YESTERDAY: Alex McRae set a new career high with nine strikeouts as the Curve offense capitalized on five Harrisburg errors in a 5-3 win. Pablo Reyes singled in Kevin Newman in the first and then scored on a sac fly by Edwin Espinal. After a run by the Senators in the bottom of the first, the Curve extended the lead in the third on an RBI single by Espinal and added another on a throwing error. Newman singled in a run in the sixth. McRae allowed one run over five frames. Tate Scioneaux pitched two scoreless innings in his Double-A debut and Montana DuRapau closed out the save in the ninth.

TONIGHT: The Curve continue the season-opening series against the Harrisburg Senators with a double-header, making up the rain-postponed game on Thursday night. The two teams finished a half-game apart in 2016, with Harrisburg narrowly missing the playoffs. 2017 marks the third consecutive season that the Curve and Senators have opened the season against each other.

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Brandon Waddell takes the mound for the first time in 2017 in game one. He began last season with A-Adv. Bradenton and went 4-0 with a 0.93 ERA in five starts. He was 7-9 with a 4.12 ERA in 22 outings (20 starts) for the Curve after being promoted in May. He went 3-0 with a 2.78 ERA in his first four Eastern League starts. Waddell was a 2016 MiLB.com Pittsburgh Organization All-Star. He was drafted in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Virginia, where he picked up a win in the clinching game of the 2015 College World Series against Vanderbilt. *For more on Waddell, see page two.*

Right-hander **Austin Coley** makes his Double-A debut in game two. He pitched with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders last season and went 12-10 with a 4.65 ERA last year. In 2015, Coley led the South Atlantic League and the Pirates organization with 16 wins while pitching for Single-A West Virginia. Coley was drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round of the 2014 draft out of Belmont. *For more on Coley, see page three.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Erick Fedde makes his first start of 2017. He enters the 2017 ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Nationals organization and the No. 58 overall prospect on MLB.com. Washington selected him in the first round (18th overall) in 2014 out of UNLV, even though he had Tommy John surgery earlier that year. He did not make his professional debut until June 2015. He made his Double-A debut last year for the Senators at PNG Field on August 10, allowing one run on five hits over seven innings.

Right-hander Mark Blackmar starts game two for the Senators. He was originally drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in 2011 in the 16th round out of Temple College in Texas. He was traded to the Chicago White Sox along with RHP Miguel Chalas for outfielder Alejandro De Aza in August 2014. He made 26 Double-A starts for the Birmingham Barons in 2015, going 6-8 with a 3.63 ERA before being released prior to the 2016 season. Blackmar began 2016 with the independent Long Island Ducks, going 6-2 with a 2.72 ERA in 13 starts before the Nationals signed him as a free agent in July. He faced the Curve on August 11 and allowed eight earned runs over six innings and again on August 22, when he allowed seven earned runs in six innings.

ROSTER: The 2017 Curve roster has 10 players that have worn an Altoona uniform prior to this season. 14 are playing at the Double-A level for the first time in their careers. There are 13 pitchers and 12 position players on the Curve roster. 24 of the 25 players were originally signed or drafted by the Pirates, with the lone exception being catcher Zane Chavez. 23 players have played with only the Pirates organization in their professional careers (RHP Buddy Borden spent time in the Tampa Bay organization).

FAMILIAR FACES: The ten players who were with the Curve last year include pitchers **Montana DuRapau, John Kuchno, Jared Lakind, Alex McRae, Miguel Rosario** and **Brandon Waddell**, catcher **Tomas Morales**, infielders **Edwin Espinal** and **Kevin Newman**, as well as outfielder **Elvis Escobar**. DuRapau and Kuchno also spent time on the Altoona roster in 2015. Kuchno and Morales are the only two players on the team with an experience above the Double-A level.

A NEW SKIPPER: For the third consecutive season, the Curve will led by a brand new manager in 2017. Indiana, Pa. native Michael Ryan takes over as the manager for the Curve this year after leading the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders to a championship in the Florida State League last season. Ryan was a coach with the Curve in 2012 before spending the next two years managing the West Virginia Power in the South Atlantic League. He moved up to Bradenton in 2015 for the first of his two seasons there. Ryan was drafted by the Minnesota Twins out of Indiana Area High School in 1996 and he went on to play in 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors with the Twins from 2002-05 and the Los Angeles Angels in 2010. The last two managers, Tom Prince and Joey Cora, are now members of the Pirates' major league coaching staff.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished first in the EL with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. DuRapau picked up a save on Opening Night at Harrisburg, the 23rd of his career, moving him into sole possession of fourth place on the franchise's all-time list.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features four of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Nemwan** (4), **Yeudy Garcia** (13), **Brandon Waddell** (17) and **Kevin Kramer** (21). The same four players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17) and Kramer (21). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. He closed out his playing career with Altoona in 2012, playing 15 games, along with one game for Triple-A Indianapolis.

In his sixth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens joins Altoona for the first time in 2017. He spent the last two years in Bradenton, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last four seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
