YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped the second game of their four-game series to the Erie SeaWolves, 7-6. Altoona took a 3-1 lead in the bottom of the first inning with an **Edwin Espinal** sacrifice fly and a two-run double from **Barrett Barnes**, but Erie saw two-RBI games from Gustavo Nunez and Kody Eaves while Anthony Gose and Corey Jones each added a solo home run. Curve starter **Tyler Eppler** surrendered a career-worst 12 hits in dropping his tenth game of the season.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue their final homestand of the regular season with the third of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Curve are 12-7 this season against the SeaWolves and saw their won eight-game winning streak against Erie come to a close with Friday's loss. Altoona swept Erie in a three-game series at PNG Field from July 25-27.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Alex McRae** makes his 14th Double-A start for the Curve, and his second against Erie. Last time out, McRae tossed six relief innings for Tyler Glasnow in Harrisburg and earned his seventh win of the season, allowing one unearned run against the Sens on five hits. In his last start, McRae went the distance in the second game of a doubleheader in Portland on 8/17, setting a new career high with eight strikeouts. Over his last seven starts since July 14, McRae has gone 4-2 with a 3.14 ERA (15 ER/43.0 IP) after going 2-4 with a 10.25 ERA in first six starts. McRae was promoted to the Curve on June 10 from A-Adv. Bradenton, where he went 3-4 with a 2.69 ERA in twelve starts. McRae is in his third pro season after being selected in the tenth round in 2014 by the Pirates out of Jacksonville University, where he was a two-way player (pitcher, third base, first base, designated hitter). **For more on McRae, see page three.**

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Tyler Alexander makes his fifth start of the season for Erie, and his 23rd start overall. Last time out, Alexander took a no-decision against Richmond, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits in six innings. The second round draft pick from 2015 out of TCU began the year with Lakeland in the Florida State League and went 6-7 with a 2.21 ERA in 19 games (18 starts). Alexander's only Double-A win came on 8/17 in Harrisburg, when he allowed just one run on four hits in seven innings of work.

PLAYOFF HUNT: The Curve are 11 games over .500. Altoona, Akron and Harrisburg are leading the chase for the two postseason spots from the Western Division. The Curve's "Magic Number" to clinch a playoff spot is currently nine. The Curve took over first place in the division for the first time on June 26, and have held that spot in the standings for 48 of their 55 games since. Akron is in second and saw a ten-game winning streak end on Thursday. Last year, the Curve won the Western Division Wild Card and went to the playoffs for the first time since their E.L. title run in 2010. They have not appeared in consecutive postseasons since the first four playoff trips in franchise history in four straight years from 2003-06.

NOT SO DREARY AGAINST ERIE: The Curve are 27-12 against the SeaWolves since the start of the 2015 season, including starting the season 8-0 against Erie last year. The Curve won eight straight games against the SeaWolves prior to Altoona's 7-6 loss on Friday, including a three-game sweep in Erie from July 8-10 and a three-game sweep at PNG Field from July 25-27.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve have outscored opponents 116-85 in the 8th inning or later this season and have 34 total come-from-behind wins. The Curve have won seven times this year after trailing through eight innings, the most in the league. The two closest teams in that category, New Hampshire and Reading, have each done it four times.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** leads active Eastern League relievers with 22 saves this year, second-most overall, sits first with 40 games finished and third in total games pitched with 46. His 22 saves are tied for fourth-most in a single season in Altoona franchise history. He is tied for the second-most saves for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007 behind only the 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. The Curve are 54-1 when leading heading into the ninth inning, the best in the E.L.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 51 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (47), Quincy Latimore (44), Dean Green (41), Dylan Cozens (37), Rhys Hoskins (36), Steven Moya (35).

BARNES BOUNCING BACK: After hitting just one homer through his first 100 games, Barnes hit four home runs in six games from August 9-16 and has hit six homers in 13 games since August 9. He hit .249 in his first 70 games through July 4, but has raised his average to .310, fourth-best in the league. In his last 45 games since July 5, Barnes has hit .401 (61/152), tops in the E.L. during that span, with seven homers, 14 doubles and 27 RBIs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's preseason top 30 Pirates prospects: **Tyler Glasnow** (1, on rehab assignment), **Kevin Newman** (11), **Clay Holmes** (15), **Barrett Barnes** (20) and **Tyler Eppler** (28). Six players are on MLB.com's current update, including Glasnow (1) Newman (4), Holmes (12), **Brandon Waddell** (22), Eppler (24) and Barnes (30). This year's team previously featured four players that were on the original MLB.com midseason update: **Austin Meadows** (2, promoted to AAA), **Elias Diaz** (10, on rehab assignment) and **Dovydas Neverauskas** (26, promoted to AAA), plus **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**, who were traded to Toronto in July. Four players are also featured on *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospect list: Glasnow (1), Newman (8) Holmes (19), Barnes (24).
