YESTERDAY: The Curve won a back-and-forth game against the Thunder, 6-4. Trenton scored first in the first, but the Curve tied the score with a sac fly by Will Craig in the bottom of the inning. In the second, Stephen Alemais gave the Curve a 2-1 lead with an RBI single. After the Thunder evened the score, Craig brought Cole Tucker in to score for his 60th RBI of the season in the fifth and Jordan George brought in Ke'Bryan Hayes with a single to open a 4-2 lead. Trenton evened the score again at 4-4, but Tucker responded with a go-ahead double in the sixth and added an insurance run with a triple in the eighth. Yeydy Garcia struck out four over two perfect innings to pick up the save. Cam Vleaux allowed four runs in seven innings to pick up his fifth win in six starts.

TODAY: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve play the finale of a five-game series against the Trenton Thunder. This series marks the first meetings of 2018 between the Curve and Thunder, a rematch of the 2017 Eastern League Championship Series, which Altoona won in a three-game sweep. The two teams will meet at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park on August 7-9 and the Thunder return to Altoona for a four-game series from August 27-30 in the final regular-season series at PNG Field this year.

THE CURVE: Friday night's win snapped a three-game losing streak for the Curve, and they added a second straight victory on Saturday. Over the last five games, the Curve offense has combined for 14 runs (2.8 runs per game) while hitting .234 (37/158). The Curve are hitting .152 (7/46) with runners in scoring position over the last five games.

THE THUNDER: With this series, Trenton returns to PNG Field for the first time since September 14, 2017, when it was defeated 4-2 as Altoona completed a three-game sweep to clinch the 2017 Eastern League title. In their most recent series, the Thunder won three of five at home against the Eastern Division-leading New Hampshire Fisher Cats. For the series, the Thunder are hitting .271 (38/140) while averaging 5.3 runs per game. The Trenton pitchers have combined for a 3.71 ERA (14 ER/34.0 IP) with 39 strikeouts in the series.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Pedro Vasquez** makes his 11th start and 12th overall appearance for the Curve. He last pitched on Monday at Akron and picked up a loss after allowing three earned runs over six innings. Over his last four starts since June 16, Vasquez is 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10 ER/23 IP). Vasquez joined the Curve from extended spring training on May 4 and debuted that night against Erie, allowing one run before rain shortened his outing to three innings. He made 24 starts and two relief appearances for A-Adv. Bradenton last year, going 9-7 with a 3.73 ERA. In the first half of the season, he went 6-3 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 starts and two relief outings, but had a 5.10 ERA over his final 13 starts, including a 6.84 ERA in five August outings. He was selected as a Florida State League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star in 2017. Vasquez was acquired by the Pirates along with LHP Jake Brentz on September 1, 2016 as players to be named later in the August 6 trade that sent Arquimedes Caminero to the Seattle Mariners. **For more on Vasquez, see page two.**

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Domingo Acevedo makes his seventh start and tenth overall appearance for the Thunder this season. After a three-game stretch working out of the bullpen, Acevedo has gone 1-0 with a 2.55 ERA (5 ER/17.2 IP) in his last four starts. He last pitched on Monday against New Hampshire, allowed two earned runs over five innings in a no-decision. Acevedo is 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA in two career starts against the Curve. He is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Yankees' No. 7 prospect.

HOME COOKIN': Over their last 22 home games since May 19, the Curve have gone 15-7 and have allowed more than three runs in a game just six times. The pitching staff has combined to post a 2.95 ERA (64 ER/195.0 IP) over the last 22 games at PNG Field. The Altoona offense has combined to hit .272 (189/696) over the last 22 games at home. The Curve snapped a three-game home losing streak with a win on Friday.

TWO-A-DAY HAYES: Third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has collected multiple hits in nine of his last 11 games, combining for a .417 average (20/48) and eight runs scored. That stretch has raised his batting average from .270 to .295, the highest he has held this season. Over his last 25 games since May 31, Hayes is batting .363 (37/101) with nine doubles, four triples, a homer and five RBIs.

REYNOLDS ON A RUN: Outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** has at least one hit in 20 of his last 24 games since June 8, batting .318 (28/88) with seven doubles, one homer (a grand slam) and 15 RBIs in that stretch. He has picked up at least one RBI in nine of his last 17 games since June 20. Reynolds missed seven weeks with a left wrist injury and was activated from the disabled list on May 29.

THE SUMMER OF GEORGE: Over his last 20 games since June 13, **Jordan George** is batting .312 (19/61) with one homer, 11 RBIs and nine walks, raising his season batting average from .277 to .289. He has at least one hit in 15 of his last 20 games. Prior to that span, George went hitless over his previous seven games (0-for-5, 2 BB) and did not make a start.

WILL POWER: 2016 first-round draft pick **Will Craig** continues to pace the Pirates organization in RBIs, totaling 60 on the season. He is on pace to drive in 101 runs this season, which would rank second in franchise history behind Adam Hyzdu's 106 RBIs in 2000. The next closest is Jose Bautista with 90 in 2005. His 60 RBIs this season rank second in the Eastern League behind New Hampshire's Cavan Biggio with 67. He is also tied with Logan Hill for first in the Pirates organization with 12 homers. On Tuesday, it was announced that Craig will participate in the Eastern League Home Run Derby on July 10 at Trenton.

MOVING ON AND GETTING OVER: After swiping 47 bases last year between Bradenton and Altoona, **Cole Tucker** did not pick up his first stolen base this season until May 22, going 0-for-5 in attempts. Since then, he has gone 20-for-24 in stolen base attempts. Tucker was rated by *Baseball America* as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Pirates organization heading into the 2018 season.

SHINING STARS: The 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game rosters were announced on Friday, and the list included four players from the Curve: First baseman **Will Craig**, third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes**, starting pitcher **Taylor Hearn** and relief pitcher **Sean Keselica**. Hayes was named as an All-Star for the third straight season (2016 in the South Atlantic League with West Virginia and 2017 in the Florida State League with Bradenton), while Craig earned his second straight All-Star nod after being picked in the FSL last year. Hearn and Keselica were both named All-Stars for the first time in their careers. The 2018 Eastern League All-Star Game will be held on Wednesday at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster features seven of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (3), **Cole Tucker** (4), **Bryan Reynolds** (5), **Taylor Hearn** (10), **Will Craig** (16), **Stephen Alemais** (18) and **Dario Agrazal** (27). The roster also features six of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects: Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Hearn (9), Craig (24), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." At the mid-season update, Hayes is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 95 overall prospect and the No. 7 third base prospect.
