YESTERDAY: The Curve were held to two hits and shut out by the Thunder, 5-0. Dario Agrazal allowed five runs, second-highest in his Double-A career, over seven innings. Tate Scioneaux and Matt Eckelman each threw a scoreless innings. Rashad Crawford drove in the Thunder's first run in the second. The Thunder brought in four runs in six hits, including five straight to open the inning, in the sixth inning to open a 5-0 lead.

TODAY: The 20th Season of Altoona Curve Baseball, presented by Stuckey Subaru, continues as the Curve face the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees in the finale of a four-game series at PNG Field. It is also the tenth of a ten-game, nine-day homestand, the final homestand of the year for the Curve. This series is the first of two series against American League-affiliated teams to close out the season after three straight sets against National League affiliates.

THE CURVE: The Curve have been outscored 18-2 in three straight losses to the Thunder after winning 16 of the previous 22 games and eight of the previous nine games. The Curve are hitting .163 (15/92) in the series after batting .267 (189/708) over the previous 22 games. After the Altoona pitching staff posted a 2.35 ERA (50 ER/191.2 IP) over 22 games from August 5-26, it has a 6.00 ERA (18 ER/27.0 IP) in the last three games against Trenton. The Curve have lost back-to-back games for the first time since July 20-22 in Reading and three straight for the first time since July 15-17. Over the last 16 series played, the Curve have won 11, lost three and split two. They have also won seven of the last nine series. Since falling a game under .500 and back to fourth in the division on June 5, the Curve have gone 48-32. Altoona clinched a winning season on August 22, its fourth straight year with a winning record (longest active streak in the league) for the first time since it posted six straight winning seasons from 2002-2007. The Curve are 18-11 in August, best in the league. Entering play tonight, the Curve have won eight of the last 12 games.

THE THUNDER: Trenton has won six straight games, tied for its longest winning streak of the year. Over those six games, the Thunder have outscored the Yard Goats and the Curve, 37-13. The Thunder are hitting .279 (61/219) over their winning streak and have posted a 1.33 team ERA (8 ER/54.0 IP). Trenton clinched its third straight postseason appearance with its 8-3 win at Hartford on Sunday, which is the second-longest active playoff streak in the league behind Altoona. Trenton's roster features four of MLB.com's Top 30 Yankees prospects: Jonathan Loaisiga (3), Domingo Acevedo (5), Trevor Stephan (8) and Nick Nelson (18).

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Scooter Hightower** seventh Double-A start and his second against the Thunder. Entering tonight's start, Hightower has not allowed an earned run over his last 19.0 innings pitched. In his most recent start, Hightower threw six scoreless innings and picked up his first Double-A win against Richmond in the second game of Saturday's double-header. He last started against the Thunder on August 7 and was ejected with two outs in the second inning. He made his Double-A debut on July 5 in relief against Trenton and allowed three runs with six strikeouts over 3.2 innings. Hightower made 18 relief appearances for A-Adv. Bradenton, going 5-0 with a 1.47 ERA and striking out 35 in 30.2 innings. He was a starter for the short-season West Virginia Black Bears last season and went 4-1 with a 1.94 ERA. Hightower was drafted in the 15th round in 2015 by the Pirates out of Columbia State. **For more on Hightower, see page three.**

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Brian Keller makes his 21st start of the season for the Thunder and his first against the Curve. Over his last three starts, Keller is 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20 IP). He is ranked sixth in the league with a 3.54 ERA and fourth with a 1.20 WHIP. Keller was drafted in the 39th round by the Yankees out of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

HOME COOKIN': Over their last 46 home games since May 19, the Curve have gone 29-17. The pitching staff has combined to post a 3.27 ERA (147 ER/404.0 IP) over the last 46 games at PNG Field. The Altoona offense has combined to hit .264 (380/1442) over the last 46 games at home. Over the last 13 home sets, Altoona has won nine, lost two and split two.

BEATING THE EAST: The Curve have gone 29-19 against the Eastern Division this season and 45-40 against the West. For the season, the Curve have hit .269 (434/1611) and scored 5.2 runs per game (248 runs/48 games) against Eastern Division teams, compared to .245 (648/2649) and 3.7 runs per game (331 total runs/89 games) against the West. Altoona has a 4.19 ERA (192 ER/412.0 IP) against the Eastern Division and a 3.51 ERA (287 ER/735.1 IP) against the West.

WILL POWER: 2016 first-round draft pick **Will Craig** continues to pace the Pirates organization and is tied for the Eastern League lead in RBIs, totaling 98 on the season. He is eight shy of the franchise record set by Adam Hyzdu with 106 RBIs in 2000. The RBI total is the second-most in franchise history for a single season, surpassing Jose Bautista (90 - 2005). He also leads the Pirates organization with 20 home runs, a career high. He has the most RBIs in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since Andrew Lambo drove in 99 in 2013. His RBI total is the fourth-highest in the E.L. since 2014 behind Dylan Cozens (125 - 2016), Rhys Hoskins (116 - 2016) and Steven Moya (105 - 2014). He has the tenth 20-homer season in Altoona franchise history. Over his last nine games since August 22, Craig is batting .138 (4/29) with one RBI.

MOVING ON AND GETTING OVER: After swiping 47 bases last year between Bradenton and Altoona, **Cole Tucker** did not pick up his first stolen base this season until May 22, going 0-for-5 in attempts. Since then, he has gone 33-for-40 in stolen base attempts. He is first in the league in steals with 33 and is second in the Pirates system behind Alfredo Reyes. Tucker was rated by *Baseball America* as the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Pirates organization heading into the 2018 season.

REYNOLDS KEEPS ROLLIN': Over 40 games since July 19, **Bryan Reynolds** has 18 multi-hit games while batting .350 (55/157) with six homers, six doubles, one triple and 24 RBIs. Reynolds missed seven weeks from April 10 to May 29 with a hamate fracture. He was acquired by the Pirates in January along with RHP Kyle Crick for OF Andrew McCutchen. Reynolds just qualified for the league leaderboard on Wednesday is ranked fifth in the league with a .303 average and fifth with a .382 on-base percentage.

ALEMAIS-ING: In 82 games since May 19, **Alemais** is batting .303 (80/262), tied for seventh in the league, with 13 doubles, three triples, one homer, 33 walks, 27 RBIs and 12 stolen bases. He opened the season with a .310 batting average over his first 15 games through April 23, but batted just .102 (6/59) over his next 18 games from April 25-May 18.

YOUNG HAYES: Third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes** has a .977 fielding percentage at third base this season, which would rank as the highest by a third baseman in the Eastern League since at least 1959. Hayes has career-high totals in home runs (7), doubles (30), extra-base hits (43) and walks (47) while sitting one triple short of matching his career-best of seven from 2017 with A-Adv. Bradenton. Hayes saw his 16-game hitting streak snapped on August 16, his longest of the season and the longest active streak in the league at the time. The streak is tied for the eighth-longest in franchise history with Starling Marte and Gorkys Hernandez. Since the streak was snapped, Hayes is batting .114 (4-for-35) over his last ten games.

THE STARTING LINE: Over the last 25 games since August 5, Altoona starting pitchers have combined to go 14-7 with a 2.74 ERA (44 ER/144.1 IP). In that span, **Dario Agrazal** is 2-3 with a 3.48 ERA (12 ER/31.0 IP) in five starts, **James Marvel** is 3-1 with a 2.33 (7 ER/27.0 IP) in four starts, **Eduardo Vera** is 3-0 with a 2.03 ERA (6 ER/26.2 IP) in four starts and **Cam Vieaux** is 3-2 with a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.1 IP) in five starts. Over the last 12 games since August 19, Curve starters are 8-4 with a 2.85 ERA (23 ER/72.2 IP).

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over his last 14 outings since July 20, reliever **Matt Eckelman** has worked 14.0 innings without allowing an earned run, lowering his ERA from 4.15 to 1.74. He has converted seven straight save chances since August 3. In 14 appearances since July 19, **Geoff Hartlieb** has posted a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP). **Logan Sendelbach** has a 1.30 ERA (5 ER/34.2 IP) over his last 17 relief outings since June 14.

D-D-DEFENSE: The Curve currently lead the Eastern League with a .985 fielding percentage, which would set the record for the best in franchise history (.980 - 2016 & '17). The team has committed 73 errors, which would be the fewest in team history (105 - 2016, '17). The .977 fielding percentage by **Ke'Bryan Hayes** would be the best in team history by a third baseman (.962 - Jason Bowers, 2008) and the best in the Eastern League by a third baseman since at least 1959. **Will Craig** has the best fielding percentage of all first basemen in the league (.994) and **Cole Tucker** has the top fielding percentage at shortstop (.972). Craig, Stephen Alemais and Hayes were named as the league's top defensive players at their positions by *Baseball America* earlier this month.
