YESTERDAY: The Curve allowed seven straight runs over the seventh and eighth innings and lost to the Senators, 9-7. After falling behind 2-0 through two innings, the Curve pulled ahead with seven runs in the second. An error brought in the first run, Elvis Escobar tied the score with a double and Jerrick Suiter put the Curve ahead with an RBI single. Edwin Espinal added a two-run homer to push the lead to 5-2, Pablo Reyes hit an RBI single and J.T. Brubaker capped the scoring with an RBI single. Harrisburg scored four runs against Sean Keselica in the seventh and three more against Brandon Cumpton in the eighth.

TODAY: The Curve face the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, in the rubber game of a three-game series. The Curve split a four-game series in Harrisburg to open the season from April 7-9, won two of three games against the Senators at home from April 28-30 and took two of three in Harrisburg from June 6-8. The Curve have lost five of their last seven games dating back to the last game before the all-star break. The Senators are coming off a four-game split in Richmond and have lost 14 of their last 19 games overall. Harrisburg is 4-11 in the month of July, the worst record in the league.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Austin Coley makes his 16th start for the Curve and his 21st overall appearance. Last time out, he allowed two earned runs over his six innings in a no-decision against Bowie on Friday. Over his last six starts since June 16, Coley is 2-0 with a 2.62 (10 ER/34.1 IP). He is ranked sixth among Eastern League pitchers with a 3.11 ERA. From May 4-June 4, Coley posted a 1.85 ERA (7 ER/34 IP) in four starts and four relief outings. He pitched with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders last season and went 12-10 with a 4.65 ERA last year. In 2015, Coley led the South Atlantic League and the Pirates organization with 16 wins while pitching for Single-A West Virginia. Coley was drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round of the 2014 draft out of Belmont. For more on Coley, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Matthew Crownover makes his ninth start for the Senators. Last time out, he allowed three earned runs over five innings in a no-decision at Richmond. He began the season with A-Adv. Potomac where he went 3-1 with a 1.94 ERA over 10 games (six starts). Crownover was promoted to Double-A Harrisburg on June 1. He was drafted in the sixth round in 2015 out of Clemson. Crownover is 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA over his last three starts.

STARTING IMPROVEMENT: Over the last 14 games since July 3, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 5-2 with a 3.24 ERA (28 ER/77.2 IP), an improvement over the previous 79 starts, when the starters combined to go 18 26 with a 4.63 ERA. In that span, Alex McRae is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA in two starts, Tanner Anderson is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA and Austin Coley is 2-0 with a 3.50 ERA.

HELLO, NEWMAN: Over his last 26 games since June 17, **Kevin Newman** is hitting .327 (37/113), fourth-best in the Pirates' system, with eight doubles, a triple, two homers and 12 RBIs. His season average has increased from .229 to .262. For the year, he has the second-best TPA/SO rate in the E.L. (9.28) and has the fifth-most at-bats (340).

SUIT UP!: Since June 2, Jerrick Suiter is batting .364 (44/121), leading the Pirates' system during that stretch, while also adding seven homers, eight doubles, 26 RBIs and 25 walks over 38 games. Suiter reached base in 10 straight plate appearances from July 5-7, going 9-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He hit safely in nine straight at-bats and eight straight plate appearances. In his last 12 games since July 5, Suiter is hitting .465 (20/43, 4 2B, 3 HR, 9 BB, 13 RBIs).

EDWINNING: Two-time E.L. All-Star Edwin Espinal leads the team with 64 RBIs, third in the league, and he is first on the team and second in the league with 24 doubles. He is currently on a 21-game on-base streak since June 26, the longest active streak in the league this season, with at least one hit in 18 of those games. His 13 homers on the year are a new career high, and he has hit four homers in his last eight games.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Curve bullpen has been tough to hit this year. Lefty Sean Keselica has held opposing hitters to a .199 average when pitching out of the pen, fifth-best in the league. **Miguel Rosario** is first in ERA (1.27) and **Tate Scioneaux** is second (1.92) in ERA out of the relievers in the league with at least 40 innings pitched. Scioneaux is tied for second in the league in appearances (31), second in BB/9 IP (1.62) and fourth in fewest baserunners/9 IP (8.41).

LOOKING FOR RELIEF: Though it has been a strength for most of the season, the Curve bullpen has combined for a 8.75 ERA (23 ER/23.2 IP) over the last seven games with a 1-4 record and four blown saves. In that span, the Curve have lost a lead in the eighth inning or later four times (three losses) and allowed another go-ahead run in the eighth to break a 3-3 tie against the Baysox last Thursday.

BATTLING THE INJURY BUG: After placing just three players on the disabled list for the entire season in 2015 and three in all of 2016, the Curve have placed nine different players on their DL this year. Currently there are six players on the disabled list, including three of the team's top-five prospects on MLB.com (Kevin Kramer, Brandon Waddell and Connor Joe).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: **Kevin Newman** (3), **Yeudy Garcia** (12), **Brandon** Waddell (16), Kevin Kramer (17), and Connor Joe (28). Four players are also ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Newman (4), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and Jin-De Jhang (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as hav ing the "Best Changeup."
