**YESTERDAY:** The Curve dropped their fifth straight game, 2-0, to the Akron RubberDucks. Akron completed a four-game sweep and handed the Curve their second shutout loss of the week. The 'Ducks scored their only two runs in the top of the sixth inning on a two-out, two-run double by Eric Haase. On the play, Elvis Escobar was in position to make an inning-ending catch, but his feet slipped from under him and the ball dropped to the ground. Brandon Waddell put together his longest outing of the season, working 5.2 innings and allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Tate Scioneaux allowed the two inherited runners to score and worked 2.1 scoreless innings of his own. Miguel Rosario pitched a scoreless ninth with two strikeouts. Akron starter Thomas Pannone pitched 6.1 scoreless innings and has not allowed an earned run in seven of his eight starts this year between Akron and A-Adv. Lynchburg.

**TODAY:** The Curve play the first of a four-game road series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Curve are coming off being swept in four games by Akron at home. The SeaWolves dropped two of their in their last series to Harrisburg at home and have lost seven of nine overall. The series is the fourth between these two teams. The Curve have won two-of-three games in each of the first three sets between the clubs. The Curve went 13-7 against the SeaWolves last year and hold a 34-15 record against them since the start of the 2015 season.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **J.T. Brubaker** makes his fifth start of the season and his eighth overall appearance. He is facing Erie for the fourth time overall and his third start. He pitched 6.2 scoreless innings against Richmond on May 2, but went on the DL after the outing with a blister on his pitching index finger. He returned on May 16 and made the first of two relief appearances, in which he combined to throw five innings and allow three earned runs. Brubaker began 2016 with Single-A West Virginia, where he went 4-5 with a 3.48 ERA in 12 starts. He was promoted to A-Adv. Bradenton in June and went 2-6 with a 5.32 ERA over 14 starts. The Pirates selected Brubaker in the sixth round of the 2015 draft out of the University of Akron. He went 6-4 with a 2.82 in his professional debut season with the West Virginia Black Bears in 2015 en route to a New York-Penn League championship. *For more on Brubaker, see page two.*

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Artie Lewicki makes his ninth start of the second and third against the Curve. Last time out, he allowed two earned runs over 5.2 innings in a loss at PNG Field on Saturday. He also faced the Curve on April 28, allowing two earned runs in 5.1 innings in a no-decision. Lewicki was drafted by the Tigers in the eighth round in 2014 out of the University of Virginia. He made 12 starts for the SeaWolves last year and went 1-7 with a 3.48 ERA.

**FORGETTABLE FIVE:** The Curve have lost five consecutive games, their longest losing streak since dropping seven in a row from July 15-21, 2016. Over those five games, the Curve are batting .181 (28/155) as a team. The offense has scored seven total runs (1.4/game). The pitching staff has posted a 2.80 ERA (14 ER/45.0 IP) during the streak. Starting pitchers have been charged with four of the five losses.

**AIR JORDAN:** Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** is tied for sixth in the E.L. with eight home runs on the season. His .528 slugging percentage is eighth in the league. He is currently on an 11-game hitting streak, tied for the third-longest on the team this year and the second-longest active streak in the league. During the streak, he is batting .378 (14/37) with a double, two homers and three RBIs.

**HEY JOE!:** First baseman/right fielder **Connor Joe** is batting .333 (32/96) in 29 games since April 18 with seven doubles, two triples, two homers and 17 RBIs, raising his average from .194 to .299. He has the sixth-best on-base percentage (.407) and has the second-best TPA/SO ratio (10.07). Over his last nine games since May 17, Joe is batting .379 (11/27) with four doubles, two triples, five walks and four RBIs.

**PUTTING IT IN PLAY:** The Curve offense has the fewest strikeouts in the Eastern League with 281 and have four of the nine toughest hitters to strike out in the league. **Edwin Espinal** has the lowest K rate (8.7%) in the E.L. He's followed by **Connor Joe** (2nd/10.2%), **Pablo Reyes** (3rd/10.3%), **Kevin Newman** (10th/13.2%) and **Jordan Luplow** (11th/13.2%).

**KRAMERICA INDUSTRIES:** Curve second baseman **Kevin Kramer** is hitting .327 (49/150), fifth-best in the league. He is ranked third in the league with a .414 on-base percentage, fourth with a .547 slugging percentage, third with 26 runs scored and tied for first with 15 doubles. He has also been hit by a pitch a league-leading eight times. He has reached base in 35 of 39 games he has played and has at least one hit in 32 of his 39 games. Over his last five games, Kramer is hitting .105 (2/19) with nine strikeouts.

**EDWINNING:** 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 29 RBIs. He has the best strikeout rate in the league (11.50 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just once.

**VIEW FROM THE TOP:** The Curve have held first place for 38 of their 44 games this season and 31 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 72 of 80 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

**DU-RAP IT UP:** Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished last season first in the EL with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. With his six-out save on Friday, DuRapau now sits alone with 30 career saves, passing Matt Peterson (2003-06) for the most in Curve franchise history. DuRapau is second in the E.L. with eight saves and tied for first with 14 games finished.

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. He closed out his playing career with Altoona in 2012, playing 15 games, along with one game for Triple-A Indianapolis.

In his sixth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens joins Altoona for the first time in 2017. He spent the last two years in Bradenton, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last four seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
