**YESTERDAY:** The Curve swept a double-header, 6-4 and 4-1, against the Akron RubberDucks at Canal Park. Connor Joe had three hits and four RBIs in game one, including a two-run, go-ahead double in the fifth. Yeudy Garcia picked up his first Double-A win after allowing two unearned runs in five innings. Tate Scioneaux allowed his first runs of the season but picked up his first save. In game two, Jordan Luplow started the scoring with a two-run homer in the second, his team-leading fifth home run of the season. Kevin Newman and Edwin Espinal also drove in runs for the Curve. Austin Coley earned his first Double-A win with two scoreless innings.

**TODAY:** The Curve continue the six-game road trip with the first of three games against the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. Altoona won two of three games in Richmond from April 10-12 and swept a rain-shortened, two-game series at PNG Field last week. Since the start of the 2016 season, the Curve have gone 20-7 against the Flying Squirrels, including 13 straight during a span last season.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Alex McRae takes the hill for his sixth start of the year and second against Richmond. Last time out, he allowed two earned runs over seven innings and improved to 2-0 on the season with a win against Harrisburg last Sunday at PNG Field. He last faced Richmond on April 12 at The Diamond and worked six scoreless innings, allowing four hits and combining with John Kuchno for a shutout win. The Curve have won each of his five starts so far this year. He was the Opening Day starter for the Curve, working five innings and allowing one run with nine strikeouts on April 7 at Harrisburg. Last season, McRae joined the Curve in late-June after making 12 starts in the Florida State League. After going 2-4 with a 10.25 ERA in his first six starts with Altoona, McRae went 6-2 with a 2.47 ERA (17 ER/62.0 IP) over his last ten outings (nine starts) from July 14-September 1. A native of Milwaukee, McRae is in his fourth professional season after being drafted by the Pirates in the tenth round out of Jacksonville University in 2014, where he played first and third base along with pitching. **Over 15 outings (14 starts) since July 14, 2017, McRae has gone 9-2 with a 2.36 ERA (24 ER/91.2 IP). **FOR RICHMOND:** RHP Jordan Johnson makes his fourth start of the season and sixth overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels. He has faced the Curve twice this year, including his most recent start on Wednesday, when he allowed four earned runs over 5.2 innings in a loss at PNG Field. He also pitched against the Curve on April 11 at The Diamond in his first start of the year and allowed one earned run over four innings with four strikeouts. Johnson is ranked by MLB.com as the Giants' ninth-best prospect. He was drafted in the 23rd round out of Cal State Northridge, where he missed most of his first two seasons after having Tommy John surgery and went 3-6 with a 4.33 ERA as a redshirt sophomore in 2014.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:** Curve relievers have been tough to hit this season. Sean Keselica has held hitters to a .080 batting average, best among relievers in the league. Buddy Borden (.104/3rd) is not far behind. Tate Scioneaux is tied for the E.L. lead among all pitchers with four wins. Curve relievers (excluding position player Chase Simpson, who has pitched one game) have combined to post a 1.75 ERA (19 ER/97.2 IP) and a 0.96 WHIP (69 H + 25 BB/97.2 IP). Current members of the bullpen active on the Curve roster have combined to post an 8-1 record with a 1.02 ERA (10 ER/88.1 IP) and a 0.89 WHIP (54 H + 25 BB / 88.1 IP) with 85 strikeouts. The Curve are 11-0 this season when leading through seven innings this season.

**KRAMERICA INDUSTRIES:** Curve second baseman Kevin Kramer is off to a hot start in his first Double-A debut campaign, hitting .386 (34/88) through his first 24 games, third-best in the league, including three home runs. A 2013 College World Series champion at UCLA and a second-round draft pick of the Pirates in 2015, Kramer is currently first in the Eastern League with a .491 on-base percentage and first with a .636 slugging percentage. He has reached base in all 24 games he has played to begin the season, the longest active streak in the Eastern League this season, and has at least one hit in 22 of his 24 games.

**HELLO, NEWMAN:** Shortstop Kevin Newman is the top-ranked prospect on this year's Curve roster, rated at No. 4 in the Pirates organization by both MLB.com and Baseball America. He made his Double-A debut with the Curve last season and led the Pirates' organization with a .320 overall batting average in his first full professional season, including a .288 mark with the Curve in 61 games. Newman was selected in the first round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of the University of Arizona.

**DU-RAP IT UP:** Altoona closer Montana DuRapau finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished last season first in the EL with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. DuRapau picked up a save Tuesday and is now tied with Brandon Knight (2006) for second place on the Curve's all-time saves list with 27, trailing only Matt Peterson (29, 2003-06). **DuRapau is second in the E.L. with six saves and tied for third with eight games finished.**
