YESTERDAY: The Curve came back to tie the game in the ninth and won in ten innings over Reading, 2-1. Eric Wood hit a game-tying single in the top of the ninth. Anderson Feliz rolled into a groundout in the tenth, scoring Jon Schwind from third. Montana DuRapau closed out his 19th save. Miguel Rosario earned his first Double-A win after two scoreless relief innings. Clay Holmes tossed five scoreless innings, working around four walks with five strikeouts.

TONIGHT: The Curve play the finale and rubber game of a three-game set against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. The Fightins took all three games in Reading the last time these two teams met from July 10-12. Altoona had lost eight consecutive road games (including three "road" games at PNG Field against Hartford) prior to last night's win.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Cody Dickson makes his 22nd start of the season for the Curve and his second against Reading. In his last start against the Fightin Phils on June 12, Dickson pitched five scoreless innings and allowed just three hits. In 16 starts since May 7, Dickson is 9-1 with a 2.89 ERA (28 ER/87.1 IP). He has not been charged with a loss over his last eight starts. Last time out, Dickson earned a win after allowing two earned runs in six innings on Tuesday against Richmond. Over six starts from May 7-June 12, Dickson went 5-0 with a 1.13 ERA (5 ER/39.2 IP) and did not allow more than one earned run in a start. The Arlington, Texas native was selected in the fourth round in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of Sam Houston State, where he was teammates for one season with fellow Altoona starter Tyler Eppler. FOR READING: Right-hander Nick Pivetta makes his 22nd start of the year for the Fightin Phils and his second against Altoona. On June 12, he held the Curve to three hits over seven scoreless innings. In his most recent start, Pivetta snapped a two-start losing skid with a win over the Baysox on Tuesday, allowing two earned runs in 7.2 innings. He made one start with Reading against Altoona last season, picking up a win at PNG Field in August 24, 2015 after allowed four runs (three earned) in seven innings. Pivetta was traded to the Phillies on July 29, 2015 for MLB reliever Jonathan Papelbon. He was named to the Eastern League All-Star team for the Eastern Division this season, the third All-Star selection of his career.

JECKYLL AND HYDE: The Curve have been a team of streaks, dating back to July 4 when they began a three-game losing streak at Akron. They answered with a six-game winning streak from July 7-July 15 (G1), outscoring opponents, 39-11. The Curve followed that with a season-worst seven-game losing streak from July 15 (G2) through July 21, during which they were outscored 33-12 and did not score more than two runs in a single game. They responded with another six-game winning streak from July 22 through July 27. That streak was followed by a four-game losing slide, all in Trenton, which was snapped with a three-game series sweep against Richmond. The Curve are eleven games over .500 and have outscored opponents 482-478 and have 28 total come-from-behind wins, while going 51-2 when leading after seven innings, tied with Harrisburg for the second-best mark in the league.

EXTRA! EXTRA! The Curve have gone into extra innings in three of the last four games, and they have won all three of those games, 2-1. On Wednesday, Edwin Espinal hit a walk-off solo homer in the bottom of the 12th inning, and he lifted the Curve to a walk-off win in 10 innings with a sacrifice fly on Thursday night. Last night, the Curve rallied in the ninth to tie the game at Reading and won in the tenth with a go-ahead groundout by Anderson Feliz. The Curve are 4-3 overall this season in seven extra-inning games.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer Montana DuRapau leads active Eastern League relievers with 19 saves this year, second-most overall, sits first with 35 games finished and fourth in total games pitched with 41. His 19 saves are eighth-most in a single season in Altoona franchise history. He has the third-most saves for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind 21 by Daniel Moskos during the team's championship run in 2010 and 24 by Noah Krol in 2011.

GRIN AND BARRETT: After hitting .249 through 70 games, Barrett Barnes has hit .396 (38/96) since July 5, the best mark in the Eastern League, with hits in 23 of 26 games with an at-bat, raising his average to .293, tied for eighth-best overall in the E.L. Barnes went on a 22-game on-base streak from July 4-28.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 48 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (46), Quincy Latimore (44) Dean Green (41), and Steven Moya (35).

BRINGIN' THE LUMBER: Curve third baseman Eric Wood entered 2016 having hit 15 career home runs in four minor league seasons. Through 92 games this year, Wood has hit 15 home runs, the most for Altoona this season, and owns the fourth-best Home Run/At Bat Ratio in the league (1/20.60). This week, Wood was also named the "Best Defensive Third Baseman" in the Eastern League on Baseball America's Best Tools list.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features four of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Kevin Newman (11), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Five players are on MLB.com's current update, including Newman (4), Holmes (12), Brandon Waddell (22), Eppler (24) and Barnes (30). Three players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24).

DEADLINE DEALS: On Monday, just moments before the trade deadline, Curve catcher Reese McGuire and outfielder Harold Ramirez were traded by the Pittsburgh Pirates along with big league left-handed pitcher Francisco Liriano to the Toronto Blue Jays for Triple-A pitcher Drew Hutchison.
