YESTERDAY: The Curve scored the go-ahead run in the eighth to beat the SeaWolves, 3-2. Making the first start of his rehab assignment, Jameson Taillon pitched three scoreless innings, allowing one hit and one run with six strikeouts. Jackson Williams gave the Curve a 1-0 lead in the third with a solo homer and Edwin Espinal added another solo home run in the fourth. The SeaWolves evened the score with a two-run homer by Gabriel Quintana in the fifth. The Curve took a 3-2 lead in the eighth after Jin-De Jhang reached on a single to left field and an error by Dominic Ficociello allowed Espinal to score from first. Jared Lakind worked three scoreless innings and picked up his first win of the season. Tate Scioneaux stranded the tying run at third in the ninth to pick up his third save.

TODAY: The Curve play the finale of a four-game road series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The series is the fourth between Altoona and Erie, and the Curve have won two-of-three games in each of the first three sets. The Curve went 13-7 against the SeaWolves last year and hold a 36-16 record against them since the start of the 2015 season.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Alex McRae makes his tenth start of the season for the Curve and his fourth against the SeaWolves. Last time out, McRae allowed three earned runs in seven innings and was charged with his first loss of the year against Akron on Wednesday. He last faced the SeaWolves on May 19 and allowed six runs (five earned), including two homers, and recorded just one out in a no-decision. Last season, McRae joined the Curve in late-June after making 12 starts in the Florida State League. After going 2-4 with a 10.25 ERA in his first six starts with Altoona, McRae went 6-2 with a 2.47 ERA (17 ER/62.0 IP) over his last ten outings (nine starts) from July 14-September 1. A native of Milwaukee, McRae is in his fourth professional season after being drafted by the Pirates in the tenth round out of Jacksonville University in 2014, where he played first and third base along with pitching. Over 19 outings (18 starts) since July 14, 2016, McRae has gone 9-3 with a 2.95 ERA (37 ER/113 IP). For more on McRae, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander A.J. Ladwig makes his fourth start of the season for the SeaWolves. Last time out, he allowed five runs for the second straight start in just 1.2 innings on Monday against Harrisburg. He made his Double-A debut on May 11 at Hartford and picked up a win, allowing one run over six innings. Ladwig started the year with A-Adv. Lakeland and went 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA over five starts. He was called to Triple-A Toledo on May 2 and made his debut for the Mud Hens at Indianapolis that day, picking up a loss after allowing six runs on 12 hits over five innings. Ladwig was selected by the Tigers in the 14th round out of Wichita State in 2014, where he was teammates with current Curve infielder Chase Simpson and former Curve relief pitcher Josh Smith.

PITCH PERFECT: Over the last nine games since May 20, the Curve pitching staff has posted a 2.48 ERA (22 ER/80.0 IP). Opponents have scored 23 runs in that stretch (2.6/game) and have not scored more than four runs in a single

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder Jordan Luplow is tied for sixth in the E.L. with eight home runs on the season. His .503 slugging percentage is eleventh in the league. On Friday, his 11-game hitting streak was snapped. It was tied for the third-longest on the team this year it was the second-longest active streak in the league. During the streak, Luplow hit .378 with a double, two homers and three RBIs.

HEY JOE!: First baseman/right fielder **Connor Joe** is batting .330 (36/109) in 32 games since April 18 with eight doubles, two triples, three homers and 19 RBIs, raising his average from .194 to .300, He has the sixth-best on-base percentage (.399) and has the second-best TPA/SO ratio (10.25). Over his last 12 games since May 17, Joe is batting .375 (15/40) with five doubles, two triples, a homer, five walks and six RBIs.

PUTTING IT IN PLAY: The Curve offense has the fewest strikeouts in the Eastern League with 302 and have the three of the five toughest hitters to strike out in the league. Edwin Espinal has the lowest K rate (9.4%) in the E.L. He's followed by Connor Joe (2nd/10%), Pablo Reyes (5th/11.5%).

KRAMERICA INDUSTRIES: Curve second baseman Kevin Kramer is hitting .319 (52/163), seventh-best in the league. He is ranked third in the league with a .404 on-base percentage, seventh with a .528 slugging percentage, and second with 16 doubles. He has also been hit by a pitch a league-leading eight times. He has reached base in 37 of 42 games he has played and has at least one hit in 33 of his 42 games. Over his last eight games, Kramer is hitting .156 (5/32)

WY NOT: In his last 14 games since May 9, Wyatt Mathisen is batting .386 with one homer and five RBIs. During that stretch, he has raised his season batting average from .274 to .321.

ROYAL REYES: Beginning with a four-hit game on May 9, Pablo Reyes is batting .357 with five doubles and nine RBIs over his last 15 games.

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star Edwin Espinal leads the team with 31 RBIs. He has the best strikeout rate in the league (10.88 TPA/SO) and had multiple $\,$ strikeouts in a game just twice. His .312 batting average is the ninth-best in the Eastern League.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 41 of their 47 games this season and 34 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 75 of 83 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer Montana DuRapau finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007 behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished last season first in the EL with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. With his six-out save on May 19, DuRapau now sits alone with 30 career saves, passing Matt Peterson (2003-06) for the most in Curve franchise history. DuRapau is tied for second in the E.L. with eight saves and tied for first with 15 games finished.

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012.
