YESTERDAY: The Curve split a double-header with the Trenton Thunder. In game one, Elvis Escobar hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the seventh after Wyatt Mathisen led off the inning with a triple to give the Curve a 3-2 victory. Mitch Keller struck out nine over six innings and allowed two runs, which both scored on a two-out, two-run single by Ryan McBroom in the sixth. Anderson Feliz brought in the Curve's first run with a groundout and Jerrick Suiter added a run with a single in the first inning. In game two, Trenton scored two runs in the third and two in the fourth to shut out the Curve, 4-0. Austin Coley matched a career high with eight strikeouts, his highest total this season.

TODAY: The Curve conclude a four-game, three-day series against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The Curve are in a stretch of playing 11 of 18 games against Trenton. The two teams split a two-game series in Altoona from June 20-21, with the finale being postponed due to rain. Trenton won three of four games at PNG Field from July 27-30 and won two of three in Trenton from August 4-6. In eight total losses to the Thunder, the Curve have lost by one run five times and two runs twice.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Casey Sadler** makes his fourth start and his eighth overall appearance for the Curve. He last pitched on Tuesday, allowing three earned runs over six innings in a no-decision against Erie. Sadler underwent Tommy John surgery on November 10, 2015 and missed the entire 2016 season. He went 11-7 with a 3.31 ERA for the Curve in 2013 over 23 starts and was selected as an Eastern League All-Star, earning late-season promotion to Indianapolis. He made his Major League debut on May 2, 2014 and made six relief outings for the Pirates that year. He made one MLB start, a win over the Brewers on April 12, 2015, his most recent Major League appearance. Sadler made his return to the mound in May with A-Adv. Bradenton, pitching in six relief outings with a 0.75 ERA before being sent to Triple-A in early-June, where he posted a 5.23 ERA in eight outings. He was assigned to the Curve on July 5. Pittsburgh drafted Sadler in the 25th round in 2010. *For more on Sadler, see page two.*

FOR TRENTON: Left-hander Daniel Camarena makes his 11th start of the season for the Thunder. He last pitched on Tuesday, allowing four earned runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision at Hartford. He faced the Curve at PNG Field on July 29 and allowed four earned runs over 4.2 innings and did not pick up a decision. Camarena is in his third season with the Thunder and has posted a 12-13 career record with a 4.03 ERA over 45 outings (42 starts) at Double-A. He was drafted in the 20th round by the Yankees in 2011 out of Cathedral Catholic (Calif.) High School.

EAST FEAST: The Curve are in their 10th of 19 consecutive games against the Eastern League Eastern Division. Overall, 26 of the 30 games from July 24-August 23 are against teams from the East. Since July 24, the Curve have gone 8-8 against the opposite division. For the season, the Curve are 21-16 when facing the Eastern Division, including a 14-11 mark at home and a 7-5 record on the road.

GOOD IN A PINCH: **Jonathan Schwind** clubbed the Curve's third pinch-hit homer of the season in last night's win, a three-run shot in the sixth to put the Curve ahead, 6-3. All three of the Altoona's pinch-hit homers have ultimately been game winners. **Jordan Luplow** hit a two-run homer as a pinch hitter on May 17 at Binghamton to break a 6-6 tie in an 8-6 win. **Chase Simpson** hit a three-run homer in the seventh inning on June 7 at Harrisburg in a 5-3 Curve win. Overall this season, Curve pinch hitters are batting .349 (15/42).

CLOSE CALLS: The Curve have gone 12-12 in their last 24 games, and seven of those losses have been by one run. Their last 12 losses since July 18 have been by an average of 1.7 runs (20 runs/12 games). The Curve have played 45 one-run games this year, the most in the Eastern League, and have posted a 21-24 record in those games.

THE SUMMER OF GEORGE: The Curve added OF/INF **Jordan George** from A-Adv. Bradenton on July 28, and he had a memorable Double-A debut the double-header on July 29. In the first game, he clubbed a two-run homer to pick up his first hit with the Curve and added a two-run double, finishing the game with four RBIs. He added a hit, an RBI and a run scored in the second game of the double-header. He is hitting .320 (16/50) with seven RBIs in his first 14 games. George hit .302 with nine homers and 43 RBIs over 69 games with Bradenton.

RETURN OF THE JIN-DE: After missing the first six weeks of the season, catcher **Jin-De Jhang** was batting .184 in 31 games prior to July 8. Since then, he has hit .272 (25/92) in 24 games with three home runs, four doubles and 17 RBIs. He picked up five RBIs last Thursday, the most for a Curve player in a game this year. Behind the plate, he has thrown out 47.4 percent (18/38) of base stealing attempts this season, the best in the Eastern League this season of catchers with at least 35 attempts against him.

C-N-O: Reliever **Tate Scioneaux** has held opposing batters to a .201 average, third-best in the league among relievers. Scioneaux is tied for first in the league with 39 appearances, has the second-lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.58) and has allowed the third-fewest baserunners (8.39/9 IP). Scioneaux has the second-best ERA (1.95) out of all relievers in the league with at least 50 innings pitched.

SAVE IT: The Curve lead the Eastern League with 39 saves this season, their third-highest total in a year since 2008 (They had 47 in 2010 and 44 in 2015). The team record for saves in a single season is 49, which the Curve posted in 2006. **Montana DuRapau** (14) and **Tate Scioneaux** (11) are the third duo of relievers in franchise history to individually record double-digit saves in a single season. **Jhondaniel Medina** (12) and **Yhonathan Barrios** (10) accomplished the feat in 2015, as did **Jeff Miller** (18) and **Elio Serrano** (14) in 2004.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Mitch Keller** (2), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Kevin Kramer** (10), **Yeudy Garcia** (19), **Brandon Waddell** (23) and **Dario Agrazal** (29). Six players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Keller (2), Tucker (8), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27).

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach in Altoona. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. He closed out his playing career with Altoona in 2012, playing 15 games, along with one game for Triple-A Indianapolis.

In his sixth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens joins Altoona for the first time in 2017. He spent the last two years in Bradenton, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last four seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
