**FRIDAY:** Akron scored five runs between the seventh and eighth to take Game 3 of the Western Division Series, 9-4. The 'Ducks scored the go-ahead run on a throwing error by Altoona catcher **Tomas Morales** in the seventh. Yan Gomes doubled in a run in the eighth and Mike Papi hit a three-run homer in the inning. After falling behind 4-0 through three, the Curve rallied to score four runs in the fourth. **Jon Schwind** started the scoring with an RBI single and **Chris Diaz** followed with a bases-loaded walk. **Kevin Newman** tied the score with a two-run double.

**TONIGHT:** The Curve meet the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, for Game Four of the 2016 Eastern League Western Division Series. Akron leads the series, 2-1. Tonight's game is the second of three possible games at Canal Park to finish the series. The Curve need a win to force a decisive Game 5.

**THE CURVE:** The Curve finished the season 12 games over .500 and a half-game behind Akron in the Western Division, clinching a wild card berth with a 2-0, ten-inning win over Richmond on Monday afternoon. This year marks the first time the Curve have made back-to-back postseasons since going to four straight from 2003-2006, the first four playoff appearances in team history. Altoona took over first place in the Western Division for the first time on June 26, and held that spot for 55 of 63 games until Akron took it on the next-to-last day of the season.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS:** The RubberDucks opened the season 35-13 with a 7.5-game lead in the division on May 28, but went on a 12-game losing streak from June 5-16, starting a stretch of posting an 18-42 record over 60 games, dropping to 56-59 on August 7 and falling seven games behind the first-place Curve. Akron went 21-5 over their last 26 games, including an 11-game winning streak from Aug. 12-24, to storm back into the playoff mix and take the Western Division's regular-season crown, taking over first place from Altoona on September 4. The RubberDucks won the final four games of their regular season at home against Bowie. Including the postseason, Akron has hit .279 (227/813) against the Curve in 23 games, but just .237 against the other 10 teams in the Eastern League.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Lefty **Brandon Waddell** made 20 starts for the Curve this year and pitched out of the bullpen twice. He last faced Akron on July 23 at PNC Field, earning a win after allowing one earned run over six innings, working around six hits and five walks. In three starts against Akron, he went 1-1 with a 3.68 ERA. Waddell began the season with A-Adv. Bradenton and went 4-0 in five starts with a 0.93 ERA, picking up a win in each of his last four outings prior to his promotion to Double-A on May 3. Waddell won the FSL Player of the Month Award for April and won his first three starts with Altoona, stretching his streak to seven straight starts won overall. He was drafted in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Virginia after leading the Cavaliers to the 2015 College World Series title, pitching seven innings in the championship clincher against Vanderbilt. *For more on Waddell, see page two.*

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander Nick Pasquale made 13 starts this year for the RubberDucks. He pitched against the Curve once, picking up a loss on July 7 at Canal Park after allowing four runs (two earned) over six innings. He began the season with A-Adv. Lynchburg, going 2-1 with a 2.03 ERA in eight games. Pasquale also pitched one game for Triple-A Columbus, working 6.2 scoreless innings and holding Pawtucket to two hits on July 22.

**ALTOONA VS. AKRON PLAYOFF HISTORY:** 2016 marks the seventh postseason appearance in Altoona franchise history and the fifth as a wild card qualifier. The Curve have faced Akron in the Division Series three previous times, with the then-Aeros taking all three sets. In Altoona's first playoff series in 2003, Akron won the series, 3-1. The two teams met again in 2005, and Akron eliminated Altoona in five games. They met again in 2006, with the series again going five games before a 5-2 win by the Aeros in the final game. The Curve are 5-3 in playoff games at home against Akron, with a 1-8 mark at Canal Park. Akron has advanced to the Eastern League Championship Series nine times in their 15 previous playoff appearances and won four league titles (2003, 2005, 2009, 2012).

**COMEBACK CURVE:** The Curve had 36 total come-from-behind wins this season. They have won seven times this year after trailing through eight innings, the most in the league (Five other teams did it four times).

**DU-RAP IT UP:** Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves this year, fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished first with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. The Curve are 58-2 when leading heading into the ninth inning, and Akron went 1-50 when trailing entering the ninth.

**BOMBS AWAY:** Curve outfielder **Stetson Allie** now sits in third place on the Curve's all-time list with 54 regular-season home runs, dating back to 2014. Allie moved ahead of Ray Sadler with his 42nd career homer on May 27 at Bowie for third all-time. Josh Bonifay and Adam Hyzdu both share the franchise record with 55 homers hit while wearing an Altoona jersey. Dating back to the start of the 2014 season, Allie leads the Eastern League in home runs, ahead of Jake Fox (50), Quincy Latimore (45), Dean Green (41), Dylan Cozens (40), Rhys Hoskins (38) and Steven Moya (35).

**BIG SECOND HALF FOR BARNES:** After hitting just one homer through his first 100 games, Barrett Barnes hit four home runs in six games from August 9-16 and has hit eight homers in 23 games since August 9. He hit .249 in his first 70 games through July 4, but raised his average to .308, sixth-best in the league. In his last 54 games after July 5, Barnes hit .378 (68/180), tops in the E.L. during that span, with eight homers, 16 doubles and 31 RBIs. Barnes was named the Eastern League Player of the Week twice in the month of August, winning the honor for the week of August 15 and was named Player of the Week again last Monday. He was named E.L. Player of the Month for August.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Nemwan** (4), **Nick Kingham** (10), **Clay Holmes** (11), **Brandon Waddell** (19), **Tyler Eppler** (21) and **Barrett Barnes** (26). This year's team previously included four other players ranked in MLB.com's top 30, including **Tyler Glasnow** (1), **Austin Meadows** (2), **Elias Diaz** (9), **Dovydas Neverauskas** (23), **Jose Osuna** (28) and **Edgar Santana** (29), plus **Reese McGuire** and **Harold Ramirez**, who were ranked fifth and sixth respectively prior to being traded to Toronto in July.
