YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped their second straight game with a 5-2 loss to the Yard Goats. Hartford broke a 2-2 tie with two runs in the seventh and a run in the eighth. Trailing 2-0 heading to the bottom of the sixth, **Edwin Espinal** hit a two-run single to knot up the score. **Kevin Newman** went 3-for-5. **Austin Coley** allowed two runs over six innings and struck out five.

TODAY: The Curve and Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, play the middle game of a three-game series at PNG Field. Altoona took two out of the three games in Hartford last weekend, including a 6-5 win in the 11-inning finale last Sunday. This series marks the second of three sets between Altoona and Hartford this year. They will meet from August 21-23 at Hartford's Dunkin' Donuts Park. In their last series, the Curve split two of three games at home against Trenton. The Yard Goats dropped two of three games in Richmond and have lost four of their last six games overall.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Tanner Anderson** makes his 13th start of the year and his 14th overall appearance. Last time out, he picked up a win after working six scoreless innings in Hartford and allowing just two hits in a 58-pitch outing last Saturday. He has picked up a win in each of his last three starts after losing five straight outings before that. He started the season 2-1 with a 1.98 ERA in five starts, and he went 0-5 with a 7.48 ERA (18 ER/21.2 IP) in his next four outings (three starts). Anderson has evened back out, posting a 3-0 record and 2.41 ERA (5 ER/18.2 IP) over his last two starts. He opened up 2017 in the Altoona rotation after primarily working as a reliever through his first two professional seasons. He worked three scoreless, one-hit innings in Game 4 of the FSL Championship Series last year and got the final out to clinch the league title. He worked as a starter in the Arizona Fall League, posting a 3.76 ERA in seven outings. Anderson is a native of Tampa and a graduate of Harvard University, where he pitched, played shortstop and third base and was an All-Ivy League second baseman. *For more on Anderson, see page two.*

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander **Konner Wade** makes his fifth start and his 20th overall appearance for the Yard Goats this year. He last pitched on Sunday, working 1.2 innings out of the bullpen against the Curve without allowing a run. Wade was selected in the seventh round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Arizona by the Rockies.

NO STEALING: The Curve are the best team in the league at throwing out potential base stealers, catching 28 of 57 attempts (.491). **Jin-De Jhang** has thrown out 75 percent (12/16) of attempts this year, the best in the E.L. among catchers with at least five attempts. **J.T. Brubaker** has the third-best rate of catching stolen base attempts among E.L. pitchers this year at 70 percent (7/10) and **Alex McRae** is seventh at 56 percent (5/9).

ELVIS HAS LEFT THE BUILDING: Over his last 20 games since May 28, **Elvis Escobar** is hitting .419 (26/62), which leads the Pirates system in that stretch, with a homer and six RBIs. On Tuesday against Trenton, Escobar matched two franchise records with five hits and two triples. His five hits were also a career high.

WY NOT: Wyatt Mathisen's .302 batting average is the best in the Pirates' system this season and 14th-best in the Eastern League. His .388 overall on-base percentage is ranked fifth in the league.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** sits tied for second in the E.L. with 16 home runs on the season, fourth with a .558 slugging percentage and he is tied for with 42 runs scored. Luplow is the fastest player to hit 16 home runs to open a season, doing it in on June 20 in 68 games. When **Adam Hyzdu** set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 16th home run on June 26 in the team's 76th game. Luplow's 16 homers are the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when **Josh Bonifay** had 17 at the break. Luplow is currently on pace to hit 32 home runs this year, which would pass Hyzdu's single-season mark.

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 46 RBIs, tied for fourth in the league, and he is first on the team and tied for second in the league with 22 doubles. He has the best strikeout rate in the league (9.89 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just three times.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 64 of their 70 games this season and 58 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 97 of 105 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve have three of the toughest relievers to hit in the league. Lefty **Sean Keselica** has held opposing hitters to a .159 average when pitching out of the pen, second-best in the league. **Buddy Borden** has held batters to a .171 average, fourth-best in the E.L., **Tate Scioneaux** has the lowest BB/9 IP ratio (0.91) for relievers. **Miguel Rosario** has the best ERA of all relievers in the Eastern League (min. 20 IP) at 0.79, which is third-best in all of MiLB among relievers with at least 30 innings pitched. **Montana DuRapau** is second in ERA (1.44) out of the relievers in the league.

DU-RAP IT UP: Altoona closer **Montana DuRapau** finished second in the Eastern League with 22 saves last year, tied for fourth-most in Curve history. With his six-out save on May 19, DuRapau moved ahead of **Matt Peterson** (2003-06) with his 30th career save, the most in franchise history. Now with 32 career saves, DuRapau is tied for first in the E.L. with 10 saves and sits first with 21 games finished.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Newman** (3), **Yeudy Garcia** (12), **Brandon Waddell** (16), **Kevin Kramer** (17), **Connor Joe** (28) and **Jordan Luplow** (30). Four players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: **Newman** (4), **Garcia** (16), **Waddell** (17), **Kramer** (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."
