YESTERDAY: The Curve were held to two hits in a 3-0 loss to the Akron RubberDucks at Canal Park. Akron starter Triston McKenzie took a no-hitter into the seventh inning before Ke'Bryan Hayes drove a lead-off triple for the Curve's first hit. Hayes added a ninth-inning single for Altoona's only other hit on the night. Akron scored three runs in the second inning against Pedro Vasquez, his only runs allowed in his six innings.

TONIGHT: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve play the first of a five-game series against the Trenton Thunder. This series marks the first meetings of 2018 between the Curve and Thunder, a rematch of the 2017 Eastern League Championship Series, a three-game sweep by Altoona. The two teams will meet at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park on August 7-9 and the Thunder return to Altoona for a four-game series from August 27-30 in the final regular-season series at PNG Field this year.

THE CURVE: During the most recent five-game road series against the division-leading RubberDucks, the Curve lost three games and won two. Over the five games, the Curve offense combined to hit .256 (42/163) with four homers (Will Craig, Logan Hill, Tyler Gaffney and Christian Kelley) and averaged 4.2 runs per game (21 total runs). The Altoona pitching staff posted a 4.15 ERA (20 ER/43.1 IP).

THE THUNDER: Trenton returns to PNG Field for the first time since September 14, 2017, when it was defeated 4-2 as Altoona completed a three-game sweep to clinch the 2017 Eastern League title. In their most recent series, the Thunder won three of four at home against the Eastern Division-leading New Hampshire Fisher Cats. The Trenton offense, which is tied for the second-lowest overall batting average in the league this season, hit .238 (39/164) over the last five games with six home runs and scored 4.4 runs per game (22 total runs). The Trenton pitching staff has posted a 3.91 ERA (20 ER/46 IP) over the last five games.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Eduardo Vera** makes his seventh Double-A start and first against the Thunder. Last time out, he threw five innings and allowed two earned runs in a no-decision at Akron on Friday. After going 1-0 with a 2.97 ERA through his first three starts at Double-A, he has gone 0-2 with a 9.88 ERA (15 ER/13.2 IP) in his last three starts since June 17. He has gone at least seven innings in seven of his last 12 starts. He made nine starts for A-Adv. Bradenton this year, going 3-2 with a 2.95 ERA. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Vera led the Florida State League with 58.0 innings pitched and ranked fifth with a 1.00 WHIP, and he earned Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star honors. Vera was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on March 5, 2012. **For more on Vera, see page two.**

FOR TRENTON: Left-hander Ryan Bollinger makes his ninth start of the season for the Thunder and first against the Curve. He last pitched on Thursday at Binghamton and allowed three runs over six innings in a no-decision. Over four June starts for the Thunder, Bollinger went 0-3 with a 12.54 ERA after going 3-0 with a 1.44 ERA in four May starts. He was originally drafted as a first baseman by the Phillies in the 47th round in 2009 and played in the GCL before being released. He switched to pitching with the independent Windy City Thunderbolts in 2010 and was signed by the White Sox for the 2011 season, pitching in their minor league system for three years before being released in March 2014. After four seasons away from affiliated baseball, Bollinger signed with the Yankees in December 2017.

HOME COOKIN': Over their last 18 home games since May 19, the Curve have gone 13-5 and have allowed more than three runs in a game just four times. The pitching staff has combined to post a 2.49 ERA (44 ER/159.0 IP) over the last 18 games at PNG Field. The Altoona offense has combined to hit .272 (154/566) over the last 18 games at home.

TWO-A-DAY HAYES: Ke'Bryan Hayes has collected two hits in six of his last seven games, combining for a .375 average (12/32) and four runs scored. That stretch has raised his batting average from .270 to .282. Over his last 21 games since May 31, Hayes is batting .341 (29/85) with eight doubles, four triples, a homer and five RBIs.

REYNOLDS ON A RUN: Outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** has at least one hit in 17 of his last 20 games since June 8, batting .306 (22/72) with six doubles, one homer (a grand slam) and 13 RBIs in that stretch. He has picked up at least one RBI in seven of his last 13 games since June 20. Reynolds missed seven weeks with a left wrist injury and was activated from the disabled list on May 29.

THE SUMMER OF GEORGE: Over his last 18 games since June 13, **Jordan George** is batting .321 (17/53) with one homer, 10 RBIs and nine walks, raising his season batting average from .277 to .291. He has at least one hit in 13 of his last 18 games. Prior to that span, George went hitless over his previous seven games (0-for-5, 2 BB) and did not make a start.

WILL POWER: 2016 first-round draft pick **Will Craig** continues to pace the Pirates organization in RBIs, totaling 58 on the season. He is on pace to drive in 102 runs this season, which would rank second in franchise history behind Adam Hyzdu's 106 RBIs in 2000. The next closest is Jose Bautista with 90 in 2005. His 58 RBIs this season rank second in the Eastern League behind New Hampshire's Cavan Biggio with 64. Craig has driven in one run in five of his last seven games (six total RBIs). He is also tied with Logan Hill for first in the Pirates organization with 12 homers. On Tuesday, it was announced that Craig will participate in the Eastern League Home Run Derby on July 10 at Trenton.

TWO-FOR-TUCKER: Shortstop **Cole Tucker** has picked up two hits in seven of his last 11 games since June 24. In that span, he is batting .333 (15/45) with two doubles, six runs scored and two RBIs. Since Tucker's season average dropped to .195 on May 19, Tucker has hit .293 (49/167) over 40 games, raising his average to .250.

MOVING ON AND GETTING OVER: After swiping 47 bases last year between Bradenton and Altoona, **Cole Tucker** did not pick up his first stolen base this season until May 22, going 0-for-5 in attempts. Since then, he has gone 18-for-22 in stolen base attempts. Tucker was rated by *Baseball America* as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Pirates organization heading into the 2018 season.

SHINING STARS: The 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game rosters were announced on Friday, and the list included four players from the Curve: First baseman **Will Craig**, third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes**, starting pitcher **Taylor Hearn** and relief pitcher **Sean Keselica**. Hayes was named as an All-Star for the third straight season (2016 in the South Atlantic League with West Virginia and 2017 in the Florida State League with Bradenton), while Craig earned his second straight All-Star nod after being picked in the FSL last year. Hearn and Keselica were both named All-Stars for the first time in their careers. The 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game will be held on Wednesday, July 11 at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster features seven of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (4), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Bryan Reynolds** (6), **Taylor Hearn** (10), **Will Craig** (17), **Stephen Alemais** (19) and **Dario Agrazal** (28). The roster also features six of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects: Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." At the mid-season update, Hayes is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 95 overall prospect and the No. 7 third base prospect.

Ryan returns to Altoona after leading the Curve to the Eastern League title in 2017. He also served as a coach for the Curve in 2012. He is in his sixth season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. He steered Bradenton to a 70-66 record in 2016, including winning the Florida State League championship. Ryan was drafted in the fifth round by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, and he went on to play 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors.

Hickerson returns to the Altoona staff after overseeing strong group of Curve pitchers in 2017 for his first year in the Pirates organization. He spent the previous 18 years working in ministry, mostly in the context of professional baseball and the military. A left-handed pitcher as a player, Hickerson was drafted by the Twins in the seventh round in 1986. He played a total of five major league seasons with the Giants, Cubs and Rockies. After his playing days, Hickerson served as a pitching coach in the Giants organization in 1997 & 1998.

De Renne joins the Curve in 2018 for his sixth season overall working in the Pittsburgh minor league system and his fifth as a hitting coach. He managed the Pirates' affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2013 to a 46-26 record. He joined Michael Ryan's staff as the hitting coach for the West Virginia Power from 2014-15 and spent each of the last three seasons with the Bradenton Marauders. As a player, De Renne was drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 12th round in 2000 out of the University of Arizona and played 11 professional seasons.

Morales joins the Curve for his first season working in the Pirates organization. He spent the last five seasons as a coach with the Indios de Mayagüez of the Liga de Béisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente (Roberto Clemente Professional Baseball League) in Puerto Rico, working mostly with catchers, including major leaguers Martin Maldonado, Roberto Perez, Christian Vazquez, Rafael Lopez and Rene Rivera. As a player, Morales was drafted in the 23rd round in 1996 by the Florida Marlins and played 15 total professional seasons.

In his seventh season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens returns to Altoona for a second season in 2018. He spent two years in Bradenton from 2015-16, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last five seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.

Schlesinger returns to the Curve for his second season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system. Prior to joining the Pirates, he served as the strength and conditioning graduate assistant at Duquesne University from 2012-2014. Schlesinger graduated from Toledo with a degree in exercise science in 2011 and completed his master's degree of science in sports leadership at Duquesne in 2014.
