YESTERDAY: The Curve beat the Trenton Thunder, 2-1. Trailing 1-0 heading into the third, Cole Tucker tied the score with an RBI single. In the fourth, **Justin Maffei** hit a go-ahead RBI single. Maffei finished the game 3-for-4 with two doubles, a run scored and an RBI. **Brandon Waddell** allowed one run over 4.2 innings with five strikeouts. **Brandon Cumpton** stranded a pair of inherited runners in the fifth and worked 1.1 scoreless innings overall. **Sean Keselica** had a runner on third with no outs in the seventh, but worked out of the inning without allowing a run. Tate Scioneaux pitched two perfect innings to pick up his 11th save of the year.

TODAY: The Curve play the finale and rubber game of a three-game road series against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The two teams split a two-game series in Altoona from June 20-21, with the third game being postponed due to rain on June 22. The Curve lost three of four at home against the Thunder from July 27-30. Trenton returns to Altoona for a four-game, three-day series from Aug. 11-13. The Curve are in a span of playing 11 of 18 games against the Thunder.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Mitch Keller makes his Double-A debut. He went 6-3 with a 3.14 ERA over 15 starts with the A-Adv. Bradenton Marauders this year. Keller is currently ranked as the Pirates' No. 2 prospect, the No. 22 prosect in baseball and the No. 6 RHP prospect by MLB.com. He went 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA over his last three starts with Bradenton. Last season, Keller went 9-5 with a 2.35 ERA over 24 total starts and was named as MiLB.com's fans' choice Top Breakout Prospect of the Year and the South Atlantic League's Most Outstanding Pitcher. FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Brady Koerner makes his seventh start of the season for the Thunder. In his last start, he pitched six innings and allowed three earned runs in a loss at Binghamton on Tuesday. Koerner went 4-1 a 2.45 ERA in six starts for A-Adv. Tampa before being promoted on July 3. He was drafted in the 17th round in 2015 by the Yankees out of Clemson.

TRENTON MAKES FOR CLOSE GAMES: The Curve have gone 3-5 against the Thunder this year, with five games being decided by one run. The Thunder have defeated the Curve by one run four times and once by two runs. The Curve have picked up a four-run win and a one-run win over the Thunder and also handed Trenton its worst loss of the year on June 20 in a 14-4 victory.

CLOSE CALLS: The Curve have gone 9-8 in their last 17 games, and five of those losses have been by one run. Their last eight losses since July 18 have been by an average of 1.5 runs (12 runs/8 games). The Curve have played 42 onerun games this year, the most in the Eastern League, and have posted a 20-22 record in those games.

STARTING IMPROVEMENT: Over the last 32 games since July 3, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 13-5 with a 2.98 ERA (60 ER/181.1 IP), an improvement over the previous 79 starts, when the starters combined to go 18-26 with a 4.63 ERA. In that span, **Alex McRae** is 3-0 with a 2.18 ERA (8 ER/33 IP) in five starts, **Tanner Anderson** is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (10 ER/34 IP) in four starts and **Austin Coley** is 3-1 with a 2.86 ERA (14 ER/44.0) in seven starts. Over the last 14 games, Curve starters have combined to go 8-2 with a 2.32 ERA (20 ER/77.2 IP).

WY NOT: All-Star third baseman Wyatt Mathisen is ranked tenth in the league with a .296 batting average and fourth with a .380 on-base percentage. On Thursday, Mathisen went 5-for-5, tying the Curve franchise record for most hits in a single game. It was the 15th five-hit game in Curve history.

THE SUMMER OF GEORGE: The Curve added OF/INF Jordan George from A-Adv. Bradenton on Friday, and he had a memorable Double-A debut in Saturday's double-header. In the first game, he clubbed a two-run homer to pick up his first hit with the Curve and added a two-run double, finishing the game with four RBIs. He added a hit, an RBI and a run scored in the second game of the double-header. He is hitting .344 (11/32) with six RBIs in his first nine games. George hit .302 with nine homers and 43 RBIs over 69 games with Bradenton.

RETURN OF THE JIN-DE: After missing the first six weeks of the season, catcher **Jin-De Jhang** was batting .184 in 31 games prior to July 8, Since then, he has hit .280 (21/75) in 20 games with two home runs, four doubles and 14 RBIs. He picked up five RBIs on Thursday, the most for a Curve player in a game this year. Behind the plate, he has thrown out 51.4 percent (18/35) of base stealing attempts this season, the best in the Eastern League this season, well above the league-average of 35.6 percent.

C-N-O: Reliever Tate Scioneaux has held opposing batters to a .198 average, third-best in the league among relievers. Scioneaux is tied for second in the league with 37 appearances, has the second-lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.65) and has allowed the third-fewest baserunners (8.37/9 IP). Scioneaux has the best ERA (1.90) out of all relievers in the league with at least 50 innings pitched.
