YESTERDAY: The Curve took the series finale from the Harrisburg Senators, 3-2. Kevin Newman hit a go-ahead sac fly in the bottom of the seventh. Austin Coley pitched six innings and allowed two runs. Yeudy Garcia picked up the win after working a 1-2-3 seventh. Tate Scioneaux picked up his seventh save with two scoreless innings. Trailing 2-1 entering the sixth, Elvis Escobar hit a solo homer to tie the score.

TODAY: The Curve face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the first of a four-game series at Prince George's Stadium. The Curve dropped three of four games against the Baysox at PNG Field last week. The Baysox won two of three games in Bowie from June 2-4 and swept four games from June 26-29. This series marks their last trip to Bowie this season. The Baysox return to PNG Field from August 24-27.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Alex McRae makes his 19th start of the year for the Curve. He is 1-1 with a 1.57 ERA (5 ER/23 IP) against the Baysox this year in three previous starts. Last time out, he held the Baysox to two earned runs over eight innings in an no-decision on Saturday. McRae has pitched the third most innings (106.0) in the Eastern League this season. He has the fifth-best walk rate in the league (2.04/9 IP). Last season, McRae joined the Curve in late-June after making 12 starts in the Florida State League. After going 2-4 with a 10.25 ERA in his first six starts with Altoona, McRae went 6-2 with a 2.47 ERA (17 ER/62.0 IP) over his last ten outings (nine starts) from July 14-September 1. A native of Milwaukee, McRae is in his fourth professional season after being drafted by the Pirates in the tenth round out of Jacksonville University in 2014, where he played first and third base along with pitching. **For more on McRae, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Jesus Liranzo makes his seventh start of the year and his 23rd overall appearance. He last pitched on Saturday, allowing one run (a homer by Edwin Espinal) over three innings against the Curve. He has started his last six outings, working three innings in five of those appearances and posting a 2.81 ERA (5 ER/16.0 IP). Liranzo is ranked by MLB.com as the Orioles' 14th-best prospect. He was originally signed by Atlanta in 2012, released later that year and signed with the Braves again in 2013 before being released again that June. The Orioles signed him in July 2013 and he had surgery to repair a fracture in his elbow that fall, missing all of 2014. Liranzo combined to post a 2.07 ERA between the DSL, Single-A Delmarva and Double-A Bowie in 2015 and 2016.

STARTING IMPROVEMENT: Over the last 15 games since July 3, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 5-2 with a 3.23 ERA (30 ER/83.2 IP), an improvement over the previous 79 starts, when the starters combined to go 18-26 with a 4.63 ERA. In that span, Alex McRae is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA in two starts, Tanner Anderson is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA and Austin Coley is 2-0 with a 3.38 ERA in four starts.

GOODBYE, NEWMAN - HELLO, TUCKER: Shortstop Kevin Newman, the Pirates' No. 3 prospect on MLB.com, was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis today after hitting .319 over his last 27 games since June 17 with eight doubles, a triple, two homers and 13 RBIs. He had a .259 batting average for the year. The Curve added 2014 first-round pick Cole Tucker, who posted a .285 average in 68 games with A-Adv. Bradenton, stealing 36 bases and driving in 32 runs. Over his last 14 games with the Marauders, Tucker hit .382 with seven doubles, four RBIs and eight stolen bases. Tucker is currently ranked as the Pirates' fifth-best prospect by MLB.com.

SUIT UP!: Since June 2, Jerrick Suiter is batting .352 (44/125), leading the Pirates' system during that stretch, while also adding seven homers, eight doubles, 26 RBIs and 25 walks over 39 games. Suiter reached base in 10 straight plate appearances from July 5-7, going 9-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He hit safely in nine straight at-bats and eight straight plate appearances. In his last 13 games since July 5, Suiter is hitting .426 (20/47, 4 2B, 3 HR, 9 BB, 13 RBIs).

EDWINNING: Two-time E.L. All-Star Edwin Espinal leads the team with 64 RBIs, third in the league, and he is first on the team and second in the league with 24 doubles. He is currently on a 22-game on-base streak since June 26, the longest active streak in the league this season, with at least one hit in 19 of those games. His 13 homers on the year are a new career high, and he has hit four homers in his last nine games.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Curve bullpen has been tough to hit this year. Tate Scioneaux has held opposing batters to a .194 average, fifth-best in the league among relievers. Lefty Sean Keselica is sixth (.199). Out of relievers with at least 40 innings pitched this season, Miguel Rosario is first in ERA (1.27) and Scioneaux is second (1.86). Scioneaux is tied for second in the league in appearances (32), third in BB/9 IP (1.71) and fourth in fewest baserunners/9 IP (8.29).

LOOKING FOR RELIEF: Though it has been a strength for most of the season, the Curve bullpen has combined for a 7.76 ERA (23 ER/26.2 IP) over the last eight games with a 2-4 record and four blown saves. In that span, the Curve have lost a lead in the eighth inning or later four times (three losses) and allowed another go-ahead run in the eighth to break a 3-3 tie against the Baysox last Thursday.

BATTLING THE INJURY BUG: After placing just three players on the disabled list for the entire season in 2015 and three in all of 2016, the Curve have placed nine different players on their DL this year. Currently there are six players on the disabled list, including three of the team's top-five prospects on MLB.com (Kevin Kramer, Brandon Waddell and Connor Joe).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates Prospects: Cole Tucker (5), Yeudy Garcia (12), Brandon Waddell (16), Kevin Kramer (17), and Connor Joe (28). Four players are also ranked in Baseball America's Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Tucker (8), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and Jin-De Jhang (27). B.A. also named Newman as the organization's "Best Hitter for Average" and Waddell as having the "Best Changeup."

ERI before allowing three runs in the fifth and sixth innings...Curve improved to 5-5 in his starts with 3-2 win on 4/30 v. HAR...Snapped a stretch of 15.1 consecutive innings pitched without a strikeout when he sat down Jaron Long on strikes to end the fourth inning...Allowed then-season-high four runs on 5/13 v. NHM...Recorded just one out and allowed six runs on two homers on 4/19 v.
