**YESTERDAY:** The Curve beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 2-1, behind eight strong innings from Alex McRae. After allowing a run in the first, McRae held Reading off the board the rest of the way and sat down the final 21 batters he faced, adding eight strikeouts. Yeudy Garcia picked up the save with a 1-2-3 ninth. Jerrick Suiter tied the score at 1-1 with a single to plate McRae in the fifth inning. McRae singled in the seventh and scored later in the frame on a wild pitch.

**TODAY:** The Curve play the finale of three games against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series marks the first meetings between the two teams this season and the Curve's only trip to FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading makes one trip to Altoona, a three-game series from August 8-10. Reading has lost 16 of its last 20 games since July 4. The Curve have won three consecutive games after dropping four of five prior to this series.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Tanner Anderson** makes his 19th start of the year and 20th overall appearance for the Curve. In his last start, he worked five innings and allowed three earned runs in a loss at Bowie on Friday night. Anderson has the best groundball rate (60.4%) in all of Double-A and currently holds the third-best FIP (3.33) in the Eastern League. He is tied for seventh in the league with seven wins and tied for seventh with eight losses. He opened up 2017 in the Altoona rotation after primarily working as a reliever through his first two professional seasons. He worked three scoreless, one-hit innings in Game 4 of the FSL Championship Series last year and got the final out to clinch the league title. He worked as a starter in the Arizona Fall League, posting a 3.76 ERA in seven outings. Anderson is a native of Tampa and a graduate of Harvard University, where he pitched, played shortstop and third base and was an All-Ivy League second baseman. *For more on Anderson, see page two.*

**FOR READING:** Right-hander Jose Taveras makes his second start of the year for the Fightin Phils. In his Double-A debut on Friday, he allowed three earned runs over 5.1 innings in a no-decision at Erie. He was promoted to Reading on July 20 after working a 6-4 record and a 2.38 ERA in 16 starts with A-Adv. Clearwater, where he was picked as a Florida State League All-Star. Taveras signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in November 2013 and was picked as the Dominican Summer League Pitcher of the Year in 2014 after he went 8-4 with a 1.05 ERA in 15 games (13 starts).

**A SERIES WIN AT READING IN THE BOOKS:** With wins in the first two games of the series, the Curve sealed their first series win in Reading since July 23-25, 2012, when Altoona won two of three games at FirstEnergy Stadium against the Phillies. Altoona went 4-2 in Reading in 2012, but posted a 3-14 record at FirstEnergy Stadium from 2013-2016. The Curve have never swept a road series in Reading in 42 all-time trips.

**STARTING IMPROVEMENT:** Over the last 21 games since July 3, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 8-3 with a 2.93 ERA (39 ER/119.2 IP), an improvement over the previous 79 starts, when the starters combined to go 18-26 with a 4.63 ERA. In that span, **Alex McRae** is 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27 IP) in four starts, **Tanner Anderson** is 1-1 with a 3.46 ERA (10 ER/26 IP) in three starts and **Austin Coley** is 3-0 with a 2.61 ERA (9 ER/31.0) in five starts.

**RETURN OF THE JIN-DE:** After missing the first six weeks of the season, catcher **Jin-De Jhang** was batting .184 in 31 games prior to July 8. Since then, he has hit .356 (16/45) in 11 games with three doubles, a home run and nine RBIs. Behind the plate, he has thrown out 54.8 percent (17/31) of base stealing attempts, the best in the Eastern League this season, well above the league-average of 35.6 percent.

**SUIT UP!:** Since June 2, **Jerrick Suiter** is batting .336 (50/149), leading the Pirates' system during that stretch, while also adding seven homers, ten doubles, a triple, 31 RBIs and 26 walks over 45 games. Suiter reached base in 10 straight plate appearances from July 5-7, going 9-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He hit safely in nine straight at-bats and eight straight plate appearances. In his last 19 games since July 5, Suiter is hitting .366 (26/71, 6 2B, 3B, 3 HR, 10 BB, 18 RBIs).

**EDWINNING:** Two-time E.L. All-Star **Edwin Espinal** leads the team with 67 RBIs, tied for second in the league, and he is first on the team and second in the league with 24 doubles. He went on a 23-game on-base streak from June 26-July 20, the second-longest for a Curve player this year and the longest active streak in the league when it was broken. His 14 homers on the year are a new career high.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** Reliever **Tate Scioneaux** has held opposing batters to a .203 average, fourth-best in the league among relievers. Lefty **Sean Keselica** is third (.201). Out of relievers with at least 40 innings pitched this season, **Miguel Rosario** is first in ERA (1.42) and Scioneaux is second (1.94). Scioneaux is tied for first in the league in appearances (34), fourth in BB/9 IP (1.80) and third in fewest baserunners/9 IP (8.72).

**WHAT A RELIEF:** After a slide, the Curve bullpen has rebounded back to form over the last four games. In that stretch, Curve relievers have posted a 3.60 ERA (4 ER/10 IP) and have converted all three save attempts. The bullpen combined for a 7.46 ERA (27 ER/33.0 IP) over 10 games from July 9-July 21 with a 2-6 record, six blown saves and 29 walks, losing a lead in the eighth inning or later six times (five losses) and allowed another go-ahead run to break a 3-3 tie against the Baysox on July 13.

**COLE TRAIN:** With the promotion of Kevin Newman to Triple-A, the Curve added 2014 first-round pick **Cole Tucker** on Thursday. Tucker posted a .285 average in 68 games with A-Adv. Bradenton, stealing a league-leading 36 bases and driving in 32 runs. Over his last 14 games with the Marauders, Tucker hit .382 with seven doubles, four RBIs and eight stolen bases. Tucker is currently ranked as the Pirates' fifth-best prospect by MLB.com. He was picked as a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star, the first all-star selection of his career.

**REHAB UPDATES:** Curve left-hander **Brandon Waddell**, who was placed on the disabled list on June 8 with a left forearm strain, is currently on a rehab assignment with the short-season West Virginia Black Bears. On Tuesday, he pitched five scoreless innings and allowed one hit with seven strikeouts, picking up a win over Batavia. In three rehab outings in the GCL and NYPL, Waddell is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12 IP). Curve outfielder **Jonathan Schwind** was placed on the DL on June 21 with a left oblique strain and began a rehab assignment with the Black Bears on Tuesday night, going 1-for-2 with a double and a run scored.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Cole Tucker** (5), **Kevin Kramer** (10), **Yeudy Garcia** (19), **Brandon Waddell** (23) and **Dario Agrazal** (29). **Connor Joe** was ranked 28th prior to the mid-season update. Five players are also ranked in Baseball America's Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Tucker (8), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27).

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach in Altoona. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
