YESTERDAY: The Curve lost their fourth straight game as the Baysox capped a four-game sweep with a 9-3 win. Bowie hit four home runs, the most given up by Altoona in a game this season. Tanner Anderson was knocked around for six runs over four innings. The Baysox opened the scoring with a three-run homer by Austin Hays in the third and added three runs in the fourth. Jake Brentz allowed two home runs to the Baysox in the fifth as the Curve fell behind, 8-0. Altoona cracked the scoreboard with three runs in the sixth inning. Edwin Espinal picked up his team-leading 50th RBI of the season with a single and Wyatt Mathisen added a two-run triple.

TODAY: The Curve face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, for the opener of a four-game series at UPMC Park. The Curve won two of three games from April 17-19 at home and then took two of three again on the road April 24-26. The two teams met again from May 19-21, with the Curve again winning two of three. Altoona dropped the first in a four-game set in the most recent series from May 26-29 before winning the final three games. The Curve went 13-7 against the SeaWolves last season and are 37-16 against them since the start of the 2015 season. The Curve enter the series coming off being swept in four at Bowie. The SeaWolves have lost three straight, falling in three of four games at Akron.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **J.T. Brubaker** makes his 12th start of the year and 14th overall appearance for the Curve. He has faced Erie four times (three starts) this year, going 0-1 with a 4.12 ERA (9 ER/19.2 IP). Last time out, Brubaker allowed a season-high seven runs (six earned) over 3.2 innings against Hartford in a no-decision on Sunday. Prior to that start, Brubaker went 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER/18.2 IP) over the three preceding outings. Brubaker began 2016 with Single-A West Virginia, where he went 4-5 with a 3.48 ERA in 12 starts. He was promoted to A-Adv. Bradenton in June and went 2-6 with a 5.32 ERA over 14 starts. The Pirates selected Brubaker in the sixth round of the 2015 draft out of the University of Akron. He went 6-4 with a 2.82 in his professional debut season with the West Virginia Black Bears in 2015 en route to a New York-Penn League championship. *For more on Brubaker, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Lefty Tyler Alexander makes his 15th start of the season for the SeaWolves and his fourth against the Curve. In his three previous starts, Alexander is 1-1 with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11 IP). He most recently faced the Curve on May 19 at PNG Field, allowing five unearned runs and recording just two outs. In his most recent start on Sunday, Alexander picked up his second straight loss after allowing five runs in seven innings against Bowie. Drafted in the second round as a sophomore in 2015 out of TCU, Alexander is ranked by MLB.com as the Tigers' fourth-best prospect. He led Tigers' minor leaguers in ERA and WHIP last year in his first full professional season.

SHINING STARS: On Wednesday, five players from the Curve were selected as Eastern League All-Stars, including Jordan Luplow, Wyatt Mathisen, Kevin Kramer, Alex McRae and Montana DuRapau.

NO STEALING: The Curve are the second-best team in the league at throwing out potential base stealers, catching 30 of 63 attempts (.476). **Jin-De Jhang** has thrown out 74 percent (14/19) of attempts this year, the best in the E.L. among catchers with at least five attempts. **J.T. Brubaker** has the third-best rate of catching stolen base attempts among E.L. pitchers this year at 70 percent (7/10) and **Alex McRae** is seventh at 58 percent (7/12).

HELLO, NEWMAN: Over his last ten games, **Kevin Newman** is hitting .326 (14/43) and has just two strikeouts. His season average has increased from .229 to .244. He has the second-best TPA/SO rate in the E.L. (9.90).

JUNE SUIT-ING HIM WELL: In the month of June, **Jerrick Suiter** is batting .355 (22/62) with four home runs and 11 RBI in 21 games. In his last six games, Suiter is hitting .450 (9/20). His batting average for the season is now .301, the highest it has been this year.

AIR JORDAN: Left fielder **Jordan Luplow** sits sixth in the E.L. with 16 home runs on the season and he is third with 45 runs scored. Luplow is the fastest player to hit 16 home runs to open a season, doing it in on June 20 in 68 games. When **Adam Hyzdu** set the Curve's single-season home run record with 31 in 2000, he hit his 16th home run on June 26 in the team's 76th game. Luplow's 16 homers are the most by a Curve player before the All-Star Break since 2005, when **Josh Bonifay** had 17 at the break. Luplow is currently on pace to hit 29 home runs this year.

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 50 RBIs, tied for fourth in the league, and he is first on the team and tied for second in the league with 22 doubles. He has the fourth-best strikeout rate in the league (9.29 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just four times.

VIEW FROM THE TOP: The Curve have held first place for 70 of their 76 games this season and 64 straight games since April 18. Dating back to July 24, 2016, they have been in first place in the Western Division for 100 of 108 games, including 36 straight games until the last two games of the year.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve have three of the toughest relievers to hit in the league. Lefty **Sean Keselica** has held opposing hitters to a .164 average when pitching out of the pen, second-best in the league. **Buddy Borden** has held batters to a .176 average, third-best in the E.L., Tate Scioneaux has the lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.06) for relievers. **Montana DuRapau** is second in ERA (1.38) out of the relievers in the league with at least 30 innings pitched.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Newman** (3), **Yeudy Garcia** (12), **Brandon Waddell** (16), **Kevin Kramer** (17), **Connor Joe** (28) and **Jordan Luplow** (30). Four players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."

Drafted in the sixth round by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2015 out of the University of Akron...Went 4-1 with a 0.76 ERA as a senior at Tecumseh High School in New Carlisle, Ohio... Pitched a no-hitter as a high school junior...Was recruited to the University of Akron by assistant Matt Ford, who is now a pitching coach in the Pirates system...Was the Friday starter for the Zips as a freshman...Went 5-4 with a 3.63 ERA as a junior in 15 starts, including one complete game...
