

YESTERDAY: The Curve and Sea Dogs played into the bottom of the fourth inning before rain resulted in the game being suspended. Barrett Barnes clubbed his fourth home run in his last six games, a two-run shot in the top of the fourth. The Curve held a 2-0 lead when the game was suspended, and it is scheduled to be completed on Thursday at

TONIGHT: The Curve face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, in a double-header. The two teams played one game at PNG Field in May, an 8-0 win by the Curve, before rain postponed the last two games of the series.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Clay Holmes makes his 24th start of the season for the Curve in game one and first against the Sea Dogs. Last time out, Holmes picked up a win over Reading on Friday after allowing one run in six innings with six strikeouts. Holmes is tied for third in the Eastern League with a career-best 10 wins. Over his last four starts since July 26, Holmes is 2-1 with a 1.64 ERA (4 ER/22.0 IP). In his last 11 starts since June 16, Holmes has gone 5-3 with a 2.36 ERA (16 ER/61.0 IP), lowering his season ERA from 5.66 to 4.02. Rated as the Pirates' 12th-ranked prospect entering this season, Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. For more on Holmes, see page two.

Right-hander Alex McRae makes his 13th Double-A start for the Curve, and his first against Portland. Last time out, McRae earned a win on Thursday against Harrisburg after allowing two runs in 6.2 innings with a career-high seven strikeouts. Over last six starts since July 14, McRae has gone 3-2 with a 2.75 ERA (11 ER/36.0 IP) after going 2-4 with a 10.25 ERA in first six starts. McRae was promoted to the Curve on June 10 from A-Adv. Bradenton, where he went 3-4 with a 2.69 ERA in twelve starts. McRae is in his third pro season after being selected in the tenth round in 2014 by the Pirates out of Jacksonville University, where he was a two-way player (pitcher, third base, first base, designated hitter). FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Mike McCarthy starts in game one, his fourth start of the season for Portland and his ninth appearance for the Sea Dogs. McCarthy started his last time out with Portland on July 26 against Trenton, allowing no runs on four hits in four innings of work. The Walnut Creek, Calif. native has also appeared in a game for Triple-A Pawtucket, allowing six earned runs (seven total) on nine hits in 3.1 innings on May 19 at Buffalo.

Lefty Jalen Beeks makes his 10th start for Portland in game two. Last time out, he pitched six innings and allowed two hits last Wednesday at Erie in a win, his third straight start with a victory and fourth consecutive winning decision. Beeks began the year with A-Adv. Salem, where he went 4-4 with a 3.07 ERA in 13 starts before a promotion to Double-A on June 23.

PLAYOFF HUNT: The Curve are 13 games over .500. Altoona, Harrisburg and Akron are leading the chase for the two postseason spots from the Western Division. The Curve's "Magic Number" to clinch a playoff spot is currently 16. On May 28, Akron was 35-13 with a 7.5-game lead over the Curve. Since that date, they have gone 26-47. The Curve took over first place in the division for the first time on June 26, and have held that spot in the standings for 38 of their 45 games since. Last year, the Curve won the Western Division Wild Card and went to the playoffs for the first time since their E.L. title run in 2010. They have not appeared in consecutive postseasons since the first four playoff trips in franchise history in four straight years from 2003-06.

D-D-DEFENSE: After holding the worst fielding percentage in the Eastern League last season, the Curve hold the top fielding percentage in the circuit in 2016 at .980. That percentage would surpass the best fielding percentage in team history, which was set at .977 in 2010 and 2013. The Curve have committed only 91 defensive errors this year, putting them on pace for 108 on the season, which would break the franchise-best mark of 125 set in 2010.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve have outscored opponents 112-74 in the 8th inning or later this season and have 31 total come-from-behind wins. The Curve have won seven times this year after trailing through eight innings, the most in the league. The two closest teams in that category, New Hampshire and Reading, have each done it four times.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer Montana DuRapau leads active Eastern League relievers with 21 saves this year, second-most overall, sits first with 38 games finished and tied for second in total games pitched with 44 His 21 saves are tied for fifth-most in a single season in Altoona franchise history. He is tied for the secod-most saves for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007 behind only the 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. The Curve are 52-1 when leading heading into the ninth inning, the best in the E.L.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 49 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (47), Quincy Latimore (44), Dean Green (41), Steven Moya (35), Rhys Hoskins (35) and Dylan Cozens (34).

BARNES BOUNCING BACK: Outfielder Barrett Barnes was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after hitting .579 (9-for-17) with three homers over five games. After hitting just one homer through his first 100 games, Barnes has hit four home runs in his last six games. He hit .249 in his first 70 games through July 4, but has raised his average to .302, sixth-best in the league. In his last 34 games since July 5, Barnes has hit .405 (47/116), tops in the E.L. during that span, with eleven doubles and 16 RBIs (not including Tuesday's suspended game).
