Three players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24).

Two-time letter winner at Sam Houston State...Compiled a 17-11 record in three-year college career...Went 9-5 with a 4.26 ERA and 91 strikeouts in 18 appearances (15 starts) as a junior with the Bearkats in 2013...His 91 strikeouts were the fifth-most in school history in a single season...Ended 2013 season with a 28.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest in school history at the Division I level and second-longest ever...Teammates at Sam Houston State in 2013 with Pirates minor league pitcher and 2015 Curve Tyler Eppler...Went 4-5 with a 3.25 ERA as a sophomore in 2012...Went 4-1 with a 4.34 ERA and 52 strikeouts over 14 games (11 starts) as a freshman in 2011...Combined to go 15-6 over junior and senior seasons at Mansfield Summit (Texas) HS...Set school record for career wins...Was a member of the Metro Scout League All-Star Team in Jupiter, Fla.
