YESTERDAY: The Curve were held to three hits and shut out by the Erie SeaWolves, 2-0. Dawel Lugo and Christin Stewart hit RBI singles in the third inning for the only two runs of the game. Casey Sadler picked up his second loss after allowing two runs over five innings. Brandon Cumpton and Luis Heredia each pitched two scoreless innings. Erie starter Tyler Alexander had his best outing of the year, going 7.1 scoreless innings and allowing three hits with eight strikeouts. Justin Maffei had the Curve's only extra-base hit, a double in the first inning.

**TODAY:** The Curve play the finale of a four-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The Curve won two of three games from April 17-19 against the SeaWolves at PNG Field and picked up two wins in three games from April 24-26 at UPMC Park. The Curve also took two of three games at home from May 19-21 and won three of four in Erie from May 26-29 before dropping three of four on the road from May 30-June 3. After winning four straight games last week, the Curve dropped three of four games at home against Trenton. The SeaWolves lost four straight games on the road at Pichmend grips to this copies and had lost give traight games prior SeaWolves lost four straight games on the road at Richmond prior to this series and had lost six straight games prior to Wednesday's victory. With Monday's win, the Curve clinched a winning record against the SeaWolves this year.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander J.T. Brubaker makes his 18th start of the season and his 20th overall appearance. Last time out, he allowed two earned runs over five innings in a no-decision against Trenton on Saturday. Over his last three starts since July 18, Brubaker is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (4 ER/16 IP). He has made five starts against the Sea-Wolves this year, going 0-2 with a 5.91 ERA (14 ER/21.1 IP). Brubaker began 2016 with Single-A West Virginia, where he went 4-5 with a 3.48 ERA in 12 starts. He was promoted to A-Adv. Bradenton in June and went 2-6 with a 5.32 ERA over 14 starts. The Pirates selected Brubaker in the sixth round of the 2015 draft out of the University of Akron. He went 6-4 with a 2.82 in his professional debut season with the West Virginia Black Bears in 2015 en route to a New York-Penn League championship. For more on Brubaker, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander A.J. Ladwig makes his 16th start of the year for the SeaWolves. In his last start, he picked six innings and allowed three runs on nine hits in a loss at Richmond on Saturday. Ladwig has faced the Curve twice, allowing two runs in each start, posting a 1-0 record and a 3.27 ERA (4 ER/11 IP). He was drafted in the 11th round by the Tigers out of Wichita State in 2014.

PLAYOFF POSITIONING: The Curve clinched a winning record against Erie this season with Monday's win, an important victory in the event of a tie in the final regular-season standings, with head-to-head records serving as the first tiebreaker. The Curve have gone 3-12 against first-place Bowie this year, but have posted a 53-40 record against the rest of the Eastern League (Bowie is 46-48 against the league excluding Altoona). Altoona went 10-10 against fourthplace Akron.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Curve have gone 7-7 in their last 14 games, and five of those losses have been by one run. Their last seven losses since July 18 have been by an average of 1.4 runs (10 runs/7 games). The Curve have played 41 one-run games this year, the most in the Eastern League, and have posted an 19-22 record in those games.

**STARTING IMPROVEMENT:** Over the last 29 games since July 3, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 12-4 with a 2.88 ERA (53 ER/165.2 IP), an improvement over the previous 79 starts, when the starters combined to go 18-26 with a 4.63 ERA. In that span, **Alex McRae** is 3-0 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER/33 IP) in five starts, **Tanner Anderson** is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (10 ER/34 IP) in four starts and **Austin Coley** is 3-0 with a 2.61 ERA (11 ER/38.0) in six starts. Over the last 11 games, Curve starters have combined to go 7-1 with a 1.89 ERA (13 ER/62 IP).

**SUPER REYES:** Pablo Reyes has posted a .353 average (6/17) over his last five games and has picked up four stolen bases. He now leads the team with 15 stolen bases this year. Reyes is also tied for third on the team and first among active players with eight home runs. Reyes led the Curve with a .304 average and five homers in the month of July. He has hit .300 (30/100) over his last 28 games since July 1.

**THE SUMMER OF GEORGE:** The Curve added OF/INF **Jordan George** from A-Adv. Bradenton on Friday, and he had a memorable Double-A debut in Saturday's double-header. In the first game, he clubbed a two-run homer to pick up his first hit with the Curve and added a two-run double, finishing the game with four RBIs. He added a hit, an RBI and a run scored in the second game of the double-header. He is hitting .400 (8/20) with six RBIs in his first six games. His overall hitting streak of eight games was snapped on Wednesday night. George hit .302 with nine homers and 43 RBIs over 69 games with Bradenton.

**RETURN OF THE JIN-DE:** After missing the first six weeks of the season, catcher **Jin-De Jhang** was batting .184 in 31 games prior to July 8, Since then, he has hit .302 (19/63) in 16 games with four doubles, a home run and nine RBIs. Behind the plate, he has thrown out 52.9 percent (18/34) of base stealing attempts this season, the best in the Eastern League this season, well above the league-average of 35.6 percent.

**SUIT UP!:** Since June 2, **Jerrick Suiter** is batting .320 (56/175), leading the Pirates' system during that stretch, while also adding eight homers, 12 doubles, a triple, 34 RBIs and 29 walks over 53 games. Suiter reached base in 10 straight plate appearances from July 5-7, going 9-for-9 with a homer, two doubles, a walk and five RBIs. He hit safely in nine straight at-bats and eight straight plate appearances.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Reliever Tate Scioneaux has held opposing batters to a .203 average, third-best in the league among relievers. Scioneaux is tied for second in the league with 36 appearances, has the second-lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.70) and has allowed the third-fewest baserunners (8.61/9 IP). Out of relievers with at least 45 innings pitched this year, **Miguel Rosario** is first with a 1.80 ERA and Scioneaux is third with a 1.96 ERA.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features five of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects: Cole Tucker (5), Kevin Kramer (10), Yeudy Garcia (19), Brandon Waddell (23) and Dario Agrazal (29). Connor Joe was ranked 28th prior to the mid-season update. Five players are also ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Tucker (8), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27).
