## UPCOMING GAMES & PITCHING PROBABLES

ELDS Game 5 | Sun., Sept. 9 | Akron | 2 p.m. | TBD vs. TBD

**TONIGHT:** The Western Division champion Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, face the Western Division Wild Card Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians, in Game 4 of the Western Division Championship Series. Akron leads the series, 2-1.

**YESTERDAY:** The Curve fell behind 5-0 in the first inning, but charged back for an 8-5 win to extend their season. James Marvel recovered to hold Akron off the board through his next four innings, and Arden Pabst singled in Altoona's first run in the fifth. Later in the inning, Cole Tucker hit a grand slam to tie the score, the second grand slam in Curve playoff history. In the eighth, Logan Hill brought in the go-ahead run and Jordan George added a two-run single. It marked the second-biggest comeback win in Curve postseason history, behind Game 1 of the 2015 ELDS when they overcame a 7-0 second-inning hole.

**THE CURVE:** Are the defending Eastern League champions...Won the E.L. West for the second straight season...Finished the regular season 18 games over .500 and with a .565 winning percentage, third-best in team history behind 2004 (85-56) and 2010 (82-60)...Posted best winning percentage in the league...Won their fourth regular-season division title in team history (2004 Southern, 2010 Western, 2017 Western)...Have advanced to the Eastern League Championship Series in all three previous division championship seasons...Are making their ninth postseason appearance in 20-year team history, third-most in the league since 1999 behind Akron and Trenton (11)...Are in the playoffs for the fourth straight season, tied for the longest streak in franchise history (2003-06) and longest active streak in the Eastern League...Are one of four teams to win multiple league titles since 1999 (Akron (5), Trenton (3), Altoona (2), New Hampshire (2))...Tied for the league lead with 38 triples...Had the fourth-best team batting average (.255) in the league and tied for the third-best OBP (.332)...Posted the fourth-best team ERA (3.85) in the league, tied for second-most shutouts (11), tied for second-most saves (39), tied for second-best WHIP (1.28)...Posted the best fielding percentage in the league (.985)...Trailing Akron by seven games in the Western Division standings entering August and moved into sole possession of first place for good on August 30...Have six of MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Ke Bryan Hayes** (2), **Cole Tucker** (5), **Bryan Reynolds** (8), **Will Craig** (16), **Stephen Alemajis** (18) and **Dario Agrazal** (26)...Were named by MLB.com as the No. 7 team on a list of "the Minors 10 most talented teams"...Have an 0-3 all-time postseason series record when falling behind 0-2...Are 13-8 at home all-time in the playoffs and 11-5 in Division Series games...Are 1-11 in postseason games in Akron and 9-3 in road playoff games at all other parks

**THE RUBBERDUCKS:** Are in the postseason for the third time in the last five seasons...Won the Eastern League title in 2016...Have won five E.L. titles since moving to Akron in 1997 (2003, '05, '09, '12, '16), the most in the league that span...Ranked second in the league in runs scored (665), second in doubles (245), second in RBIs (618), third in total bases (1,798), second in walks (506), third in steals (132), tied for third in OBP (.332) and third in OPS (.721)...Ranked second in the E.L. in ERA (3.59), first in shutouts (13) and tied for second in WHIP (1.28)...Was 56-48 with a seven-game lead in the E.L. West through July 31 but lost eight of nine to open August and went 3-12 from August 1-17...Went 10-7 over next 17 games to close season...Hit .256 with a 4.65 team ERA from August 1 through the end of the regular season...Have four of MLB.com's Top 30 Indians prospects: **Nick Sandlin** (18), **James Karinchak** (25), **Ernie Clement** (26) and **Tyler Krieger** (29), as well as rehabbing major leaguers **Josh Donaldson** and **Cody Anderson**.

**FULL STEAM AHEAD:** Beginning on August 1, the Curve went 22-12 to close out the season, best in the league, and hit .262 as a team in that stretch. The Curve led the league with a 2.87 ERA in August. After the final 13 series of the season, the Curve won 10, lost two and split one. Over the final 17 games, the Curve went 12-5. After falling a game under .500 and back to fourth in the division on June 5, the Curve went 52-33 through the rest of the season.

**HEAD-TO-HEAD HISTORY:** Altoona has faced Akron in the Division Series four previous times and dropped each series. In all four of the previous meetings, Akron was the regular-season division champion and held home-field advantage. In 2003 in the Curve's first-ever postseason series, the Aeros took the series in four games. Over back-to-back seasons in 2005 and 2006, the Aeros won in five games, with both teams winning all of their games at home. In 2016, Altoona split two games at home before dropping back-to-back games in Akron, with the RubberDucks winning the decisive Game 4, 1-0, on a tenth-inning, walk-off single by Eric Haase. In 2000, the Curve missed the postseason after losing their final three regular-season games at home. The Curve have lost nine straight playoff games in Akron, with the last win coming on September 4, 2003.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Dario Agrazal** makes the fourth postseason start of his professional career. Agrazal made 14 starts and one relief appearance for the Curve this season and faced Akron twice, combining to pitch 13.0 scoreless innings against the Ducks. On April 6, he worked six hitless innings at home in his season debut against Akron. On April 19 at Canal Park, Agrazal threw seven innings and allowed four hits. Agrazal was placed on the disabled list on May 29 with a right shoulder strain and returned to the Altoona roster on August 5. Over his first four starts back, he went 2-2 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER/24.0 IP), but he combined to go 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (15 ER/10.0 IP) over his last two starts, including allowing ten runs and five homers in his final regular season start at Bowie on Monday. He made one postseason start in the DSL playoffs in 2013, picking up a loss after allowing four runs in four innings. He pitched two games for the West Virginia Power in the South Atlantic League playoffs in 2015 and went 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP). Agrazal is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect. **For more on Agrazal, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Left-hander Sean Brady makes the third postseason start of his professional career. This year, Brady made all but one of his 28 starts with Akron. He made five starts against Altoona this season, going 0-3 with a 6.58 ERA (19 ER/26.0 IP). Brady finished the regular season going 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP) over his last three starts. He made one start in the Arizona League playoffs in 2013 and one in the Carolina League playoffs in 2016, combining for 10.1 scoreless innings. Brady was drafted by the Indians in the fifth round in 2013 out of Baker (Fla.) High School.

**HOME COOKIN':** Over their last 47 regular-season home games since May 19, the Curve went 30-17. The pitching staff combined to post a 3.23 ERA (148 ER/413.0 IP) over the last 47 games at PNG Field. The Altoona offense combined to hit .265 (390/1473) over the last 47 games at home. Over the last 13 home sets, Altoona won nine, lost two and split two. For the season, the Curve went 40-29 at home, second-best in the league behind Trenton (42-29).

**THE STARTING LINE:** Over the last 30 regular-season games from August 5-September 3, Altoona starting pitchers combined to go 15-8 with a 3.17 ERA (59 ER/167.1 IP). In that stretch, **Cam Vieaux** went 3-2 with a 2.86 ERA (9 ER/28.1 IP) in five starts, **Eduardo Vera** went 4-0 with a 1.65 ERA (6 ER/32.2 IP) in five starts, **James Marvel** went 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA (11 ER/33.0 IP), **Dario Agrazal** went 2-4 with a 5.82 ERA (22 ER/34.0 IP) in six starts and **Scotter Hightower** went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/17.2 IP). Excluding the regular-season finale, Curve starters went 15-7 with a 2.68 ERA (49 ER/164.1 IP) in 29 games from August 5-September 2.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Over his last 16 regular-season outings since July 20, closer **Matt Eckelman** had a 0.53 ERA (1 ER/17.0 IP), lowering his ERA from 4.15 to 1.82, and converted eight straight save chances since August 3. In 16 appearances since July 19, **Geoff Hartlieb** posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) and converted all four save attempts. **Logan Sendelbach** posted a 1.30 ERA (5 ER/34.2 IP) over his last 17 relief appearances since June 14.

**LEADING THE WAY:** **Bryan Reynolds** finished the season ranked fifth in the league with a .302 batting average and tied for fourth with a .381 on-base percentage. **Ke'Bryan Hayes** landed tenth with a .293 average. **Cole Tucker** led the circuit in games played (133) and stolen bases (35) while finishing fifth in hits (134) and fourth in runs scored (77). **Will Craig** led the E.L. with 102 RBIs, finished sixth with 20 homers and third with 53 extra-base hits.

**D-D-DEFENSE:** The Curve led the Eastern League with a .985 fielding percentage this season, a new franchise record, surpassing the .980 mark set in 2016 and 2017. The team committed a franchise-record low 74 errors, beating the 105 mark set over the previous two years. **Ke'Bryan Hayes** posted a .978 fielding percentage at third base, the best in the minors and the best by a third baseman in the Eastern League since at least 1959. **Will Craig** led all E.L. first basemen with a .993 fielding percentage and **Cole Tucker** led all shortstops with a .973 mark. Craig, Hayes and second baseman **Stephen Alemajis** were named as the league's top defensive players at their positions by *Baseball America* in August.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** The Curve had the youngest team in the league this season. The Altoona playoff roster includes 17 players in their first year at Double-A, six in their second and two in their third. Three players on the Curve roster (**Jin-De Jhang**, **Alfredo Reyes**, **Arden Pabst**) have Triple-A experience, totaling 13 games played. Akron's roster includes 11 players who played at Double-A or higher prior to 2017, 15 players with playing time in Triple-A in their careers and two players with MLB experience.
