YESTERDAY: The RubberDucks stormed ahead with six runs in the seventh and three runs in the ninth to defeat the Curve, 12-8, in Game 1 of the Western Division Series. The Curve took a 5-1 lead through two innings and were in front 7-3 heading into the eighth inning before the rally by Akron. **Anderson Feliz** hit a pair of home runs and **Stetson Allie** went deep. **Jin-De Jhang** had three hits, including two doubles, and drove in a pair of runs.

TONIGHT: The Curve meet the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, for Game Two of the 2016 Eastern League Western Division Series. Akron leads the best-of-five series, 1-0. Tonight's game is the last at Peoples Natural Gas Field before the series shifts to Canal Park in Akron for the final three games.

THE CURVE: The Curve finished the season 12 games over .500 and a half-game behind Akron in the Western Division, clinching a wild card berth with a 2-0, ten-inning win over Richmond on Monday afternoon. This year marks the first time the Curve have made back-to-back postseasons since going to four straight from 2003-2006, the first four playoff appearances in team history. Altoona took over first place in the Western Division for the first time on June 26, and held that spot for 55 of 63 games until Akron took it on the next-to-last day of the season. The Curve went 22-9 at home in their last 31 home games from June 30 to the end of the regular season, including 3-1 against Akron.

THE RUBBERDUCKS: The RubberDucks dominated the first half of the season, but fell to 56-59 through August 7. They went 21-5 over their last 26 games to storm back into the playoff mix and take the Western Division's regular-season crown. The 'Ducks were seven games out of first place on August 12, but went 18-4 the rest of the way to take over first place from Altoona on September 4, including an 11-game winning streak from Aug. 12-24. The RubberDucks won the final four games of their regular season. Including last night, Akron has hit .280 against the Curve in 22 games, but just .237 against the other 10 teams in the Eastern League.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Clay Holmes** made 26 starts this season for the Curve. We went 2-2 with a 7.23 ERA against the 'Ducks this year in five starts. In his last start, Holmes worked around five walks to hold Richmond to two earned runs in 5.2 innings on Friday. Holmes is tied for fifth in the Eastern League with a career-best 10 wins. In 14 starts since June 16, Holmes went 5-5 with a 3.03 ERA (25 ER/71.1 IP). Rated as the Pirates' 12th-ranked prospect entering this season, Holmes only pitched in nine games in 2015 after missing all of 2014 due to Tommy John surgery. *For more on Holmes, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Julian Merryweather made 13 Double-A starts for Akron this year. Last time out, he allowed one earned run on six hits over seven innings in a no-decision at Erie last Wednesday. Over his last nine starts dating back to July 19, Merryweather went 4-2 with a 2.55 ERA (15 ER/53 IP). He began the year with A-Adv. Lynchburg, where he went 8-2 with a 1.03 ERA over 11 starts with 58 strikeouts and 15 walks in 61.0 innings. Merryweather is in his third professional season after being selected by Cleveland in the fifth round of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma Baptist.

ALTOONA VS. AKRON PLAYOFF HISTORY: 2016 marks the seventh postseason appearance in Altoona franchise history and the fifth as a wild card qualifier. The Curve have faced Akron in the Division Series three previous times, with the then-Aeros taking all three sets. In Altoona's first playoff series in 2003, Akron won the series, 3-1. The two teams met again in 2005, and Akron eliminated Altoona in five games. They met again in 2006, with the series again going five games before a 5-2 win by the Aeros in the final game. The Curve are 4-3 in playoff games at home against Akron, with a 1-7 mark at Canal Park.

COMEBACK CURVE: The Curve had 36 total come-from-behind wins this season. They have won seven times this year after trailing through eight innings, the most in the league (Five other teams did it four times).

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves this year, fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished first with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. The Curve are 58-2 when leading heading into the ninth inning, and Akron went 1-50 when trailing entering the ninth.

BOMBS AWAY: Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 54 home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (50), Quincy Latimore (45), Dean Green (41), Dylan Cozens (40), Rhys Hoskins (38) and Steven Moya (35).

BIG SECOND HALF FOR BARNES: After hitting just one homer through his first 100 games, Barrett Barnes hit four home runs in six games from August 9-16 and has hit eight homers in 23 games since August 9. He hit .249 in his first 70 games through July 4, but raised his average to .308, sixth-best in the league. In his last 54 games after July 5, Barnes hit .378 (68/180), tops in the E.L. during that span, with eight homers, 16 doubles and 31 RBIs. Barnes was named the Eastern League Player of the Week twice in the month of August, winning the honor for the week of August 15 and was named Player of the Week again last Monday. He was named E.L. Player of the Month for August earlier today.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Nemwan** (4), **Nick Kingham** (10), **Clay Holmes** (11), **Brandon Waddell** (19), **Tyler Eppler** (21) and **Barrett Barnes** (26). This year's team previously included four other players ranked in MLB.com's top 30, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Austin Meadows** (2), **Elias Diaz** (9), **Dovydas Neverauskas** (23), **Jose Osuna** (28) and **Edgar Santana** (29), plus **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**, who were ranked fifth and sixth respectively prior to being traded to Toronto in July.
