**YESTERDAY:** The Curve lost the opener of a five-game series in Akron, 4-3. The Curve left seven runners on base over the final four innings. They trailed, 4-2, in the eighth and loaded the bases with one out, but Bralin Jackson lined out to shortstop and Will Craig was doubled off at second to end the inning. In the ninth, Ke'Bryan Hayes hit an RBI single to pull the Curve within one, but they stranded runners at first and second. The Curve took a 1-0 lead in the first with a two-out RBI single by Craig, the first of his two hits in the game. Akron answered with an RBI double by Bobby Bradley to take a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the first. Altoona tied the score with a solo homer by Christian Kelley in the second. Willi Castro put Akron ahead with a solo homer in the seventh and added a run with an RBI double by Logan Ice.

**TONIGHT:** The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve play the second of a five-game set with the first-place Akron RubberDucks, the Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Altoona took two-of-three games at PNG Field including two walk-off wins when the two teams last met at the end of May. The Curve opened the season with three wins during a four-game series to open the season in Altoona, a series that also featured a last at-bat win for the Curve on Opening Day. The current series is the second visit to Canal Park this season for the Curve after the RubberDucks won three-of-four from April 16-19. The Eastern League's two most recent champions will meet two more times this season, a three-game set in Akron on July 23-25 and another three-game series in Altoona on August 3-5.

**THE CURVE:** After winning eight of nine games from June 6-16, the Curve lost four of six but have now won five of the last eight, including four out of five games in the previous series against Harrisburg. In the last seven games, Curve pitchers have combined to post a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67 IP). In the month of June, the Curve offense is ranked fourth in the league with a .269 average. The Curve are 15-11 in June, tied with Akron for the second-best record in the league this month behind Erie (18-8). For the season, the Curve are ranked second in the Eastern League with seven shutouts, one behind Erie. The Curve entered Thursday's game a season-best seven games over .500 (40-33) before dropping two straight.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS:** Akron has held on to sole possession of first place in the Western Division since May 4 and enter play on Saturday a season-best 12 games over .500. The Ducks took three of four in Bowie in their most recent series and have won their last three overall, their longest winning streak since a five-game winning streak between 5/22(1)-5/25. Akron is 15-11 in June with the second-lowest team batting average of the month through 25 games at .234 while clubbing 27 homers, tied for the most in the circuit. Akron's roster holds seven of the Indians' top-30 prospects: RHP Triston McKenzie (No. 2), 1B Bobby Bradley (No. 4), Willi Castro (No. 6), RHP Aaron Civale (No. 9), C Logan Ice (No. 20), Ka'ai Tom (No. 23), and INF/OF Tyler Kreiger (No. 25).

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Tate Scioneaux** makes his second professional start, his second consecutive start. He started on Tuesday in the second game of a double-header against Harrisburg and worked a season-high three innings while allowing one hit and no runs with four strikeouts. He has not allowed a run in six of his last eight outings. A 39th-round draft pick out of Southeastern Louisiana University in 2015, Scioneaux tied with Montana DuRapau for the team lead in saves (14) last season and closed out the Curve's title run by striking out the side in order in Game 3 of the ELCS against Trenton on September 14. **For more on Scioneaux, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Cleveland Indians right-hander Carlos Carrasco makes a rehab start for the RubberDucks. With Cleveland this season, he is 8-5 with a 4.24 ERA in 15 starts. He was placed on the 10-day disabled list on June 17 with a right elbow contusion after being struck by a line drive hit by Joe Mauer in the second inning of a start on June 16. Carrasco has made 36 appearances (34 starts) in the Eastern League in his career with Reading and Akron, combining to go 13-11 with a 4.58 ERA dating back to 2007.

**CARDIAC CURVE:** Altoona played nine straight games decided by four runs or more between June 9 and June 20(2) before competing in six one-run games over the previous ten contests. Over their last five games, the Curve have played four one-run games have the league's best record in those games at 16-8 (.667 winning percentage).

**REYNOLDS ON A RUN:** Outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** has at least one hit in 15 of his last 17 games since June 8, batting .328 (20/61) with six doubles, one homer (a grand slam), and 13 RBIs in that stretch. He has picked up at least one RBI in seven of his last ten games since June 20. Reynolds missed seven weeks with a left wrist injury and was activated from the disabled list on May 29.

**THE SUMMER OF GEORGE:** Over his last 15 games since June 13, **Jordan George** is batting .349 (15/43) with one homer, eight RBIs and seven walks, raising his season batting average from .277 to .297. He has at least one hit in 11 of his last 15 games. Prior to that span, George went hitless over his previous seven games (0-for-5, 2 BB) and did not make a start.

**WILL POWER:** 2016 first-round draft pick **Will Craig** continues to pace the Pirates organization in RBIs, totaling 55 on the season. He is on pace to drive in 102 runs this season, which would rank second in franchise history behind Adam Hyzdu's 160 RBIs in 2000. The next closest is Jose Bautista with 90 in 2005. His 55 RBIs this season is tied for second in the Eastern League behind New Hampshire's Cavan Biggio with 61.

**COLE TRAIN:** Shortstop **Cole Tucker** has picked up two hits in each of his last three games and in five of his last seven games. In his last nine games since June 22, Tucker is hitting .351 (13/37) with a double and six runs scored. Over his last 24 games since June 3, Tucker is batting .309 (30/97) with two doubles, a homer, five RBIs and 13 runs scored.

**MOVING ON AND GETTING OVER:** After swiping 47 bases last year between Bradenton and Altoona, **Cole Tucker** did not pick up his first stolen base this season until May 22, going 0-for-5 in attempts. Since then, he has gone 18-for-22 in stolen base attempts. Tucker was rated by *Baseball America* as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Pirates organization heading into the 2018 season.

**MOVING ON UP:** The Pirates elevated two of the organization's top prospects from Double-A Altoona to Triple-A Indianapolis before Thursday's game. Pittsburgh's top overall prospect **Mitch Keller** compiled an 11-4 record and a 2.83 in 20 regular season starts for the Curve between the end of 2017 and the 2018 season while holding Eastern League hitters to a .205 batting average. Keller was the E.L. Postseason MVP during Altoona's championship run last year and won both of his postseason starts that included a 90-pitch, one-hit, nine-inning complete game on September 7. Prior to his promotion to Triple-A Indianapolis, outfielder **Jason Martin**, the Pirates' No. 21 prospect, led Pirates organization's full-season players and ranked fifth in the Eastern League with a .325 batting average on the season. His nine homers are third-most on the team and tied for fifth in the Pittsburgh organization. On the season, he has totaled eight three-hit games and a team-best 25 total multi-hit performances. Martin was acquired by the Pirates in January in a trade package from the Astros for RHP Gerrit Cole.

**SHINING STARS:** The 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game rosters were announced Friday, and the list included four players from the Curve: First baseman **Will Craig**, third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes**, starting pitcher **Taylor Hearn** and relief pitcher **Sean Keselica**. Hayes was named as an All-Star for the third straight season (2016 in the South Atlantic League with West Virginia and 2017 in the Florida State League with Bradenton), while Craig earned his second straight All-Star nod after being picked in the FSL last year. Hearn and Keselica were both named All-Stars for the first time in their careers. The 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game will be held on Wednesday, July 11 at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster features seven of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (4), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Bryan Reynolds** (6), **Taylor Hearn** (10), **Will Craig** (17), **Stephen Alemais** (19) and **Dario Agrazal** (28). The roster also features six of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects: Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." At the mid-season update, Hayes is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 95 overall prospect and the No. 7 third base prospect.

Ryan returns to Altoona after leading the Curve to the Eastern League title in 2017. He also served as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his sixth season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson returns to the Altoona staff after overseeing strong group of Curve pitchers in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates organization. He spent the previous 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher as a player, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. De Renne joins the Curve in 2018 for his sixth season overall working in the Pittsburgh minor league system and his fifth as a hitting coach. He managed the Pirates' affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2013 to a 46-26 record. He joined Michael Ryan's staff as the hitting coach for the West Virginia Power from 2014-15 and spent each of the last three seasons with the Bradenton Marauders. As a player, De Renne was drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 12th round in 2000 out of the University of Arizona and played 11 professional seasons.

Morales joins the Curve for his first season working in the Pirates organization. He spent the last five seasons as a coach with the Indios de Mayaguez of the Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente (Roberto Clemente Professional Baseball League) in Puerto Rico, working mostly with catchers, including major leaguers Martin Maldonado, Roberto Perez, Christian Vazquez, Rafael Lopez and Rene Rivera. As a player, Morales was drafted in the 23rd round in 1996 by the Florida Marlins and played 15 total professional seasons.
