YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped the rubber game of a three-game series, and the final game of a ten-game road trip, to the Harrisburg Senators. Altoona took their first lead of the game in the top of the eighth with a two-run, pinch-hit double from Edwin Espinal to give the Curve a 3-2 lead, but an Andrew Stevenson RBI single against Montana DuRapau in the ninth tied the game at 3-3 and Kevin Keyes walked the Sens off with a single into center field. Curve starter Cody Dickson allowed just one run on four hits in five innings, striking out six.

TONIGHT: The Curve return to PNG Field for the first time since August 14, and begin their final homestand of the regular season with the first of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Curve are 11-6 this season against the SeaWolves and have won seven straight games against Erie dating back to June 26. Altoona swept Erie in a three-game series at PNG Field from July 25-27.

FOR ALTOONA: Lefty Brandon Waddell makes his 19th start of the year for the Curve and fourth against Erie. In his last outing, Waddell dropped his second straight decision against New Hampshire, allowing five runs on nine hits in 9.1 innings of work, surrendering two home runs (his first multi-home run game since 5/29 @ BOW). Last time he pitched at PNG Field, Waddell pitched out of the bullpen for the first time in his career, allowing four runs (two earned) over 3.2 innings in relief of Tyler Glasnow on his MLB rehab assignment against Reading. In his last seven starts since July 9, Waddell is 2-3 with a 3.14 ERA (15 ER/43.0 IP). He began the season with A-Adv. Bradenton and went 4-0 in five starts with a 0.93 ERA, picking up a win in each of his last four outings prior to his promotion to Double-A on May 3. Waddell won the Florida State League Player of the Month Award for April and won his first three starts with Altoona, stretching his streak to seven straight starts won overall. He was drafted in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Virginia after leading the Cavaliers to the 2015 College World Series title, pitching seven innings in the championship clincher against Vanderbilt. *For more on Waddell, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Artie Lewicki makes his 13th start of the season and his tenth start for Erie. Lewicki is looking to avoid his third straight loss after dropping his last start against Reading, allowing four runs on seven hits in six innings of work despite striking out six. In his last five starts since July 25, Lewicki is 0-4 despite a 2.83 ERA (9 ER / 28.2 IP). Lewicki took the loss against Altoona on July 25 at PNG Field, allowing two runs on nine hits in 6.2 innings, striking out five.

PLAYOFF HUNT: The Curve are 11 games over .500. Altoona, Akron and Harrisburg are leading the chase for the two postseason spots from the Western Division. The Curve's "Magic Number" to clinch a playoff spot is currently 10. The Curve took over first place in the division for the first time on June 26, and have held that spot in the standings for 46 of their 53 games since. Akron is in second and has won ten straight games. Last year, the Curve won the Western Division Wild Card and went to the playoffs for the first time since their E.L. title run in 2010. They have not appeared in consecutive postseasons since the first four playoff trips in franchise history in four straight years from 2003-06.

NOT SO DREARY AGAINST ERIE: The Curve are 26-11 against the SeaWolves since the start of the 2015 season, including starting the season 8-0 against Erie last season. The Curve currently have won seven straight games against the SeaWolves, including a three-game sweep in Erie from July 8-10 and a three-game sweep at PNG Field from July 25-27.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve have outscored opponents 116-85 in the 8th inning or later this season and have 32 total come-from-behind wins. The Curve have won seven times this year after trailing through eight innings, the most in the league. The two closest teams in that category, New Hampshire and Reading, have each done it four times.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer Montana DuRapau leads active Eastern League relievers with 22 saves this year, second-most overall, sits first with 40 games finished and third in total games pitched with 46. His 22 saves are tied for fourth-most in a single season in Altoona franchise history. He is tied for the second-most saves for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007 behind only the 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. The Curve are 54-1 when leading heading into the ninth inning, the best in the E.L.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder Stetson Allie now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 51 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (47), Quincy Latimore (44), Dean Green (41), Dylan Cozens (37), Rhys Hoskins (35), Steven Moya (35).

BARNES BOUNCING BACK: After hitting just one homer through his first 100 games, Barnes hit four home runs in six games from August 9-16 and has hit six homers in 13 games since August 9. He hit .249 in his first 70 games through July 4, but has raised his average to .307, fifth-best in the league. In his last 41 games since July 5, Barnes has hit .399 (57/143), tops in the E.L. during that span, with six homers, twelve doubles and 23 RBIs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: Tyler Glasnow (1, on rehab assignment), Kevin Newman (11), Clay Holmes (15), Barrett Barnes (20) and Tyler Eppler (28). Six players are on MLB.com's current update, including Glasnow (1) Newman (4), Holmes (12), Brandon Waddell (22), Eppler (24) and Barnes (30). This year's team previously featured four players that were on the original MLB.com midseason update: Austin Meadows (2, promoted to AAA), Elias Diaz (10, on rehab assignment) and Dovydas Neverauskas (26, promoted to AAA), plus Reese McGuire and Harold Ramirez, who were traded to Toronto in July. Four players are also featured on Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Glasnow (1), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24).
