YESTERDAY: The Curve dropped their 2017 regular-season road finale at Richmond, 4-3, in 11 innings. An error by third baseman Wyatt Mathisen allowed the winning run to score. Anderson Feliz gave the Curve a 3-2 lead in the top of the 11th, but Richmond fought back to tie the score and walk off in the bottom of the inning. Brandon Waddell worked seven innings and struck out six while allowing two runs, both scoring on a two-run homer by K.C. Hobson that tied the score at 2-2 in the seventh. Jin-De Jhang gave the Curve a 2-0 lead in the first with a two-run double.

TODAY: The Curve play the first of four games against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, for the final series of the regular season. The Curve opened the season in Harrisburg, splitting a four-game set from April 7-9, and won two of three games at home from April 28-30. The Curve also took two of three games at Harrisburg from June 6-8. The two teams last met from July 17-19 at PNG Field, when the Curve won two of three games.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Mitch Keller** makes his sixth Double-A start for the Curve. Last time out, he picked up his second loss after allowing four earned runs over 5.2 innings against the Baysox on Sunday. Keller allowed two earned runs in each of his first four Double-A starts. He was promoted to Double-A on August 4 after going 6-3 with a 3.14 ERA over 15 starts with A-Adv. Bradenton. Keller is currently ranked as the Pirates' No. 2 prospect, the No. 22 prospect in baseball and the No. 6 RHP prospect by MLB.com. He went 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA over his last three starts with Bradenton. Last season, Keller went 9-5 with a 2.35 ERA over 24 total starts and was named as MiLB.com's fans' choice Top Breakout Prospect of the Year and the South Atlantic League's Most Outstanding Pitcher. **For more on Keller, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Brady Dragmire makes his sixth start and 18th overall appearance for the Senators. He last pitched on Sunday, allowing two earned runs over 5.2 innings in a no-decision at Reading. As a starter with the Senators, Dragmire is 2-0 with a 3.52 ERA and has posted a 2.25 ERA in 12 relief outings. Dragmire was drafted by the Blue Jays in the 17th round in 2011 and joined the Texas Rangers organization to open the 2017 season. He pitched in 20 games with Triple-A Round Rock, where he went 0-4 with a 5.70 ERA and was released on June 16. Dragmire signed with the Nationals as a free agent on June 20.

PLAYOFF BOUND: The Curve solidified a playoff berth for the third straight season with Tuesday night's win at Richmond. They currently lead the Western Division by one game over Bowie with four games remaining. This year marks the second time in franchise history the Curve have reached the playoffs in three straight seasons (They went to the playoffs in four consecutive years from 2003-2006). The Curve have won their division two times: 2004 and 2010. In both of those seasons, they advanced to the Eastern League Championship series, losing in the finals to New Hampshire in 2004 and winning their only E.L. title to date in 2010 over Trenton. The win on Tuesday also locked up the Curve's 12th winning season in their first 19 years.

PITCH PERFECT: Over the last 12 games since August 20, Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 5-3 with a 2.74 ERA (22 ER/72.1 IP). In that stretch, **J.T. Brubaker** is 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (8 ER/16 IP) in three starts, **Brandon Waddell** is 1-0 with a 1.45 ERA (3 ER/18.2 IP) in three starts, **Mitch Keller** is 1-1 with a 5.06 ERA (6 ER/10.2 IP) in two starts, **Casey Sadler** is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in one start and **Alex McRae** is 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (4 ER/11 IP) in two starts.

COLE WORLD: **Cole Tucker** is batting .388 (19/49) over his last 12 games with 10 RBIs, two doubles, a triple and one homer. He has picked up five go-ahead hits for the Curve dating back to Aug. 20, when he hit an RBI single in the 10th inning at New Hampshire to lift the Curve to a 6-5 win. On Aug. 21, he clubbed a two-run homer in a 2-0 win at Hartford. On Aug. 22, he gave the Curve a lead with a two-run triple to give the Curve the lead in a 5-4 win at Hartford. On Saturday, Tucker broke a 1-1 tie with a go-ahead single in the sixth inning in a win over the Baysox. He broke a scoreless tie in a 3-1 win on Tuesday at Richmond as the Curve clinched a postseason berth.

CLOSE CALLS: The Curve have gone 21-20 in their last 41 games, and nine of those losses have been by one run. Their last 20 losses since July 18 have been by an average of 2.2 runs (43 runs/20 games). The Curve have played 52 one-run games this year, the most in the Eastern League, and have posted a 26-26 record in those games.

SEARCHING FOR HITS: The Curve hit .243 in the month of August, the lowest in the Eastern League and the lowest for the Curve in a single month this season. The team average for the season is currently .255, which would tie the second-lowest in franchise history (2008 Curve also hit .255), trailing only the 2013 team, which hit .252.

C-N-O: Reliever **Tate Scioneaux** has held opposing batters to a .210 average, tied for third-best in the league among relievers. Scioneaux is ranked third in the league with 44 appearances, has the lowest BB/9 IP ratio (1.47) and has allowed the second-fewest baserunners (8.62/9 IP). He has converted each of his last eight save attempts.

SAVE IT: The Curve lead the Eastern League with 44 saves this season, tied for their second-highest total in a year since 2008 (They had 47 in 2010 and 44 in 2015). The team record for saves in a single season is 49, which the Curve posted in 2006. **Montana DuRapau** (14) and **Tate Scioneaux** (14) are the third duo of relievers in franchise history to individually record double-digit saves in a single season. **Jhondaniel Medina** (12) and **Yhonthan Barrios** (10) accomplished the feat in 2015, as did **Jeff Miller** (18) and **Elio Serrano** (14) in 2004.

ELVIS IS IN THE BUILDING: Center fielder **Elvis Escobar** is batting .339 (21/62) over his last 17 games with seven RBIs. He lifted the Curve to a 3-2 win with a walk-off single against Trenton on August 12 in the first game of a double-header. The next day, he drove a walk-off single in the bottom of the tenth to hand the Curve a 5-4 win against the Thunder. He is the only Curve player to have multiple walk-off hits this season. Escobar has seven three-hit games this season, which is tied for most on the team. However, Escobar is hitting .087 (2-for-23) dating back to August 25.

WHAT A RELIEF: Over 15 games since July 15, **Luis Heredia** posted a 0.87 ERA (2 ER/20.2 IP). **Tanner Anderson** has a 0.87 ERA (2 ER/20.2 IP) in nine appearances since moving to the bullpen on July 31. Since July 3, **Tate Scioneaux** has converted all eight save chances and has a 2.08 ERA (6 ER/26 IP) in 18 games. Right-hander **Yeudy Garcia** has posted a 3.09 ERA (8 ER/23.1 IP) and added three saves over 14 outings since moving to the bullpen full time in early July.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster currently features six of MLB.com's Mid-Season Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Mitch Keller** (2), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Kevin Kramer** (10), **Yeudy Garcia** (19), **Brandon Waddell** (23) and **Dario Agrazal** (29). Six players are also ranked in *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pittsburgh prospects list: Keller (2), Tucker (8), Garcia (16), Waddell (17), Kramer (21) and **Jin-De Jhang** (27).

Mitch Thomas Keller...Attended Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the same school that produced outfielder Ryan Sweeney...Was ranked as the No. 1 baseball prospect in the state of Iowa and ranked No. 31 of all prospects nationally by Perfect Game...Central All Region 1st Team his senior year in 2014...Added nearly 10 mph to his fastball between his junior and senior seasons...3.7 GPA throughout high school... Was committed to play collegiately at the University of North Carolina, but decided to forgo his scholarship after signing with the Pirates after the team selected him in the 2nd round of the 2014 draft...Named as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates organization by Baseball America entering the 2017 season...Older brother Jon Keller is a right-handed pitcher in the Baltimore Orioles organization and played in the Eastern League for Bowie in 2015-17...Currently ranked by MLB.com as the Pirates' No. 2 prospect, No. 22 overall prospect and No. 6 RHP prospect

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach in Altoona. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. He was drafted in the 23rd round of the 2003 MLB draft by the Pirates out of Miami Dade College. With the Curve, in 2011, Picart hit .218 with one home run and 14 RBIs in 56 games. He closed out his playing career with Altoona in 2012, playing 15 games, along with one game for Triple-A Indianapolis.

In his sixth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens joins Altoona for the first time in 2017. He spent the last two years in Bradenton, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last four seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
