YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped game two of the series, 9-0. Altoona was shutout for the third time this season and the first time since May 25 against Akron. Cody Dickson made his first start of the season for the Curve and allowed five runs in three innings. Garabez Rosa finished 2-for-5 with four RBI for Bowie, including a three-run home run. Altoona was held to six hits in the loss and the Curve have scored just one run through the first two games of the series.

TODAY: The Curve and Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, play the third game of a four-game series at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie took two out of the three games against Altoona in the first series meeting of the season on June 2-4 with two walk-off wins. This series marks the second of five sets between Altoona and Bowie this year. They will meet again on July 13-16 for the first series at Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona. In their last series, the Curve won two of three games at home against Hartford. The Baysox dropped two of three games in Erie and split a double header with the SeaWolves on Sunday. Altoona will continue their eight-game road trip by traveling to Erie for a four-game set on June 30-July 3.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Austin Coley makes his twelfth start and 17th overall appearance of the year for the Curve. He has the sixth-best ERA in the E.L. Last time out, Coley worked six innings and allowed two runs on five hits, striking out six in the no-decision against Hartford. From May 4-June 4, Coley posted a 1.85 ERA (7 ER/34 IP) in four starts and four relief outings. He pitched with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders last season and went 12-10 with a 4.65 ERA last year. In 2015, Coley led the South Atlantic League and the Pirates organization with 16 wins while pitching for Single-A West Virginia. Coley was drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round of the 2014 draft out of Belmont. For more on Coley, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Matthew Grimes makes his 13th start of the season for the Baysox and his first against Altoona this year. Last time out on Thursday, he picked up a win after allowing two runs on five hits in seven innings against Binghamton. Grimes spent the 2016 between A-Adv. Frederick and Bowie in Baltimore's system. He went a combined 11-9 with a 2.80 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). Grimes logged a career-high 138.1 innings last season and began this year in Double-A with the Baysox.

NO STEALING: The Curve are the best team in the league at throwing out potential base stealers, catching 30 of 62 attempts (.483). **Jin-De Jhang** has thrown out 74 percent (14/19) of attempts this year, the best in the E.L. among catchers with at least five attempts. **J.T. Brubaker** has the third-best rate of catching stolen base attempts among E.L. pitchers this year at 70 percent (7/10) and Alex McRae is seventh at 58 percent (7/12).

HELLO, NEWMAN: Over his last nine games, Kevin Newman is hitting .333 (13/39) and has just two strikeouts. His season average has increased from .229 to .244. He has the second-best TPA/SO rate in the E.L. (9.77).

ELVIS HAS LEFT THE BUILDING: Over his last 24 games since May 28, Elvis Escobar is hitting .385 (27/70), which leads the Pirates system in that stretch, with a homer and six RBIs. On June 20 against Trenton, Escobar matched two franchise records with five hits and two triples. His five hits were also a career high.

JUNE SUIT-ING HIM WELL: In the month of June, Jerrick Suiter is batting .345 (19-for-55) with four home runs and 11 RBI in 19 games. His average sat at .246 after playing 18 games in May after he joined Altoona on May 7 from A-Adv. Bradenton.

MO OF THAT. PLEASE: Tomas Morales has two home runs in his last three starts for the Curve, although the blasts came three weeks apart. The 25-year-old catcher returned to Altoona on June 19 after spending 12 days with Triple-A Indianapolis. Morales leads Curve catchers with two homers, and all four of his career home runs have come in a Curve uniform.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** sits fifth in the E.L. with 16 home runs on the season, seventh with a .547 slugging percentage and he is third with 44 runs scored. He currently has a ten-game hitting streak, one game short of his season high. Luplow is the fastest player to hit 16 home runs to open a season, doing it in on June 20 in 68 games. When Adam Hyzdu set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 16th home run on June 26 in the team's 76th game. Luplow's 16 homers are the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when Josh Bonifay had 17 at the break. Luplow is currently on pace to hit 32 home runs this year, which would pass Hyzdu's single-season mark.

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star Edwin Espinal leads the team with 49 RBIs, fourth in the league, and he is first on the team and tied for second in the league with 22 doubles. He has the third-best strikeout rate in the league (9.66 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just three times. He grounded out in his lone at-bat on Sunday to

snap a season-long 11-game hitting streak. During the streak, he batted .372 (16/43) with 15 RBIs and had at least one RBI in six straight games. VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 68 of their 74

games this season and 62 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 98 of 106 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year. WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve have three of the toughest relievers to hit in

the league. Lefty Sean Keselica has held opposing hitters to a .162 average when pitching out of the pen, second-best in the league. Buddy Borden has held batters to a .176 average, fourth-best in the E.L., Tate Scioneaux has the lowest BB/9 IP ratio (0.89) for relievers. Montana DuRapau is second in ERA (1.38) out of the relievers in the league with at least 30 innings pitched.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: Kevin Newman (3), Yeudy Garcia (12), Brandon Waddell (16), Kevin Kramer (17), Connor Joe (28) and Jordan Luplow (30). Four players are also ranked in Baseball America's Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and Jin-De Jhang (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."
