SUNDAY: The Curve fell to the Reading Fightin Phils, 6-5, in the first game of a scheduled double-header and the second contest was canceled due to rain. Aided by six shutout innings from starting pitcher Taylor Hearn, Altoona built a 4-0 lead entering the bottom of the seventh and turned to Tate Scioneaux for the final three outs. With two outs, Reading connected on three straight hits to break up the shutout and move within one run. With two on, two out and two strikes on Darick Hall, the tarp was pulled and the game sat in a rain delay for 2:40. The Fightins tied the game on the first pitch out of the delay against Matt Eckelman and sent the game to extra innings. Will Craig tripled in a run in the top of the eighth and Reading scored the winning runs on an error by Alfredo Reyes with the bases loaded.

TODAY: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve play the first of three against the first-place Akron RubberDucks, the Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. The current series is the final visit to Akron for the Curve. The two squads will square off for a three-game series at PNG Field during the first weekend in August to conclude the season series.

THE CURVE: Since Wednesday, the Curve have won three of their last five games, taking the series finale against the Baysox at home and winning two of four in Reading. Over that stretch, the Curve offense has combined to hit .207 (43/145) with five homers, including three by Will Craig, while batting .415 (17/41) with runners in scoring position and averaging 6.4 runs per game (32 runs). The pitching staff has combined for a 5.63 ERA (24 ER/38.1 IP). Since the all-star break, the Curve have lost four games in their opponents last at bat. Overall, 16 blown saves by the Altoona bullpen trails only Akron's 17 among Eastern League squads.

THE RUBBERDUCKS: Akron enters the series riding a five-game winning streak, their longest since a seven-game streak from 5/2-5/8 in which they took sole possession of first place in the Western Division and have held the top spot since the first win of that streak. Most recently, the RubberDucks swept a four-game series against Richmond in Akron. Since the all-star break, the 'Ducks have won 9 out of 11 games included a tour-game sweep over Binghamton at Canal Park and lost two-of-three to Harrisburg on City Island. Akron's 60 wins are the most in the Eastern League while they stand a season-best 20 games over the .500 mark. There are eight of the Indians' top 30 prospects on the Akron roster, according to MLB.com: RHP Tristan McKenzie (No. 1), 1B Bobby Bradley (No. 4), SS Willi Castro (No. 5), RHP Aaron Civale (No. 8), Logan Ice (No. 20), Ka'ai Tom (No. 23), Tyler Krieger (No. 25) and Andrew Calica (No. 30).

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Eduardo Vera makes his tenth start of the season for the Curve and third against the RubberDucks. Last time out, he worked seven innings for the fourth time this season at Double-A on July 17 vs. Bowie. Vera made his Double-A debut against Akron on May 30 in Altoona and worked seven innings and allowed one earned run before firing five innings with two runs surrendered on June 29 in Akron. He has allowed two earned runs in each of his last four starts, although his outing on July 4 was cut short after he was struck by a line drive from the third batter he faced. Vera went 3-2 with a 2.95 ERA in nine starts with Bradenton this year, earning a Florida State League All-Star nod, and was promoted to Double-A on May 30. In his first three starts with the Curve, he went 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA. Over his last five starts since June 16, Vera has gone 1-3 with an 8.55 ERA (19 ER/20 IP). Vera signed with the Pirates as an international free agent in March 2012. For more on Vera, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Aaron Civale makes his 15th start for the RubberDucks and his fourth against the Curve. In his most recent start, Civale allowed five runs at Harrisburg on Wednesday over 4.1 innings. Since he posted a one-hit, scoreless start that spanned seven innings on July 4 at Richmond, Civale has not pitched beyond the fifth innings in his two latest starts with an ERA of 7.00 (7 ER/9 IP). Civale was drafted by the Indians in the third round during the 2016 draft out of Northeastern and is currently ranked as their No. 8 prospect by MLB.com.

TWO-A-DAY HAYES: Third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has collected multiple hits in 11 of his last 18 games, combining for a .380 average (27/71) and 14 runs scored. That stretch has raised his batting average from .270 to .296, the highest point of the season. Over his last 32 games since May 31, Hayes is batting .355 (44/124) with 13 doubles, four triples, a homer and nine RBIs. Hayes played in the All-Star Futures Game last Sunday at Nationals Park and was the starting third baseman for Team USA, going 1-for-2 with a home run and a walk. Hayes is currently riding a 13-game on-base streak, the fourthlongest by a Curve hitter this season. Jason Martin reached base in 17 straight games for the Curve while Stephen Alemais and Jordan George each recorded 14-game streaks.

ALEMAIS-ING: Over his last 13 games since July 7, Stephen Alemais is batting .436 (17/39) with six RBIs and has drown ten walks. In 54 games since May 19, Alemais is batting .329 (55/167) with nine doubles, one triple, one homer, 25 walks and 22 RBIs with 11 stolen bases. He opened the season with a .310 batting average over his first 15 games through April 23, but batted just .102 (6/59) over his next 18 games from April 25-May 18. On Thursday, Alemais tied a career high with four his ret Populing.

WILL POWER: 2016 first-round draft pick **Will Craig** continues to pace the Pirates organization in RBIs, totaling 77 on the season. He is on pace to drive in 111 runs this season, which would break the franchise record set by Adam Hyzdu with 106 RBIs in 2000. The next closest is Jose Bautista with 90 in 2005. His 77 RBIs this season rank first in the Eastern League and his 17 since the all-star break lead all hitters on the circuit. He also leads the Pirates organization with 16 home runs, a career high. He has at least one RBI in his last six games (12 total RBIs). He picked up his first multi-homer game in his career on Saturday at Reading

MOVING ON AND GETTING OVER: After swiping 47 bases last year between Bradenton and Altoona, **Cole Tucker** did not pick up his first stolen base this season until May 22, going 0-for-5 in attempts. Since then, he has gone 26-for-30 in stolen base attempts. He is currently second in the league in steals. Tucker was rated by Baseball America as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Pirates organization heading into the 2018 season. Over his 12 games since the all-star break, Tucker is batting .341 (15/44) with 14 runs scored, two doubles, one triple, one homer, six RBIs, seven walks and six steals. RBIs, seven walks and six steals.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve roster features eight of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: Ke'Bryan Hayes (3), Cole Tucker (4), Bryan Reynolds (5), Taylor Hearn (9), Luis Escobar (10), Will Craig (15), Stephen Alemais (17) and Dario Agrazal (26). The roster also features seven of Baseball America's Top 30 Pirates prospects: Hayes (4), Tucker (6), Escobar (7), Hearn (9), Craig (24), Yeudy Garcia (26), Alemais (28) and Agrazal (30). Reynolds was ranked by B.A. as the Giants' No. 5 prospect prior to being traded to Pittsburgh. B.A. also rated Tucker as "Fastest Baserunner," Christian Kelley as the "Best Defensive Catcher," and Hayes as "Best Defensive Infielder." Hayes is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 91 overall prospect and the No. 7 third base prospect.
