YESTERDAY: The Curve collected 14 hits and rolled to an 8-2 win over the Fightin Phils to open the road trip. Christian Kelley drove an RBI single in the second and Bryan Reynolds added an RBI single in the third to take a 2-0. Austin Listi and Cornelius Randolph each hit solo homers for Reading in the fourth to tie the score at 2-2. Ke'Bryan Hayes doubled to put the Curve ahead, 3-2, in the fifth. Will Craig drove a two-run single and Logan Hill added an RBI double to cap a four-run inning and open the Curve lead to 6-2. In the seventh, Stephen Alemais hit a two-run single, his fourth hit of the game, to open the lead to 8-2. Altoona starter Cam Vieaux worked 5.2 innings and allowed two runs to pick up his sixth win. Logan Sendelbach pitched 2.1 scoreless innings and Geoff Harlieb pitched a scoreless ninth inning to close out the game.

TODAY: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve play the second and third of a five-game, four-day series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. The two teams faced off at FirstEnergy Stadium on May 10-13 and again at PNC Field from June 5-7 with the Curve winning two of three in each series. Altoona's last visit to Reading was scheduled to be a four-game series but the third game on May 12 was rained out and will be made up tonight. The current series will be the last regular season meetings between the Curve and Fightins.

THE CURVE: After winning three straight entering the all-star break, the Curve hold a 4-4 record since returning to action in the second half. The Curve lost the first two games of their previous series at home against Bowie despite holding a lead entering the ninth inning, just the third and fourth losses this season when leading after eight. Three of Altoona's four losses since the break have been with a lead entering the final inning including two losses to Bowie and the first game of a double-header on July 13 at Erie. After losing three straight from Sunday through Tuesday, the Curve have won their last two games. In the two wins, the Curve are hitting .353 (24/68) and averaging 6.5 runs per game (13 total runs).

THE FIGHTINS: After winning six of eight entering the all-star break, the Fightin Phils are 3-5 since play resumed including splitting four games with Bowie and losing two-of-three in Hartford in the most recent series. After winning the series opener in Hartford and Tuesday's game was rained out, the Fightins lost twice on Wednesday after both games of a double-header ended on walk-off hits by Brendan Rodgers of the Yard Goats. In the month of July, Reading is 9-7 and they lead the circuit with 22 homers this month they rank third in hitting at .274. Reading's roster contains five of the Phillies' top 30 prospects, according to MLB.com: Adam Haseley (No. 3), Jalo Romero (No. 7), Franklyn Kilome (No. 7), Cornelius Randolph (No. 14) and Connor Seabold (No. 27). Additionally, Haseley is regarded as baseball's No. 78 overall prospect on the MLB.com list.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Austin Coley** makes his third start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he pitched three scoreless innings at Erie on Saturday. After allowing back-to-back singles to open the first inning, Coley sat down the final nine batters he faced in order. In his 2018 Altoona debut on May 28 at Harrisburg, Coley picked up a win after allowing three runs over six innings. He was scratched from a start on June 2 at Hartford with right shoulder discomfort and placed on the disabled list the next day. He has gone 3-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24.0 IP) over his last five Double-A games (four starts) since August 25, 2017. Coley made seven starts and two relief outings for the Triple-A Indianapolis Indians, going 1-3 with a 9.84 ERA before being assigned to Altoona on May 25. He spent all of last season with the Curve, going 6-4 with a 3.01 ERA over 23 starts and six relief outings en route to being named the Altoona Co-Pitcher of the Year. Coley was drafted by the Pirates in the eighth round in 2014 out of Belmont University. **For more on Coley, see page two.**

Right-hander **Scooter Hightower** starts for the Curve in game two. Last time out, he made his first Double-A start last Friday in the second game of a double-header at Erie and tossed four scoreless innings. Hightower made 18 relief appearances for A-Adv. Bradenton, going 5-0 with a 1.47 ERA and striking out 35 in 30.2 innings. Hightower was a starter for the short-season West Virginia Black Bears last season and went 4-1 with a 1.94 ERA. He was drafted in the 15th round in 2015 by the Pirates out of Columbia State. **For more on Hightower, see page three.**

FOR READING: Right-hander **Connor Seabold** makes his fifth start of the season for the Fightin Phils. He has allowed three runs in each of his last three starts, going five innings twice and six innings once. In his Double-A debut on June 27 against Erie, he was knocked around for five runs on eight hits over three innings. Seabold began the season with A-Adv. Clearwater and went 4-4 with a 3.77 ERA in his 12 starts. He was drafted by the Phillies last year in the third round out of Cal State Fullerton and threw five relief appearances with short-season Williamsport, going 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA. He went 23-15 in 56 career college outings with the titans at Fullerton and was a two-time All-Big West selection and an All-American in 2017.

Right-hander **Ranfi Casimiro** takes the mound for game two for the Fightin Phils in his first start at Double-A this season. He has made 11 relief appearances for Reading this season, most recently on July 1 at Hartford. Casimiro has bounced between A-Adv. Clearwater and Triple-A Lehigh Valley this season. He pitched 20 games for Reading, including four starts, in 2017 and went 1-5 with a 3.57 ERA.

TWO-A-DAY HAYES: Third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has collected multiple hits in 11 of his last 16 games, combining for a .375 average (24/64) and 13 runs scored. That stretch has raised his batting average from .270 to .293. Over his last 30 games since May 31, Hayes is batting .350 (41/117) with 12 doubles, four triples, a homer and seven RBIs. Hayes played in the All-Star Futures Game on Sunday at Nationals Park and was the starting third baseman for Team USA, going 1-for-2 with a home run and a walk.

ALEMAIS-ING: Over his last 12 games since July 7, Stephen Alemais is batting .425 (17/40) with five RBIs and has drawn eight walks. In 52 games since May 19, Alemais is batting .329 (54/164) with nine doubles, one triple, one homer, 23 walks and 21 RBIs with 11 stolen bases. He opened the season with a .310 batting average over his first 15 games through April 23, but batted just .102 (6/59) over his next 18 games from April 25-May 18. On Thursday, Alemais tied a career high with four hits at Reading.

WILL POWER: 2016 first-round draft pick **Will Craig** continues to pace the Pirates organization in RBIs, totaling 72 on the season. He is on pace to drive in 108 runs this season, which would break the franchise record set by Adam Hyzdu with 106 RBIs in 2000. The next closest is Jose Bautista with 90 in 2005. His 72 RBIs this season rank tied for first in the Eastern League with New Hampshire's Cavan Biggio and his 12 since the all-star break lead all hitters on the circuit. He also leads the Pirates organization with 14 home runs, a career high. He has at least one RBI in his last four games (seven total RBIs).

THE SUMMER OF GEORGE: Utility man **Jordan George** is currently riding a season-best, 14-game on-base streak in which he has hit safely in his last six games. George is the third Curve hitter to reach base in at least 14 consecutive games, joining **Jason Martin's** streak of 17 games and a 14-game stretch by **Stephen Alemais**. Before he was promoted to Double-A Altoona in 2017, the Arkansas native recorded a 23-game on-base streak with A-Adv. Bradenton from July 1-27. In college at Arkansas State, George finished his collegiate career with a 74-game on-base streak that began in 2014 and stretched through all 55 games as a senior in 2015.

MOVING ON AND GETTING OVER: After swiping 47 bases last year between Bradenton and Altoona, **Cole Tucker** did not pick up his first stolen base this season until May 22, going 0-for-5 in attempts. Since then, he has gone 23-for-27 in stolen base attempts. He is currently second in the league in steals. Tucker was rated by *Baseball America* as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Pirates organization heading into the 2018 season. Over his last 11 games at the plate, Tucker is batting .342 (14/41) with a homer, five RBIs, three doubles, two triples and six walks. Since the All-Star break, Tucker is hitting .364 (12/33) in nine games and leads the league with nine runs scored.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster features eight of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Ke'Bryan Hayes** (3), **Cole Tucker** (4), **Bryan Reynolds** (5), **Taylor Hearn** (9), **Luis Escobar** (10), **Will Craig** (15), **Stephen Alemais** (17) and **Dario Agrazal** (26). The roster also features seven of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects: Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Escobar (7), Hearn (9), Craig (24), **Yeudy Garcia** (26), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," **Christian Kelley** as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." Hayes is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 91 overall prospect and the No. 7 third base prospect.
