**SATURDAY:** The Curve picked up a 5-2 win in the conclusion of Friday's rain-suspended game, and lost the regularly-scheduled game, 2-0. In the win, Christian Kelley went 2-for-3 and clubbed his third homer of the season, setting a new career high. Cole Tucker, Will Craig, Jordan George and Logan Hill each drove in a run for the Curve. In his Double-A debut, Pedro Vasquez worked three innings and allowed one run before rain halted play. Logan Sendelbach picked up a win with two innings pitched, and Tate Scioneaux worked two scoreless innings with two strikeouts to get his second save of the season. The series finale between the Curve and SeaWolves on Sunday was postponed due to rain.

**TONIGHT:** The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues at PNG Field as the Curve host the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the opener of a three-game series. This series marks the first meetings of the year between the two teams, who faced off in the Western Division Series last year, a 3-0 Curve sweep.

**THE CURVE:** After opening the season with a 6-2 record, Altoona lost eight of the next 11 games before winning five of the last six. Their five-game winning streak was snapped with a loss on Friday night to the SeaWolves. The Curve enter play today tied for second place in the division, two games behind Akron, and have won six of the last eight games. The Curve have played ten games decided by one run this season, the third-most in the league, and have won six of them.

**THE BAYSOX:** Bowie enters the series in fourth place in the Western Division, 4.5 games behind first-place Akron and 2.5 games behind Altoona. The Baysox were most recently swept at home in a four-game series by the RubberDucks, being outscored 41-5. They have lost eight of their last ten games overall, including being swept at Akron from April 27-29 and winning two of three at Erie from April 30-May 2. Over their last ten games, the Baysox have been outscored 76-28. The Bowie pitching staff has combined for a 6.06 ERA (59 ER/87.2 IP) in the last ten games. They have lost eight games this season by three runs or more, the most in the Eastern League, and have been shut out four times, tied for the most in the league.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Pittsburgh Pirates right-hander **Joe Musgrove** takes the mound on a major league rehab assignment. Picked up by the Pirates along with 3B Colin Moran, LF Jason Martin and Michael Feliz in the trade with the Houston Astros for Gerrit Cole, Musgrove was placed on the Pirates' 10-day disabled list on April 2 retroactive to March 30 with a right shoulder sprain. He made his first rehab start on Tuesday in Bradenton against Dunedin, working three innings and allowing two runs on five hits. Musgrove was drafted by the Blue Jays in the first round in 2011 and traded to the Astros in 2012. Musgrove reached the big leagues as a starter for the first time in 2016, going 4-4 with a 4.06 ERA in ten starts and one relief outing. He pitched in 38 games for the Astros last season, including 15 starts, on their way to winning the World Series championship. **For more on Musgrove, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Left-hander Jayson Aquino makes his first start for the Baysox this season. His previous four outings came with Triple-A Norfolk, where he went 1-2 with a 4.26 ERA. He last pitched on April 29 at Charlotte, where he allowed two earned runs over five innings in a no-decision. Aquino last pitched for Bowie in 2016, going 5-10 with a 3.90 ERA in 19 starts and one relief outing, and he was selected as an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star. He has pitched seven games in the majors for the Orioles over the last two years and worked his remaining 25 starts with Norfolk. Originally signed by the Rockies in 2010, Aquino has pitched in the Colorado, Toronto, Pittsburgh, Cleveland and Baltimore organizations in his career.

**TIMELY HITTING:** After hitting .069 (4/58) and scoring two total runs over the first two games of the road trip in Harrisburg, the Curve have improved to .255 (60/235) and scored 34 runs over the last eight games, averaging 4.3 runs per game. 24 of the 34 runs over the last eight games have scored in the fifth inning or later, with 15 runs scored in the seventh inning or later in the last eight games. The Altoona offense has also tallied nine multi-run innings in that span.

**KELLEY HEATING UP:** Over his last eight games since April 21, **Christian Kelley** is hitting .467 (14/30) with three homers, three doubles, six runs scored and nine RBIs, raising his batting average from .162 to .290. He set a new career high with his third homer of the season on Saturday. Kelley is ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the Pirates organization and leads the Eastern League with 13 base-stealing attempts thrown out this season.

**HAYES AT THE HOT CORNER:** **Ke'Bryan Hayes** was presented with this MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove Award on Thursday, honoring him as minor league baseball's top defensive third baseman for 2017 with Bradenton. He is currently leading the league with eight double plays started. At the plate, Hayes has hit .304 (7/23) over his last seven games since April 30 with two doubles.

**KING OF THE HILL:** After hitting .133 through his first 19 games, **Logan Hill** has hit .294 (5/17) over his last three games with a homer and three RBIs. His three homers on the season are tied for the team lead.

**J-MART:** Outfielder **Jason Martin** leads qualifying Curve hitters with a .296 batting average this season. Over his last five games, Martin has driven in four runs and added his second homer of the season on Thursday. He has also posted a .368 batting average (7/19) in his last five games.

**THE STARTING LINE:** Curve starting pitchers have combined to go 7-6 with a 2.60 ERA (45 ER/155.2 IP) over the first 27 games of the 2018 season. Over the last 42 regular-season games dating back to August 20, 2017, Curve starters have combined to go 14-9 with a 2.46 ERA (69 ER/252.0 IP). Including the Curve's six postseason games in 2017, Curve starters are 20-9 with a 2.33 ERA (77 ER/297.1 IP) over the last 48 games. The Curve have three starters ranked in the top-eight in the league in ERA: Agrazal (1.47/4th), Waddell (1.74/7th) and Brubaker (1.80/8th).

**WY NOT:** Infielder **Wyatt Mathisen** is hitting .385 through his 12 games played this season, has worked 11 walks and been hit by a pitch three times, posting a .585 on-base percentage. He has added a homer, three doubles and one triple in his 26 at-bats. Mathisen was the starting third baseman in the 2017 Eastern League All-Star Game for the Western Division.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster features ten of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Mitch Keller** (1), **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (4), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Bryan Reynolds** (6), **Taylor Hearn** (11), **Will Craig** (18), **Stephen Alemais** (20), **Jason Martin** (22), **Brandon Waddell** (27) and **Dario Agrazal** (29). The roster also features eight of Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospects: Keller (1), Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Waddell (19), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," Keller as having the "Best Fastball," "Best Curveball" and "Best Control," Waddell as having the "Best Changeup," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." Keller is ranked by B.A. as the No. 12 prospect in baseball and the No. 15 overall prospect by MLB.com, as well as MLB.com's No. 5 overall RHP.

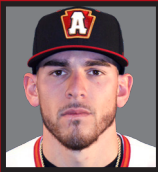

## MUSGROVE CAREER NOTES

Joseph Anthony Musgrove...2011 graduate of Grossmont High School in El Cajon, Calif., where he pitched and played first base...Went 7-5 with a 2.40 ERA (27 ER/78.1 IP) and 100 strikeouts in 14 games as a senior while also hitting .350 with nine homers and 32 RBIs...Also played offensive and defensive line on the Grossmont football team...Drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the supplemental first round (Comp. A, 46th overall)...Made professional debut in the GCL in 2011 and was ranked as the 15th-best prospect in the league after the season...Began 2012 with rookie-level Bluefield but was acquired by Houston as part of a 10-player trade on 7/20...Spent first full season with Astros org. in 2013 and pitched in the GCL...Spent all of 2014 in the New York-Penn League with Tri-City...Tied for second in the league in strikeouts and eighth in ERA...Named in 2014 as a Baseball America short-season All-Star and won the Tri-City MVP Award...Named Houston's minor league pitcher of the year in 2015 after combining to go 12-1 with a 1.88 ERA in 19 games (14 starts) across three levels, leading all of MiLB in SO/BB ratio (12.38)...Began 2016 at AA and led Texas League in ERA at time of promotion to AAA on 5/13...Starting pitcher for U.S. team in the Sirius/XM All-Star Futures Game in San Diego and tossed a perfect first inning...Made MLB debut with Houston on 8/2 in relief against Toronto and worked 4.1 scoreless innings, setting an MLB record for the most strikeouts by a reliever in his debut with eight...Spent most of 2017 split between the rotation and bullpen with the Astros, going 7-8 with a 4.77 ERA in their World Series title season
