THE CURVE: Altoona finished the season eight games over .500 and won the Western Division by two games over the Baysox. The title marked the franchise's third regular-season division championship in franchise history, winning the South Division in 2004 and the Western Division in 2010. This year, the Curve led the West for 96 of 140 games and took over sole possession of the top spot for good on August 22. The Curve won 10 of their final 16 games, including a season-best five-game winning streak from August 20-24. Altoona clinched the Western Division regular-season title with a walk-off win over Harrisburg on September 4 and a loss by Bowie at Richmond that afternoon. The Curve advanced to the ELCS with a three-game sweep over the Bowie Baysox in the Western Division Series.

THE THUNDER: Trenton posted their best record in franchise history, going 92-48 in the regular season, including a 52-20 mark at home. They finished the year with the top pitching staff in the league, posting a franchise-record 2.83 ERA, the lowest in the Eastern League since 1976, with 1160 strikeouts. They also tossed 20 shutout wins this year, another franchise record. On Friday, Justin Sheffield and Taylor Widener combined to no-hit Binghamton in Game 2 of the Eastern Division Series. After losing Game 1 of their Division Series, the Thunder won their next three games to advance to the ELCS, outscoring the Rumble Ponies, 20-7. Trenton is in the Eastern League postseason for the 12th time in their 24 seasons and the ninth time in the last 13 years. They have won three EL titles: 2007, 2008 and 2013.

IN THE ELCS: The Curve face the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, in Game 3 of the Eastern League Championship Series at Peoples Natural Gas Field tonight. The Curve won the first two games of the series in Trenton and have won all five of their postseason games. Dating back to the regular season, the Curve have won seven straight games, their longest winning streak of the season. In Game 1, Brandon Waddell worked six scoreless innings and Tanner Anderson closed out the save as the Curve beat the Thunder, 2-1. Last night, J.T. Brubaker allowed one earned run over eight innings, Elvis Escobar drove in a pair of runs and Yeudy Garcia worked a scoreless ninth in a 4-2 win as the Curve took a 2-0 lead in the series. An Altoona win tonight would clinch the Curve's second Eastern League title in franchise history.

AGAINST THE THUNDER: The Curve went 5-8 against Trenton this season, with five losses coming by one run and two by two runs. On June 20, the Curve beat the Thunder 14-4, handing Trenton their worst loss of the season. Altoona went to Trenton for one series, going 1-2 at ARM & HAMMER Park, losing the finale in extra innings. The Thunder posted a 4.05 ERA against the Curve, their highest against any E.L. opponent this year, with a 2.71 ERA against the other ten teams.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Mitch Keller takes the mound in Game 3. He last pitched in Game 1 of the Western Division Series, tossing a complete-game shutout on 90 pitches at Bowie. It was the deepest he has pitched in a game in his professional career, surpassing the eight innings he threw in the postseason for Bradenton last year. In that outing on Thursday, Keller faced the minimum 27 batters for the game, allowing just one hit and two walks. Keller made his first two Double-A starts against Trenton this year in early August, posting a 3.00 ERA without picking up a decision. Dating back to the regular season, Keller has not allowed a run in his last two starts, spanning 15 innings. He was promoted to Double-A on August 4 after going 6-3 with a 3.14 ERA over 15 starts with A-Adv. Bradenton, where he was picked as a Florida State League All-Star. Between Altoona and Bradenton, Keller posted a 3.03 ERA this season in 23 starts, seventh-best in the Pirates' system, and he ranked fourth in the system with 116 strikeouts. Keller has made three total postseason starts in his career, with two coming last season with Bradenton. He pitched Game 1 of the Marauders' first-round series against St. Lucie, picking up a win after allowing three runs in 5.1 innings, all coming across in the fifth, and added eight strikeouts. He also started Game 3 of the championship series against Tampa, working eight scoreless innings and allowing four hits in a win. Overall, he is 3-0 with a 1.21 ERA (3 ER/22.1 IP) in playoff starts. Last season, Keller went 9-5 with a 2.35 ERA over 24 total starts and was named as MiLB.com's fans' choice Top Breakout Prospect of the Year and the South Atlantic League's Most Outstanding Pitcher. *For more on Keller, see page two.*

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Will Carter takes the mound for Game 3 of the ELCS. He last pitched in Game 4 of the Eastern Division Series, picking a win as Trenton eliminated Binghamton and advanced to the Championship Series, tossing 6.1 innings and allowing one earned run on three hits. Carter spend the beginning of the season on the disabled list and was activated with Trenton on June 20. He made six regular season starts for the Thunder and nine relief appearances. As a starter, he went 2-1 with a 3.62 ERA. Carter was drafted by the Yankees in the 14th round in 2015 out of the University of Alabama.

BACK TO THE PLAYOFFS: The Curve solidified a playoff berth for the third straight season with a 3-1 win on August 29 at Richmond. The Curve are the only team to reach the Eastern League postseason in each of the last three seasons. This year marks the second time in franchise history the Curve have reached the playoffs in three straight seasons (They went to the playoffs in four consecutive years from 2003-2006). The Curve have won their division two other times: 2004 and 2010. In both of those seasons, they advanced to the Eastern League Championship series, losing in the finals to New Hampshire in 2004 and winning their only E.L. title to date in 2010 over Trenton. This year's Curve team posted the sixth-best record in team history (.529 winning percentage).

CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES HISTORY: The Curve have picked up regular-season division titles three times, including this year, and they have won their Division Series match-ups all three times to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series. In 2004, the Curve swept the Erie SeaWolves in the Division Series and were swept in three games in the ELCS by New Hampshire. In 2010, the Curve beat the Harrisburg Senators in the divisional round and faced the Trenton Thunder in the Championship Series, winning in four games. The Curve lost the first game at home, which was started by rehabbing Major Leaguer Andy Pettitte, but bounced back to win Game 2 at home and took the next two games in Trenton to lock up their first Eastern League title in franchise history.

PITCH PERFECT: Over the last 20 games since August 20 (including playoffs), Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 12-3 with a 2.11 ERA (31 ER/132.1 IP). In that stretch, J.T. Brubaker is 1-1 with a 3.30 ERA (11 ER/30 IP) in four starts, Brandon Waddell is 2-0 with a 1.09 ERA (3 ER/24.2 IP) in three starts, Mitch Keller is 3-1 with a 2.10 ERA (6 ER/25.2 IP) in three starts, Casey Sadler is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in one start, Alex McRae is 2-0 with a 3.68 ERA (9 ER/22 IP) in four starts and Austin Coley is 3-0 with a 0.43 ERA in three starts (1 ER/21 IP).

CLOSE CALLS: The Curve went 24-21 in their last 45 regular-season games, and ten of those were by one run. Their last 21 losses since July 18 were by an average of 2.1 runs (44 runs/21 games). The Curve played 54 one-run games this year, the most in the Eastern League, and posted a 27-27 record in those games.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: 23 players on the Curve roster have previous playoff experience including 21 players over the previous two seasons. Kevin Kramer, Casey Hughton, Mitchell Tolman, Tate Scioneaux, Brandon Waddell, Tanner Anderson, J.T. Brubaker and Daniel Zamora played during the playoffs for the 2015 New York-Penn League-champion West Virginia Black Bears during their championship run. Anderson, Brubaker, Kramer, Scioneaux, Mitch Keller, Wyatt Mathisen, Pablo Reyes, Jerrick Suiter, Michael Suchy, Sean Keselica, Yeudy Garcia and Austin Coley were with Bradenton during the playoffs in their title run last season under manager Michael Ryan. Waddell, Alex McRae, Jin-De Jhang, Tomas Morales, Elvis Escobar and Jonathan Schwind saw action in last year's Eastern League playoffs. Johnny Hellweg pitched in the Midwest League playoffs in 2010 and California League playoffs in 2011. Luis Heredia pitched in the 2015 South Atlantic League postseason. Escobar, Jhang and Mathisen also won a championship in 2012 with the GCL Pirates.

WHAT A RELIEF: Over his 17 games since July 15, Luis Heredia posted a 1.57 ERA (4 ER/23.0 IP). Tanner Anderson has a 1.07 ERA (3 ER/25.1 IP) in 12 appearances (including playoffs) since moving to the bullpen on July 31. Since July 3, Tate Scioneaux has converted all eight save chances and has a 1.86 ERA (6 ER/29 IP) in 20 games, including one playoff appearance. Right-hander Yeudy Garcia posted a 2.63 ERA (8 ER/27.1 IP) and added four saves over 17 outings since moving to the bullpen full time in early July, including two playoff outings.

Mitch Thomas Keller...Attended Xavier High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, the same school that produced outfielder Ryan Sweeney...Was ranked as the No. 1 baseball prospect in the state of Iowa and ranked No. 31 of all prospects nationally by Perfect Game...Central All Region 1st Team his senior year in 2014...Added nearly 10 mph to his fastball between his junior and senior seasons...3.7 GPA throughout high school...Was committed to play collegiately at the University of North Carolina, but decided to forgo his scholarship after signing with the Pirates after the team selected him in the 2nd round of the 2014 draft...Named as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates organization by Baseball America entering the 2017 season...Older brother Jon Keller is a right-handed pitcher in the Baltimore Orioles organization and played in the Eastern League for Bowie in 2015-17...Currently ranked by MLB.com as the Pirates' No. 2 prospect, No. 22 overall prospect and No. 6 RHP prospect

Ryan returns to Altoona after serving as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He spent the past four seasons as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders the last two years and the West Virginia Power the two before that. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson joins the Altoona staff in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates' organization. He has spent the last 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

2017 marks Riggs' third year as the Altoona hitting coach, and his third year in the Pirates' organization. Riggs spent eight seasons coaching in the Rockies' organization, and has some managerial experience, serving as the skipper for the Double-A Tulsa Drillers for two seasons (2013-2014). As a player, Riggs was drafted by Cincinnati in the 28th round in 1990 out of East Carolina, reaching Double-A. He ended his career by playing one season in China, where he was the league MVP in 1998.

Picart joins the Curve for his first season as a coach in Altoona. He played for Altoona in parts of two seasons from 2011-2012, appearing in 71 games. Schlesinger joins the Curve for his first season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia, and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
