YESTERDAY: The Curve clubbed three home runs and beat the Harrisburg Senators, 4-3. Wyatt Mathisen started the scoring with a solo homer in the third and Edwin Espinal added to the lead with a two-run shot in the fourth. The Senators answered with two runs in the bottom of the fourth to pull within a run. Jordan Luplow hit a solo homer, his third straight game going deep, in the seventh. In the bottom of the inning, the Sens pulled back within a run, but Tate Scioneaux worked through the final two frames to pick up his fifth save of the year. Tanner Anderson allowed three runs over 6.2 innings to snap a personal six-game losing skid.

TODAY: The Curve play the second of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The Curve split a four-game series to open the series at FNB Field from April 7-9. The Curve won two of three games in Altoona from April 28-30. This series marks Altoona's last trip to Harrisburg this season. The Senators come to Altoona for three games July 17-19 and for four games to close out the regular season from September 1-4.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **J.T. Brubaker** makes his eighth start of the season and his tenth appearance of the year overall. He has faced the Senators one other time this season, picking up a loss on April 9 at FNB Field after allowing four runs in 5.1 innings. Last time out, Brubaker was hit with five earned runs in 4.0 innings in a no-decision against Akron on Thursday. Brubaker began 2016 with Single-A West Virginia, where he went 4-5 with a 3.48 ERA in 12 starts. He was promoted to A-Adv. Bradenton in June and went 2-6 with a 5.32 ERA over 14 starts. The Pirates selected Brubaker in the sixth round of the 2015 draft out of the University of Akron. He went 6-4 with a 2.82 in his professional debut season with the West Virginia Black Bears in 2015 en route to a New York-Penn League championship. *For more on Brubaker, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Jaron Long makes his 12th start of the season for the Senators and his third against the Curve. He was Harrisburg's Opening Day starter on April 7, allowing four runs (one earned) in 5.0 innings in a loss against the Curve. He also faced the Curve on April 30 at PNG Field, when he was charged with another loss after allowing three earned runs in 5.2 innings. Long is in his fourth consecutive season in the Eastern League. Originally a member of the New York Yankees organization, Long was signed as a minor league free agent by the Nationals on April 22, 2016, and he spent last year splitting time between Harrisburg and Triple-A Syracuse.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** sits tied for second in the E.L. with 14 home runs on the season. His .597 slugging percentage is second in the league, he sits third with 35 runs scored, fourth with 108 total bases, fourth with 27 extra-base hits. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for May 29-June 4, a span in which he hit .423 (11/26) with five home runs, two doubles, four walks, eight runs scored and six RBIs. He has hit six homers over his last eight games, all solo blasts. On Sunday, he hit his 13th home run of the year, surpassing his career high of 12 set in 2015 with Single-A West Virginia. Entering tonight's game Luplow has homered in three consecutive games.

POWER SURGE: On Tuesday, **Jordan Luplow** became the fastest player in Curve history to reach 14 homers to open a season, doing it in 52 games. When **Adam Hyzdu** set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 14th homer on June 22. **Brad Eldred** was the fastest to hit 14 homers overall, doing it in 32 games after joining the Curve in July 2004. Luplow's 14 homers are tied for the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when **Josh Bonifay** had 17 at the break, evening **Stetson Allie** (2014), **Jarek Cunningham** (2013) and **Andrew Lambo** (2013).

BOMB SQUAD: The Curve have hit 17 home runs over their last eleven games, with at least one homer in ten of those eleven games, including each of the last five. The team hit just 26 homers in their first 44 games.

WY NOT: In his last 21 games since May 9, **Wyatt Mathisen** is batting .333 (23/69) with three homers and nine RBIs. During that stretch, he has raised his season batting average from .274 to .305, tied for 12th-best in the league. His .395 on-base percentage is ranked third in the league.

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 34 RBIs, tied for seventh in the league. He has the third-best strikeout rate in the league (9.95 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just three times.

ROYAL REYES: Beginning with a four-hit game on May 9, **Pablo Reyes** is batting .325 (25/77) with six doubles and 13 RBIs over his last 20 games. He is batting .405 (17/42) with runners in scoring position this season. In 10 games hitting ninth in the order, Reyes is batting .294 (10/34), opposed to his .252 (31/123) average elsewhere in the order.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 49 of their 55 games this season and 42 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 82 of 90 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished last season first in the E.L. with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. With his six-out save on May 19, DuRapau now sits alone with 30 career saves, passing Matt Peterson (2003-06) for the most in Curve franchise history. DuRapau is fourth in the E.L. with eight saves and first with 17 games finished.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Nemman** (3), **Yeudy Garcia** (12), **Brandon Waddell** (16), **Kevin Kramer** (17), **Connor Joe** (28) and **Jordan Luplow** (30). Four players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17) and Kramer (21). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. He closed out his playing career with Altoona in 2012, playing 15 games, along with one game for Triple-A Indianapolis.

In his sixth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens joins Altoona for the first time in 2017. He spent the last two years in Bradenton, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last four seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
