YESTERDAY: The Curve fell to the Sea Dogs, 7-4, after allowing six runs in the second inning. Connor Joe and Edwin Espinal each hit RBI doubles in the first to put the Curve ahead, 2-0, but the Sea Dogs responded with five runs to chase Yeudy Garcia from the game in the top of the second and added another in the frame against Jared Lakind. Rafael Devers hit a solo homer in the fourth to open the Portland advantage to 7-2. The Curve punched back with an RBI single by Joe and a sac fly from Espinal in the fifth, but were held off the bases the rest of the way. Portland pitching sat down the final 14 Curve batters of the game. Tate Scioneaux pitched three perfect innings and struck out three. Buddy Borden worked two scoreless innings.

TODAY: The Curve play the finale of a three-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series marks Portland's only trip to Altoona in 2017. The Curve play three games from August 15-17 against the Sea Dogs in Portland at Hadlock Field.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Alex McRae makes his 13th start of the year for the Curve. Last time out, he picked up a loss after allowing a franchise record-tying 14 hits and eight runs (seven earned) over 5.1 innings against Richmond on Friday. He has faced the Sea Dogs once in his career, working seven innings and allowed four runs with eight strikeouts while picking up a win on August 17, 2016. Last season, McRae joined the Curve in late-June after making 12 starts in the Florida State League. After going 2-4 with a 10.25 ERA in his first six starts with Altoona, McRae went 6-2 with a 2.47 ERA (17 ER/62.0 IP) over his last ten outings (nine starts) from July 14-September 1. A native of Milwaukee, McRae is in his fourth professional season after being drafted by the Pirates in the tenth round out of Jacksonville University in 2014, where he played first and third base along with pitching. FOR PORTLAND: Left-hander Trey Ball makes his 11th start of the year for the Sea Dogs. Last time out, he pitched 5.1 innings and allowed two runs in an no-decision against Erie on Saturday. Ball was the seventh-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of an Indiana high school. He was ranked as Boston's eighth-best prospect in 2013 by MLB.com, and he is currently ranked 29th in their system.

NO STEALING: The Curve are the third-best team in the league at throwing out potential base stealers, catching 24 of 52 attempts (.462). Jin-De Jhang has thrown out 72.7 percent (8/11) of attempts this year, the best in the E.L. among catchers with at least five attempts. J.T. Brubaker has the sixth-best rate of catching stolen base attempts among E.L. pitchers this year at 62.5 percent (5/8).

ELVIS HAS LEFT THE BUILDING: Outfielder Elvis Escobar clubbed his first homer of the season on Tuesday night. Over his last 15 games since May 28, Escobar is hitting .404 (19/47).

WY NOT: In his last 27 games from May 9-June 12, **Wyatt Mathisen** hit .353 (30/85), tops in the Pirates system over that stretch, with three homers and nine RBIs. Mathisen had his nine-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday and is hitless in his last eight at-bats. His .400 on-base percentage is ranked fourth in the league.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder Jordan Luplow sits tied for third in the E.L. with 14 home runs on the season. He sits third with 37 runs scored and tied for seventh with 27 extra-base hits. On May 6, **Jordan Luplow** became the fastest player in Curve history to reach 14 homers to open a season, doing it in 52 games. When **Adam Hyzdu** set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 14th homer on June 22. **Brad Eldred** was the fastest to hit 14 homers overall, doing it in 32 games after joining the Curve in July 2004. Luplow's 14 homers are tied for the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when **Josh Bonifay** had 17 at the break, evening **Stetson Allie** (2014), Jarek Cunningham (2013) and Andrew Lambo (2013).

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star Edwin Espinal leads the team with 38 RBIs, ninth in the league, and he is first on the team and third in the league with 19 doubles. He has the second-best strikeout rate in the league (10.30 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just three times.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 57 of their 63 games this season and 51 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 90 of 98 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve have three of the toughest relievers to hit in the league. Lefty Sean Keselica has held opposing hitters to a .159 average, second-best in the league. **Buddy Borden** has held batters to a .173 average, fourth-best in the E.L., and **Tate Scioneaux** has held hitters to a .175 average, fifth-best in the league. Scioneaux has the second-lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.03). Miguel Rosario has the best ERA of all relievers in the Eastern League (min.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer Montana DuRapau finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. It was tied for the second-most for a Curve pitcher in a season since 2007, behind only 24 by Noah Krol in 2011. He finished last season first in the E.L. with 43 games finished and fourth with 50 appearances. With his six-out save on May 19, DuRapau moved ahead of Matt Peterson (2003-06) with his 30th career save, the most in franchise history. Now with 31 career saves, DuRapau is tied for third in the E.L. with nine saves and sits first with 19

20 IP) at 0.88, which is fifth-best in all of MiLB among relievers with at least

30 innings pitched. Scioneaux (1.44) is fifth in the league (min. 20 IP) and Montana DuRapau is seventh (1.53).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: Kevin Nemwan (3), Yeudy Garcia (12), Brandon Waddell (16), Kevin Kramer (17), Connor Joe (28) and Jordan Luplow (30). Four players are also ranked in Baseball America's Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and Jin-De Jhang (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."
