**YESTERDAY:** The Curve walked off with a 1-0 win in the bottom of the ninth over Reading, the second straight shut out in the series. Tyler Gaffney brought home Stephen Alemais with a two-out single in the bottom of the ninth for the game's only run. Altoona starter Taylor Hearn worked seven scoreless innings and matched his season high with nine strikeouts. Yeudy Garcia and Sean Keselica worked the final six outs with a combined four strikeouts. Reading starter Ranger Suarez matched Hearn with seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits with nine strikeouts.

**TONIGHT:** The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve face the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in the first of three games at PNG Field. The series marks Hartford's only trip to Altoona this year and wraps up the season series between the two clubs, who play all six head-to-head games in a ten-day span. The Curve dropped two-of-three games in Hartford from June 1-3.

**THE CURVE:** After winning three straight games, the Curve lost three straight, including the final two games at Hartford over the weekend and Tuesday's game against Reading, and followed with back-to-back shutout wins against Reading. As a team, the Curve are hitting .263 (214/814) with 22 homers over the last 24 games since May 11, averaging 4.4 runs per game (105 runs) in that stretch.

**THE YARD GOATS:** Hartford has lost 12 of its last 15 games, including being swept in three games at Erie prior to this series. The Yard Goats lost seven consecutive games, their longest losing streak of the season, from May 26-June 1 before winning back-to-back games against the Curve at Dunkin' Donuts Park last weekend. Over the last 15 games since May 24, the Yard Goats are hitting .236 (115/488) as a team and have posted a 5.72 ERA (82 ER/129 IP).

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Cam Vieaux makes his Double-A debut for the Curve. He made 10 starts for A-Adv. Bradenton, going 4-1 with a 3.81 ERA. He last pitched last Friday against Charlotte, working six innings and a allowing three earned runs in a win with eight strikeouts. He has picked up 17 strikeouts over his last two starts. He led the Florida State League with nine homers allowed. Vieaux was a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star last year with the West Virginia Power, going 2-3 with a 2.73 ERA in 11 starts before a mid-season promotion to Bradenton, where he went 3-7 with a 4.39 ERA in 13 starts. He was drafted in the sixth round in 2016 by the Pirates out of Michigan State, where he went 17-16 with a 2.98 ERA in 48 career games (39 starts) for the Spartans. Vieaux will be the twelfth different starting pitcher for the Curve this season, matching totals from 2016 and 2017 for the season for the highest since 2014 (17).

**FOR HARTFORD:** Right-hander Jesus Tinoco makes his 12th start of the season for the Yard Goats and his second against the Curve. Last time out, he worked 6.1 innings and allowed three earned runs with eight strikeouts last Friday against the Curve in Hartford. From May 1-16, Tinoco went 1-3 with a 9.00 ERA (21 ER/21 IP) over four starts, but has a 3.24 ERA (6 ER/16.2 IP) over his last three starts. Tinoco is ranked as Colorado's 13th-best prospect by MLB.com. He was originally signed by the Blue Jays out of Venezuela in 2011 and was traded to the Rockies along with INF Jose Reyes, RHP Miguel Castro and RHP Jeff Hoffman for RHP LaTroy Hawkins and SS Troy Tulowitzki in 2015. He is in his first season at Double-A after going 11-4 with a 4.67 ERA last year with A-Adv. Lancaster.

**HOME COOKIN':** Over their last eight home games since May 19, the Curve have gone 6-2 and have allowed more than three runs in a game just once, a 4-2 loss to Reading on Tuesday night. The pitching staff has combined to post a 2.13 ERA (17 ER/72.0 IP) over the last eight games at PNG Field. The Altoona offense has combined to hit .275 (71/258) over the last eight games at home. The Curve have picked up walk-off wins in three of their last five home games.

**BLANK SPACE:** The Curve pitching staff has not allowed a run over the last 18 innings pitched, with back-to-back shutout wins against Reading, marking the first consecutive shut outs for Altoona since August 25 & 26, 2012 against Richmond. Altoona has two shutouts in the month of June, while the rest of the Eastern League has combined for two shutouts this month.

**RISP-Y BUSINESS:** Over the last 15 games since May 23, the Curve are hitting .206 (26/126) with runners in scoring position. In six games in the month of June, the team has combined to hit .198 (12/61) with runners in scoring position.

**ALEMAIS-ING:** After going 0-for-26 from May 4-18, **Stephen Alemais** has picked up 24 hits over his last 18 games, hitting .400 (24/60) since May 19, the fourth-best average across all of Double-A during that stretch. He opened the season with a .310 batting average over his first 15 games through April 23, but batted just .102 (6/59) over his next 18 games from April 25-May 18.

**COLE TRAIN:** Since May 20, **Cole Tucker** has hit .319 (22/69) in 16 games with three doubles, a triple, four RBIs and eight stolen bases. Over his previous 20 games from April 25-May 19, Tucker hit .104 (8/77), the lowest average in the Pirates organization among qualifying hitters. Prior to that slide, Tucker had posted a .321 (18/56) batting average over his first 15 games of the season. After starting the year 0-for-5 in stolen base attempts, Tucker has successfully stolen in eight of his last nine tries.

**KE' PLAYS:** **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has picked up at least one hit in 12 of his last 17 games since May 19, posting a .333 (22/66) average in that span with two homers, eight doubles and 10 RBIs. On Friday he matched a career high with four hits, the first Curve player with a four-hit game this season, and had a team-best three doubles. Last year's MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner as the top defensive third baseman in the minors, Hayes currently leads all Eastern League third basemen with a .974 fielding percentage on the 2018 season, while playing more games (53) at the position than anyone else in the circuit.

**J-MART:** Outfielder **Jason Martin** is ranked fourth in the Pirates organization and tied for fifth in the Eastern League with a .321 batting average on the season. His seven homers are second on the team and rank tied for fourth in the Pittsburgh organization. On the season, he has totaled seven three-hit games and a team-best 18 total multi-hit performances.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster features 10 of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Mitch Keller** (1), **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (4), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Bryan Reynolds** (6), **Taylor Hearn** (10), **Will Craig** (17), **Stephen Alemais** (19), **Jason Martin** (21), **Brandon Waddell** (26) and **Dario Agrazal** (28). The roster also features eight of Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospects: Keller (1), Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Waddell (19), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," Keller as having the "Best Fastball," Best Curveball" and "Best Control," Waddell as having the "Best Changeup," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." Keller is ranked by B.A. as the No. 12 prospect in baseball and the No. 15 overall prospect by MLB.com, as well as MLB.com's No. 5 overall RHP.

Ryan returns to Altoona after leading the Curve to the Eastern League title in 2017. He also served as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his sixth season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson returns to the Altoona staff after overseeing strong group of Curve pitchers in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates organization. He spent the previous 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher as a player, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

De Renne joins the Curve in 2018 for his sixth season overall working in the Pittsburgh minor league system and his fifth as a hitting coach. He managed the Pirates' affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2013 to a 46-26 record. He joined Michael Ryan's staff as the hitting coach for the West Virginia Power from 2014-15 and spent each of the last three seasons with the Bradenton Marauders. As a player, De Renne was drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 12th round in 2000 out of the University of Arizona and played 11 professional seasons.

Morales joins the Curve for his first season working in the Pirates organization. He spent the last five seasons as a coach with the Indios de Mayaguez of the Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente (Roberto Clemente Professional Baseball League) in Puerto Rico, working mostly with catchers, including major leaguers Martin Maldonado, Roberto Perez, Christian Vazquez, Rafael Lopez and Rene Rivera. As a player, Morales was drafted in the 23rd round in 1996 by the Florida Marlins and played 15 total professional seasons.

In his seventh season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens returns to Altoona for a second season in 2018.
