YESTERDAY: The Curve swept a double-header against the RubberDucks, 6-5 and 5-1. In game one the Curve rallied for four runs over the final two innings and held off Akron. Jerrick Suiter tied the game at 4-4 in the sixth and Tomas Morales hit a go-ahead double later in the inning. Logan Hill added an insurance run in the top of the seventh. Akron scored a run in the bottom of the inning, but Yeudy Garcia stranded the bases loaded to end the game. In game two, Edwin Espinal hit a solo homer to break a scoreless tie in the fourth. Jin-De Jhang brought in a run with a single in the sixth to pull ahead, 2-0, and three more runs scored in the frame on an error and two wild pitches. Montana DuRapau closed out his 14th save. The wins stretched the Curve's winning streak to four, moving them back into first place in the division.

TODAY: The Curve face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, in the finale of a four-game series heading into the All-Star Break. Altoona swept Akron at home from April 13-15 in three games before being swept in three at Canal Park April 21-23. The Curve won two of three in Akron from May 4-7, but were swept in four games at home from May 22-25. In their most recent series, the Curve won two of three at PNG Field from May 30-June 1. This is the final series this year between the two teams. The Curve are coming off taking two of three at home against Binghamton. Akron won two of three at home against Harrisburg leading into this series.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Tanner Anderson** makes his 16th start of the year and his 17th overall appearance. Last time out, he set career high working eight scoreless innings on Tuesday in a 6-0 win over Binghamton, throwing 110 pitches. Anderson has picked up a decision in each of his last 12 appearances (11 starts) since May 3, going 6-6 in that stretch. He has the best groundball rate (61.2%) in all of Double-A and currently holds the third-best FIP (3.23) in the E.L. Anderson is tied for fourth in the league and tied for first in the Pirates' system with seven wins. He opened up 2017 in the Altoona rotation after primarily working as a reliever through his first two professional seasons. He worked three scoreless, one-hit innings in Game 4 of the FSL Championship Series last year and got the final out to clinch the league title. He worked as a starter in the Arizona Fall League, posting a 3.76 ERA in seven outings. Anderson is a native of Tampa and a graduate of Harvard University, where he pitched, played shortstop and third base and was an All-Ivy League second baseman. *For more on Anderson, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Left-hander **Matt Whitehouse** makes his ninth start of the year and his 18th overall appearance for the RubberDucks. Last time out, he allowed two runs (one earned) with six strikeouts in six innings in a win at Harrisburg on Tuesday. Whitehouse has won each his last five starts with a 3.03 ERA (11 ER/32.2 IP), including a Triple-A outing against Gwinnett on June 17. He began the year as a reliever and is 1-0 with a 1.89 ERA in nine bullpen outings.

CURVE CRACKING THE CURSE OF THE CANAL: Since the Curve's inaugural season in 1999, they have won a season series against Akron just three times: 1999 (12-10), 2004 (16-4) and 2010 (13-6). They split the season series in 2006 (12-12). Altoona has posted a losing record at Canal Park 13 of 18 years. They had a winning record in Akron in 2004 (8-2), 2010 (6-4) and 2013 (6-5) and split the games in Akron in 1999 (5-5) and 2003 (5-5). The Curve have completed just three sweeps at Canal Park, all of them in three games: May 6-8, 2003; June 4-6, 2004; April 19-21, 2010. Heading into the final game of this year's series, the Curve are 10-9 against the RubberDucks and 5-4 in Akron.

BACK ON TOP: With Saturday's wins, the Curve moved back into first place in the E.L. West for the first time since June 30, a span covering eight games. Altoona led the division from April 18-June 30, a span covering 64 straight games. They have led the division for 66 of the last 74 games. Dating back to July 24, 2016, the Curve have held first place in the division for 102 of 116 games. After a season-worst seven-game losing streak from June 26-July 2, the Curve have won six of seven and are currently on their fourth four-game winning streak, matching a season high.

BATTLING THE INJURY BUG: After placing just three players on the disabled list for the entire season in 2015 and three in all of 2016, the Curve have placed nine different players on their DL this year. Currently there are seven players on the disabled list, including three of the team's top-five prospects on MLB.com (**Kevin Kramer**, **Brandon Waddell** and **Connor Joe**).

SHINING STARS: First baseman **Edwin Espinal** was added to the Eastern League Western Division All-Star roster on Monday, giving the team six selections this season, tied for the most in the league. That total is tied for the second-most in franchise history (2006 and 2010), behind only the seven selections in 2014. Espinal is just the fourth player in Curve history to receive multiple Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star nods, joining Shawn Garrett (2002-03), Jason Delaney (2008-09) and Brock Holt (2011-12). **Jordan Luplow**, **Wyatt Mathisen**, **Kevin Kramer**, **Alex McRae** and **Montana DuRapau** were named to the All-Star rosters on June 28.

HELLO, NEWMAN: Over his last 19 games since June 17, **Kevin Newman** is hitting .358 (27/73) with seven doubles, a triple, two homers and nine RBIs. His season average has increased from .229 to .263. For the year, he has the fourth-best TPA/SO rate in the E.L. (9.33). He has picked it up another notch over his last nine games since June 30, batting .395 (15/38) with five doubles, a triple, a homer and seven RBIs.

SUIT UP!: Since June 2, **Jerrick Suiter** is batting .368 (35/95), leading the Pirates' system during that stretch, with six homers, six doubles, 20 RBIs and 18 walks over 31 games. Suiter reached base in 10 straight plate appearances from Wednesday-Friday, going 9-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He hit safely in nine straight at-bats and eight straight plate appearances. In his last five games, he is hitting .647 (11/17, 2 2B, 2 HR, 2 BB, RBIs)

EDWINNING: 2016 E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 55 RBIs, fifth in the league, and he is first on the team and tied for first in the league with 24 doubles. He has the second-best strikeout rate in the league (9.68 TPA/SO) and had multiple strikeouts in a game just four times.

DU-RAP IT UP: On May 19, Curve closer **Montana DuRapau** moved ahead of Matt Peterson (2003-06) with his 30th career save, the most in franchise history. Now with 36 career saves, DuRapau is first in the E.L. with 14 saves and sits first with 26 games finished.

WHAT A RELIEF: The Curve bullpen has been tough to hit this year. Lefty **Sean Keselica** has held opposing hitters to a .172 average when pitching out of the pen, second-best in the league, and Tate Scioneaux (.202) is ranked fifth. **Miguel Rosario** is first in ERA (0.89), **Montana DuRapau** is second (1.49), Keselica is fourth (1.88) and Scioneaux is sixth (2.01) in ERA out of the relievers in the league with at least 36 innings pitched.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Newman** (3), **Yeudy Garcia** (12), **Brandon Waddell** (16), **Kevin Kramer** (17), and **Connor Joe** (28). Four players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."
