**YESTERDAY:** The Curve held off the Erie SeaWolves for a 6-5 win, their seventh win in the last 10 games and Erie's sixth straight loss. The Curve broke a 4-4 tie with a double by Jordan George in the sixth and added another run on a double by Elvis Escobar. Erie scored two runs with help from two Altoona errors in the first inning. The Curve answered to tie the score in the bottom of the frame with an RBI hit by Anderson Feliz and an RBI double by Jerrick Suiter. The Curve jumped ahead 3-2 with another double by Suiter in the third and pushed the lead to two runs with an RBI single by Cole Tucker in the fourth. Erie evened the score in the top of the sixth with a two-out, two-run homer by Zack Cox. Curve starter Alex McRae picked up his ninth win, allowing four runs (two earned) over six innings. Tate Scioneaux worked the final six outs to pick up his tenth save of the season.

**TODAY:** The Curve play the third of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Curve won two of three games from April 17-19 against the SeaWolves at PNG Field and picked up two wins in three games from April 24-26 at UPMC Park. The Curve also took two of three games at home from May 19-21 and won three of four in Erie from May 26-29 before dropping three of four on the road from May 30-June 3. After winning four straight games last week, the Curve dropped three of four games at home against Trenton. The SeaWolves lost four straight games on the road at Richmond prior to this series and have now lost six straight games. With Monday's win, the Curve clinched a winning record against the SeaWolves this year.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Casey Sadler makes his second start of the year for the Curve. Last time out, making his first start for the Curve since August 24, 2013 and his first overall start since June 21, 2015 with Indianapolis, Sadler pitched five innings and allowed three runs on five hits in a no-decision against Trenton on Thursday. Sadler underwent Tommy John surgery on November 10, 2015 and missed the entire 2016 season. He went 11-7 with a 3.31 ERA for the Curve in 2013 over 23 starts and was selected as an Eastern League All-Star, earning late-season promotion to Indianapolis. He made his Major League debut on May 2, 2014 and made six relief outings for the Pirates that year. He made one MLB start, a win over the Brewers on April 12, 2015, his most recent Major League appearance. Sadler made his return to the mound in May with A-Adv. Bradenton, pitching in six relief outings with a 0.75 ERA before being sent to Triple-A in early-June, where he posted a 5.23 ERA in eight outings. He was assigned to the Curve on July 5. Pittsburgh drafted Sadler in the 25th round in 2010.

**FOR ERIE:** Left-hander Tyler Alexander makes his 21st start of the year for the SeaWolves. Last time out, Alexander allowed seven runs on 12 hits over 5.2 innings in a no-decision against Richmond on Friday. Over his last two starts, he has posted a 14.73 ERA (12 ER/7.1 IP). He has faced the Curve in four starts this year, going 2-1 with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP). Alexander was drafted by Detroit in the second round (65th overall) in 2015 out of TCU, where he was teammates in 2014 with Curve outfielder Jerrick Suiter. He entered the year as the MLB.com's No. 4 Tigers prospect, but dropped to 12th in the mid-season update.

**PLAYOFF POSITIONING:** The Curve clinched a winning record against Erie this season with Monday's win, an important victory in the event of a tie in the final regular-season standings, with head-to-head records serving as the first tiebreaker. The Curve have gone 3-12 against first-place Bowie this year, but have posted a 53-39 record against the rest of the Eastern League (Bowie is 46-47 against the league excluding Altoona). Altoona went 10-10 against fourth-place Akron.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Curve have gone 7-6 in their last 13 games, and five of those losses have been by one run. Their last seven losses since July 18 have been by an average of 1.3 runs. The Curve have played 41 one-run games this year, the most in the Eastern League, and have posted an 19-22 record in those games.

**STARTING IMPROVEMENT:** Over the last 28 games since July 3, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 12-3 with a 2.86 ERA (51 ER/160.2 IP), an improvement over the previous 79 starts, when the starters combined to go 18-26 with a 4.63 ERA. In that span, Alex McRae is 3-0 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER/33 IP) in the starts, Tanner Anderson is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (10 ER/34 IP) in four starts and Austin Coley is 3-0 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER/38.0) in six starts. Over the last ten games, Curve starters have combined to go 7-0 with a 1.74 ERA (11 ER/57 IP).

**THE SUMMER OF GEORGE:** The Curve added OF/INF Jordan George from A-Adv. Bradenton on Friday, and he had a memorable Double-A debut in Saturday's double-header. In the first game, he clubbed a two-run homer to pick up his first hit with the Curve and added a two-run double, finishing the game with four RBIs. He added a hit, an RBI and a run scored in the second game of the double-header. He is hitting .444 (8/18) with six RBIs in his first five games, extending his overall hitting streak to eight games. George hit .302 with nine homers and 43 RBIs over 69 games with Bradenton.

**RETURN OF THE JIN-DE:** After missing the first six weeks of the season, catcher Jin-De Jhang was batting .184 in 31 games prior to July 8. Since then, he has hit .302 (19/63) in 16 games with four doubles, a home run and nine RBIs. Behind the plate, he has thrown out 52.9 percent (18/34) of base stealing attempts this season, the best in the Eastern League this season, well above the league-average of 35.6 percent.

**SUIT UP!:** Since June 2, Jerrick Suiter is batting .328 (56/171), leading the Pirates' system during that stretch, while also adding eight homers, 12 doubles, a triple, 34 RBIs and 29 walks over 52 games. Suiter reached base in 10 straight plate appearances from July 5-7, going 9-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He hit safely in nine straight at-bats and eight straight plate appearances. In his last 26 games since July 5, Suiter is hitting .344 (32/93, 8 2B, 3B, 4 HR, 13 BB, 21 RBIs).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** Reliever Tate Scioneaux has held opposing batters to a .203 average, third-best in the league among relievers. Scioneaux is tied for first in the league with 36 appearances, has the second-lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.70) and has allowed the third-fewest baserunners (8.61/9 IP). Out of relievers with at least 45 innings pitched this year, Miguel Rosario is first with a 1.80 ERA and Scioneaux is third with a 1.96 ERA.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects: Cole Tucker (5), Kevin Kramer (10), Yeuji Garcia (19), Brandon Waddell (23) and Dario Agrazal (29). Connor Joe was ranked 28th prior to the mid-season update. Five players are also ranked in Baseball America's Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Tucker (8), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and Jin-De Jhang (27).
