YESTERDAY: The Curve blanked the SeaWolves, 7-0. Starter **J.T. Brubaker** worked seven innings and allowed three hits with no walks and six strikeouts. **Jesus Liranzo** worked a scoreless inning with three strikeouts in the eighth and **Geoff Hartlieb** pitched a 1-2-3 ninth inning. **Bralin Jackson** singled in a run in the second to start the scoring. **Will Craig** added to the lead with an RBI single in the third. In the fifth, **Jason Martin** singled to score **Cole Tucker** and **Stephen Alemais** came in after a fielding error by Erie. Craig singled in Martin in the sixth and again in the seventh to extend the lead to 6-0, and **Jackson Williams** added a seventh run with an RBI single in the eighth.

TONIGHT: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues at PNG Field as the Curve host the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers in the second of a three-game series. The Curve swept an abbreviated, two-game series at Erie's UPMC Park from April 13-14, with the finale being postponed.

THE CURVE: After opening the season with a 6-2 record, Altoona lost five of eight games, including three of four games at Akron and two of three at home against Richmond. During that span, the Curve were outscored 28-19. The team picked up their second shutout win of the season on Monday against Erie. The Curve pitching staff has the best WHIP (1.06) in the Eastern League.

THE SEAWOLVES: Erie began the season 3-0, but followed with a six-game losing streak and have lost 11 of its last 13 games overall. The SeaWolves were swept at Bowie with three straight walk-off losses from April 9-11, dropped both games at home against Altoona, lost two of three at home against Trenton and followed with two losses in three games at Binghamton prior to this series. Erie has the third-highest team batting average (.250) in the league.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Dario Agrazal** makes the fifth start of his Double-A career and fourth of 2018. Last time out, Agrazal tossed seven scoreless innings in a no-decision at Akron on Thursday. It was his second scoreless outing through his first three starts, after he worked six scoreless innings against Akron on April 10. He faced Erie on April 13 and picked up a win after allowing two runs over five innings. Agrazal pitched one game for the Curve last season, working four innings and allowing two runs in a loss against Trenton on June 21. He was placed on the disabled list with a right pectoral strain after the start and missed the remainder of the year. A native of Panama, Agrazal was an All-Star selection in the Dominican Summer League in 2013, the New-York Penn League with the West Virginia Black Bears in 2015 and with the Bradenton Marauders in the Florida State League last season. He is currently ranked by both *Baseball America* and *MLB.com* as the Pirates' No. 30 prospect.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Sandy Baez makes his fourth start of the season. Last time out, he was hit with his first loss after allowing three earned runs over five innings against Trenton on Thursday. Baez made two starts for Erie last season and went 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA after missing part of the season with an oblique strain. Baez signed with the Tigers as an international free agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2011.

BREAKING THROUGH: After averaging 5.2 runs per game (26 total runs) through the first five games of the season, the Curve averaged 2.5 runs per game (20 total runs) over the next eight games and scored two or less runs five times. Over the last three games, the Curve have averaged 5.7 runs (17 total runs) while hitting .346 (37/107) with five doubles, one triple and two homers.

THE STARTING LINE: Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 4-3 with a 1.94 ERA (20 ER/93.0 IP) over the first 16 games of the 2018 season. Over the last 31 regular-season games dating back to August 20, 2017, Curve starters have combined to go 11-6 with a 2.09 ERA (44 ER/189.1 IP). Including the Curve's six postseason games in 2017, Curve starters are 17-6 with a 2.01 ERA (52 ER/232.2 IP) over the last 37 games.

WORKING DEEP: Altoona was the only team in Double-A to have its starting pitchers work at least five innings in every game this year prior to Sunday's outing by **Taylor Hearn**. Through the first 16 games of the season, Curve starters have combined for 93.0 innings, averaging 5.8 innings per game. The starters have worked 7.0 innings three times, 6.0 innings six times, 5.2 innings twice, 5.0 innings four times and 4.2 innings once.

MARTIN MAKING STRIDES: Outfielder **Jason Martin** was activated on April 10 and went 0-for-8 with five strikeouts in his first two games with Altoona. Since then, he has hit .417 (15/36) over ten games with a homer, three doubles, three triples, four RBIs, six walks and 10 runs scored. On Saturday, he hit his first Double-A homer and finished a triple shy of the cycle. He was walked six times in the last five games. Martin is ranked ninth in the league with a .341 batting average, third with a .614 slugging percentage and tied for first with three triples. Martin was picked up by the Pirates along with 3B Colin Moran, RHP Joe Musgrove and RHP Michael Feliz in a trade that sent RHP Gerrit Cole to the Astros on January 13.

COLE TRAIN: Over his last 32 games dating back to August 17, 2017, **Cole Tucker** is hitting .336 (41/122) with nine doubles, three triples, two homers, 18 RBIs and 20 walks. He currently ranks second on the Curve batters with a .321 batting average to open the 2018 season.

WY NOT: Infielder **Wyatt Mathisen** is hitting .438 through his eight games played this season, has worked eight walks and been hit by a pitch twice, posting a .643 on-base percentage. He has added three doubles and one triple in his 16 at-bats. Mathisen was the starting third baseman in the 2017 Eastern League All-Star Game for the Western Division, but has played exclusively at first base and second base this season.

THE SUMMER OF GEORGE: After missing the start of the season with a hamstring strain, **Jordan George** was activated on April 20. So far, he has collected five singles in his three starts over his last nine at-bats. Last year, George hit .302 over 99 games with Bradenton and Altoona.

ALEMAIS-ING: Infielder **Stephen Alemais** is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak, which is tied for the third-longest active streak in the Eastern League. For the season, Alemais has hit safely in 13 of his 15 games, with the two lone hitless performances coming on back-to-back games on April 13 and April 16.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster features ten of *MLB.com*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Mitch Keller** (1), **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (4), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Bryan Reynolds** (6), **Taylor Hearn** (11), **Will Craig** (18), **Stephen Alemais** (20), **Jason Martin** (22), **Brandon Waddell** (27) and **Dario Agrazal** (29). The roster also features eight of *Baseball America*'s Top 30 Pirates prospects: Keller (1), Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Waddell (19), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," Keller as having the "Best Fastball," Best Curveball" and "Best Control," Waddell as having the "Best Changeup," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." Keller is ranked by B.A. as the No. 12 prospect in baseball and the No. 15 overall prospect by *MLB.com*, as well as *MLB.com*'s No. 5 overall RHP.
