YESTERDAY: The Curve had their three-game win streak snapped with a 2-1 loss to the Trenton Thunder. Dante Bichette gave the Thunder the lead with an RBI single in the fourth, and a second run scored on a double play ground-out by Rashad Crawford later in the inning. The Curve scored their only run on an RBI double by Edwin Espinal in the fifth. Dario Agrazal made his Double-A debut for the Curve and allowed two runs over four innings. Tate Scioneaux pitched four scoreless relief innings and Montana DuRapau pitched a scoreless ninth. Ronald Herrera pitched 5.2 innings and allowed one run to pick up his eighth win in nine starts made this year. The Curve left 11 on base.

TODAY: The Curve and Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, play the finale of a three-game series at PNG Field. This series marks the first match-ups this year between the two teams. The two teams meet again for a four-game set from July 27-30 in Altoona, three games in Trenton from August 4-6, and then another three-game series in Altoona from August 11-13. Last year, the Curve won two of the three games played in Altoona from May 9-11 and were swept in four games in Trenton from August 28-31. The Curve will be halfway through their season at the conclusion of tonight's game.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Austin Coley** makes his eleventh start and 16th overall appearance of the year for the Curve. He has the seventh-best ERA in the E.L. Last time out, Coley worked 3.1 scoreless innings and allowed two hits with no walks and four strikeouts before rain suspended Friday night's game in Hartford. From May 4-June 4, Coley posted a 1.85 ERA (7 ER/34 IP) in four starts and four relief outings. He pitched with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders last season and went 12-10 with a 4.65 ERA last year. In 2015, Coley led the South Atlantic League and the Pirates organization with 16 wins while pitching for Single-A West Virginia. Coley was drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round of the 2014 draft out of Belmont. *For more on Coley, see page two.*

FOR TRENTON: Left-hander Josh Rogers makes his sixth start of the season for the Thunder and 14th overall. Last time out, he picked up a win for the third straight outing after allowing one earned run on two hits over 6.0 innings against Erie on Saturday. He began the year with A-Adv. Tampa, where he went 4-3 with a 2.22 ERA in eight starts. He was named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on April 30.

ONE IS THE LONELIEST NUMBER: Dating back to a four-game series from July 28-31, 2016, the Curve have scored exactly one run in four of their last five games against the Trenton Thunder. The only exception was Tuesday's game, when the Curve scored a season-high four runs behind 14 hits.

NO STEALING: The Curve are the best team in the league at throwing out potential base stealers, catching 28 of 56 attempts (.500). **Jin-De Jhang** has thrown out 80 percent (12/15) of attempts this year, the best in the E.L. among catchers with at least five attempts. **J.T. Brubaker** has the third-best rate of catching stolen base attempts among E.L. pitchers this year at 70 percent (7/10).

ELVIS HAS LEFT THE BUILDING: Over his last 19 games since May 28, **Elvis Escobar** is hitting .431 (25/58) with a homer and six RBIs. On Tuesday against Trenton, Escobar matched two franchise records with five hits and two triples. His five hits were also a career high.

WY NOT: In his last 34 games since May 9, **Wyatt Mathisen** is hitting .325 (37/114), best in the best in the Pirates system over that stretch among qualifying hitters. His .391 overall on-base percentage is ranked fourth in the league.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** sits tied for second in the E.L. with 16 home runs on the season, fourth with a .559 slugging percentage and he is fourth with 41 runs scored. Luplow is the fastest player to hit 16 home runs to open a season, doing it in on June 20 in 68 games. When **Adam Hyzdu** set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 16th home run on June 26 in the team's 76th game. Luplow's 16 homers are the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when **Josh Bonifay** had 17 at the break. Luplow is currently on pace to hit 32 home runs this year, which would pass Hyzdu's single-season mark.

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 44 RBIs, tied for seventh in the league, and he is first on the team and tied for second in the league with 22 doubles. He has the best strikeout rate in the league (10.12 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just three times.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 63 of their 69 games this season and 57 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 96 of 104 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve have three of the toughest relievers to hit in the league. Lefty **Sean Keselica** has held opposing hitters to a .159 average when pitching out of the pen, second-best in the league. **Buddy Borden** has held batters to a .171 average, fourth-best in the E.L., Tate Scioneaux has the lowest BB/9 IP ratio (0.91) for relievers. Miguel Rosario has the best ERA of all relievers in the Eastern League (min. 20 IP) at 0.84, which is fourth-best in all of MiLB among relievers with at least 30 innings pitched. **Montana DuRapau** is second in ERA (1.44) out of the relievers in the league.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. With his six-out save on May 19, DuRapau moved ahead of Matt Peterson (2003-06) with his 30th career save, the most in franchise history. Now with 32 career saves, DuRapau is tied for first in the E.L. with 10 saves and sits first with 20 games finished.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Nemwan** (3), **Yeudy Garcia** (12), **Brandon Waddell** (16), **Kevin Kramer** (17), **Connor Joe** (28) and **Jordan Luplow** (30). Four players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. He closed out his playing career with Altoona in 2012, playing 15 games, along with one game for Triple-A Indianapolis.

In his sixth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens joins Altoona for the first time in 2017. He spent the last two years in Bradenton, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last four seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
