YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped both games in their doubleheader against the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 6-2 and 3-2, and have now lost four straight games. In the first game, Richmond scored six runs in the second inning against Austin Coley. The Curve brought the tying run to the plate in the seventh, but could not even the score. In the second game, Richmond scored three runs in the first inning and held off a late Curve charge, stranding the tying run in scoring position in the seventh.

TODAY: The Curve conclude a four-game series against the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. The Curve took two-of-three in Richmond from April 10-12 and swept a two-game series at home May 2-3. The Squirrels took two-of-three at The Diamond May 8-10. The two teams meet for one more series, August 28-31 in Richmond. The Curve are 21-12 against the Flying Squirrels since the start of the 2016 season, including winning 13 straight against them last year.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Tanner Anderson** makes his eleventh start of the season and 12th overall appearance. Last time out, he picked up a win after allowing three earned runs on 10 hits over 6.2 innings at Harrisburg on Tuesday. Tonight's game marks his fourth outing against Richmond. He is 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (6 ER/13.2 IP) in his three previous starts against Richmond. He started the season 2-1 with a 1.98 ERA in five starts, and then he went 0-5 with a 7.48 ERA (18 ER/21.2 IP) in his next four outings (three starts) prior to his last start. He opened up 2017 in the Altoona rotation after primarily working as a reliever through his first two professional seasons. He worked three scoreless, one-hit innings in Game 4 of the FSL Championship Series last year and got the final out to clinch the league title. He worked as a starter in the Arizona Fall League, posting a 3.76 ERA in seven outings. Anderson is a native of Tampa and a graduate of Harvard University, where he pitched, played shortstop and third base and was an All-Ivy League second baseman. *For more on Anderson, see page two.*

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Jose Flores makes his fourth start of the season and 16th overall appearance. He moved into the Richmond rotation on May 24. Since then, he has posted an 0.75 ERA. He went 18.1 innings without allowing a run from April 30-June 4. The 28-year-old Venezuela native was originally signed by the Cleveland Indians in 2005. He has also spent time with the Athletics and Reds before signing with the Giants in December 2016.

WY NOT: In his last 24 games since May 9, **Wyatt Mathisen** is batting .358 (29/81) with three homers and nine RBIs. During that stretch, he has raised his season batting average from .274 to .321, sixth-best in the league. His .413 on-base percentage is ranked first in the league. He is currently on a nine-game hitting streak.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** sits tied for third in the E.L. with 14 home runs on the season. His .558 slugging percentage is fifth in the league, he sits third with 36 runs scored and tied for fifth with 27 extra-base hits. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for May 29-June 4, a span in which he hit .423 (11/26) with five home runs, two doubles, four walks, eight runs scored and six RBIs. He has hit six homers over his last eight games, all solo blasts. On Sunday, he hit his 13th home run of the year, surpassing his career high of 12 set in 2015 with Single-A West Virginia. Luplow homered in three consecutive games from Saturday through Tuesday.

POWER SURGE: On Tuesday, **Jordan Luplow** became the fastest player in Curve history to reach 14 homers to open a season, doing it in 52 games. When **Adam Hyzdu** set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 14th homer on June 22. **Brad Eldred** was the fastest to hit 14 homers overall, doing it in 32 games after joining the Curve in July 2004. Luplow's 14 homers are tied for the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when **Josh Bonifay** had 17 at the break, evening **Stetson Allie** (2014), **Jarek Cunningham** (2013) and **Andrew Lambo** (2013).

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 34 RBIs, tied for ninth in the league. He has the second-best strikeout rate in the league (10.18 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just three times.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 54 of their 60 games this season and 48 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 87 of 95 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished last season first in the E.L. with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. With his six-out save on May 19, DuRapau moved ahead of Matt Peterson (2003-06) with his 30th career save, the most in franchise history. Now with 31 career saves, DuRapau is tied for third in the E.L. with nine saves and sits first with 18 games finished.
