Cole Tucker reached on an infield single in the top of the 10th to score the go-ahead run. Yeudy Garcia stranded the tying run at third in the bottom of the inning to close out his first save of the season. Curve starter Dario Agrazal worked seven scoreless innings and allowed four hits. The Curve took a

TONIGHT: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues at Canal Park in Akron, Ohio against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians in the finale of a four-game series. The Curve are looking to avoid being swept in four games for the first time dropping all four games at Bowie from June 26-29, 2017, which was also the last time the Curve lost four games in a row. The Curve were also swept in four games last season by Akron at home from May 22-25 during a season-worst six-game losing streak. The last four-game sweep in Akron over the Curve game from May 19-22, 2008.

THE CURVE: After taking three-of-four against Akron to open the season, the Curve split a shortened two-game series with Harrisburg at home. They followed with an abbreviated, two-game sweep at Erie, but dropped three of four in Akron, salvaging the road trip finale on Thursday night. The Curve have a 2.33 team ERA, second-best in the league.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: With the best record in the Eastern League, Richmond won three-of-four at home against Bowie heading into this series. From April 13-18, they went on a six-game winning streak and won nine-of-ten from April 8-18 prior to losing the series finale against the Baysox on Thursday. Richmond's pitching staff has combined for a 2.54 team ERA, thirdbest in the Eastern League

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander **Brandon Waddell** takes the mound for his third start of the season. Last time out, he worked six innings and allowed one unearned run in a no-decision at Erie on Saturday. He is tied with Mitch Keller for fourth in the league with a 0.77 ERA, has the second-lowest baserunners/9 IP ratio (6.17) and the third-lowest BB/9 IP ratio (0.77). Last year, Waddell began the season 0-2 with a 4.55 ERA over his first eight starts prior to the All-Star Break, but hit the disabled list twice, including for a long stretch from June 8 through July 31 with a left forearm strain. When he returned, he posted a 3-1 record with a 2.82 ERA in his final seven regular-season starts. The Houston native also pitched game one of the ELCS at Trenton on September 12, throwing six scoreless innings in a 2-1 Curve win, which extended his career postseason scoreless streak to 19.0 innings in three starts. Waddell pitched the University of Virginia to a College World Series title in 2015, and he was the winning pitcher in their national championship clincher against Vanderbilt. He is ranked as the Pirates' No. 19 prospect by Baseball America and No. 29 by MLB.com. He went 0-1 with a 1.23 ERA in three starts against Akron last year.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Garrett Williams makes his third start of the season. He picked up a win on April 9 after allowing two earned runs in five innings at Hartford. He followed with four innings pitched on Sunday and allowed two earned runs in a no decision. Williams split 2017 between Single-A August and A-Adv. San Jose, combining to go 6-5 with a 2.32 ERA in 16 starts and two relief outings. He is ranked as the Giants' No. 9 prospect by MLB.com.

HITTING A WALL: After averaging 5.2 runs per game (26 total runs) through the first five games of the season, the Curve have averaged 2.4 runs per game (17 total runs) over the last seven games and scored two or less runs five times.

HOME COOKIN': The Curve went 4-2 on the season-opening homestand before a 3-3 road trip to Akron and Erie. In the six home games, the Curve hit .237 with three homers and scored 26 runs. On the road, the team hit .213 with no homers and scored 16 runs in six games. Overall, Altoona has a .225 team batting average, ranked seventh out of the Eastern League's

THE STARTING LINE: Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 1.19 ERA (9 ER/68.1 IP) over the first 12 games of the 2018 season, the best start for Altoona starters since 2015, when they were 5-0 with a 0.56 ERA (4 ER/64.0 IP) through the first 12 games. That year, starting pitchers Jason Creasy, Zack Dodson, Tyler Glasnow, Chad Kuhl and Angel Sanchez began the year 6-0 with a 0.71 ERA (6 ER/75.2 IP) over their first 14 games. Over the last 27 regular-season games dating back to August 20, 2017, Curve starters have combined to go 9-5 with a 1.80 ERA (33 ER/164.2 IP). Including the Curve's six postseason games in 2017, Curve starters are 15-5 with a 1.77 ERA (41 ER/208.0 IP) over the last 33 games. The Curve have four starters ranked in the top eight in the league in ERA: Keller (0.77/T-4rd), Waddell (0.77/T-4rd), Hearn (0.82/T-6th) and Aarazal (1.00/8th). (0.82/T-6th) and Agrazal (1.00/8th).

KE' PLAYS FROM HAYES: After posting a .050 (1/20) average through his first five games, Ke'Bryan Hayes has hit .385 (10/26) over his last seven games, including two three-hit games and one two-hit game, while collecting an RBI in three straight games from 4/13-4/16.

MARTIN MAKING STRIDES: Outfielder Jason Martin was activated on April 10 and went 0-for-8 with five strikeouts in his first two games with Altoona. Since then, he has hit .429 (9/21). His three triples are tied for the Eastern League lead. Martin was picked up by the Pirates along with 3B Colin Moran, RHP Joe Musgrove and RHP Michael Feliz in a trade that sent RHP Gerrit Cole to the Astros on January 13.

COLE TRAIN: Over his last 29 games dating back to August 17, 2017, Cole Tucker is hitting .342 (38/111) with seven doubles, three triples, two homers, 18 RBIs and 19 walks. He currently leads qualifying Curve batters with a .333 batting average to open the 2018 season.

WY NOT: Infielder Wyatt Mathisen is hitting .400 through his five games played this season and has worked five walks. He has added three doubles in his ten atbats. Mathisen was the starting third baseman in the 2017 Eastern League All-Star Game for the Western Division, but has played exclusively at first base in his three defensive starts this year.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster features ten of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: Mitch Keller (1), Ke'Bryan Hayes (4), Cole Tucker (5), Bryan Reynolds (6), Taylor Hearn (11), Will Craig (18), Stephen Alemais (20), Jason Martin (22), Brandon Waddell (27) and Dario Agrazal (29). The roster also features eight of Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospects: Keller (1), Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Waddell (19), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," Keller as having the "Best Fastball," Best Curveball" and "Best Control," Waddell as having the "Best Changeup," Christian Kelley as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." Keller is ranked by B.A. as the No. 12 prospect in baseball and the No. 15 overall prospect by MLB.com, as well as MLB.com's No. 5 overall RHP.
