YESTERDAY: Harrisburg jumped on top of the Curve early with three runs in the first inning, thanks in large part to a two-run home run from Kevin Keyes, but Tyler Eppler settled down after the frame, allowing just two more runs despite taking the loss. Altoona's offense had trouble hitting Harrisburg starter Erick Fedde in his Double-A debut, as Fedde allowed just one run on five hits in seven innings. Anderson Feliz tripled home Stetson Allie for the first Curve run in the seventh, and Allie doubled home Barrett Barnes in the ninth.

TONIGHT: The top two teams in the Western Division face off in the finale of a three-game series at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve enter the game with a 1.5-game lead over the Harrisburg Senators, the Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Alex McRae makes his twelfth Double-A start for the Curve, and his second against Harrisburg. In his last start against the Senators, McRae allowed just one run on eight hits in a career best eight innings of work on 7/14. Last time out, McRae took his first no-decision of the season against Reading, allowing just one run on five hits in six innings, striking out six. McRae was promoted to the Curve on June 10 from A-Adv. Bradenton, where he went 3-4 with a 2.69 ERA in twelve starts. The Wisconsin native made his Double-A debut against Reading, taking the loss when he allowed four home runs and seven total runs on eight hits in 3.2 innings of work. McRae is in his third pro season after being selected in the tenth round in 2014 by the Pirates out of Jacksonville University, where he was a two-way player (pitcher, third base, first base, designated hitter). **For more on McRae, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Mark Blackmar makes his fifth start of the season for the Senators, and seventh overall. In his last start, Blackmar defeated the Trenton Thunder by tossing seven scoreless frames, scattering six hits, walking one and striking out four. The Corpus Christi native was signed by the Nationals as a free agent on July 5 and began the year in Potomac, going 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA in two starts.

PLAYOFF HUNT: Altoona, Harrisburg and Akron are leading the chase for the two postseason spots from the Western Division. The Curve's "Magic Number" to clinch a playoff spot is currently 21. On May 28, Akron was 35-13 with a 7.5-game lead over the Curve. Since that date, they have gone 23-46, including 4-14 over their last 18 games. The Curve took over first place in the division for the first time on June 26, and have held that spot in the standings for 34 of 41 games since. Harrisburg started the year 7-13 through April, but has gone 55-41 since. Last year, the Curve won the Western Division Wild Card and went to the playoffs for the first time since their E.L. title run in 2010. They have not appeared in consecutive E.L. postseasons since the first four playoff trips in franchise history in four consecutive years from 2003-2006.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE: The Curve are 35-22 at PNG Field this year, the best home record in the E.L. Western Division. Altoona won 10 consecutive home games from July 22-August 9, setting a new franchise record. The streak surpassed the club's nine-game home winning streak set from July 2-July 23, 2001 under manager Dale Sveum.

D-D-DEFENSE: After holding the worst fielding percentage in the Eastern League last season, the Curve hold the top fielding percentage in the circuit in 2016 at .981. That percentage would surpass the best fielding percentage in team history, which was set at .977 in 2010 and 2013. The Curve have committed only 81 defensive errors this year, putting them on pace for 100 on the season, which would break the franchise-best mark of 125 set in 2010.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve have won in their last at-bat in each of their last four victories. Last Wednesday, Edwin Espinal hit a walk-off solo homer in the bottom of the 12th inning for a 2-1 win over Richmond and lifted the Curve to a 2-1 walk-off win over the Flying Squirrels in 10 innings with a sacrifice fly on Thursday night. On Saturday, the Curve rallied in the ninth to tie the game at Reading and won in the tenth with a go-ahead groundout by Anderson Feliz. The Curve are 4-3 overall this season in seven extra-inning games. Last night, Stetson Allie hit a tie-breaking solo home run in the eighth in the Curve's 9-7 win over the Senators. The Curve have outscored opponents 111-73 in the eighth inning or later this season and have 29 total come-from-behind wins.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer Montana DuRapau leads active Eastern League relievers with 20 saves this year, second-most overall, sits first with 36 games finished and tied for third in total games pitched with 42. His 20 saves are eighth-most in a single season in Altoona franchise history. He has the third-most saves for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind 21 by Daniel Moskos during the team's title run in 2010 and 24 by Noah Krol in 2011.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 49 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (46), Quincy Latimore (44) Dean Green (41), Rhys Hoskins (35) and Steven Moya (35).

BRINGIN' THE LUMBER: Curve third baseman Eric Wood entered 2016 having hit 15 career home runs in four minor league seasons. Through 94 games this year, Wood has hit 15 home runs, the most for Altoona this season, and owns the fifth-best Home Run/At Bat Ratio in the league (1/21.33). Last week, Wood was also named the "Best Defensive Third Baseman" in the Eastern League on *Baseball America's* Best Tools list.
