**YESTERDAY:** The Curve received another sterling start from right-hander James Marvel but fell short, 3-1, against the Erie SeaWolves in the final contest of a six-game homestand. Marvel extended his scoreless streak to 20.2 innings when he began the day with six shutout innings, but Erie plated three against him in the seventh on a two-run double by Cam Gibson followed by a run-scoring two-bagger by Kade Scivicque. Bralin Jackson paced the Curve offense with two hits, including a double that led to Altoona's lone run against Erie starter Alex Faedo. Left-handed reliever Jake Brentz tossed a season-high 2.1 scoreless innings behind Marvel's starting effort.

**TODAY:** The 21st season of Altoona Curve Baseball continues as the Curve open a four-game series against the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Double-A affiliate of the Richmond Flying Squirrels. The two clubs meet for the third consecutive weekend after the Curve won two-of-three in Richmond two weeks ago before repeating those results in Altoona last weekend.

**THE CURVE:** Altoona's club has played .500 ball over the last 12 games while being outscored by one run, 44-43, over that period. Entering 2019, the Curve own the Eastern League's longest active streak for reaching the post-season while their four straight playoff appearances are tied for a franchise record (2003-06). Over that four-year period, the Curve have the best record (302-258) among Western Division teams while the only teams in the league with better records are Trenton (329-235) and Reading (305-254).

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS:** Richmond has won three of their last five after taking two-of-three games in Maryland against the Bowie Baysox to start the week. The recent run comes on the heels of a season-long, six-game losing streak from April 20-27, which started and stopped in games against the Curve. The Flying Squirrels have homered in five straight games for a total of 12 home run and are now ranked third among Eastern League clubs in that category (21). Despite the long ball success, Richmond is hitting a league-low .193 with runners in scoring position and have scored the second-fewest runs (74) on the circuit. While their pitching staff is ranked in the middle of the pack with a 3.49 team ERA, Richmond's rotation is the fourth-best unit in the league with a .304 ERA, just 0.02 points behind the Curve rotation in third.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-handed pitcher **Pedro Vasquez** will make his sixth outing of the season and his fifth start of the campaign. In his most recent start, Vasquez allowed a season-high five runs and eight hits over five innings against the Flying Squirrels. After not seeing Richmond over his first 16 Double-A outings, Vasquez is making his third straight start against the Flying Squirrels that included six scoreless, one-hit innings last Saturday at The Diamond. The right-hander from Santo Domingo was originally signed by the Mariners as an international free agent in 2015 and was traded to the Pirates organization in September 2016...*For more on Vasquez, see page two.*

**FOR RICHMOND:** After making his Giants organization debut against the Curve at PNG Field on Saturday, right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his second start for the Squirrels. He allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits over 3.2 innings and struck out four in his season debut in his last outing. Lawson signed with the Giants on April 23, 2019 as a minor league free agent after he was released by Tampa Bay, the organization that drafted him in the 12th round in 2016 out of South Florida, on March 23 of this year. Lawson pitched as high as Triple-A with the Rays in 2017 as a fill-in and split the 2018 season with A-Adv. Charlotte and Double-A Montgomery with a combined record of 6-7, 4.15 ERA and one complete-game shutout in 28 total outings.

**APRIL ALLEGORY:** The Curve finished April with a record of 12-12. The club has now finished the first month of the season .500 or better 10 times and gone on to reach the Eastern League playoffs after the last eight instances. The only Curve team that missed the postseason after a .500 or better start through April was in 2002 when the club started 12-12. One Altoona squad has reached the playoffs after a sub-.500 start, which was in 2016 after a 9-13 beginning. April is the only full month of the season in which the Curve franchise owns a losing record, currently standing at 222-238 overall.

**CURVE COMMAND:** Altoona pitchers have issued 55 walks through 25 games, the fewest free passes in all of Minor League Baseball. The starting rotation has limited their walks to 24 on the campaign, the lowest total at Double-A through 137 innings and the third-best in the minors behind starting pitchers for Dunedin (A-Adv. Blue Jays) with 19 walks in 122 innings and Hickory (Single-A Rangers) with 20 walks through 121.1 frames.

**GETTING OFFENSIVE:** The Curve offense has found it's rhythm over the last seven games with 36 runs on 65 hits, including 25 extra-base knocks, and a 18-for-67 (.269) mark with men in scoring position. Prior to the 36-run outburst, the Curve were limited to 14 runs over their previous eight games and were batting .207 (49/237), .106 (5/47) with runners in scoring position and had 10 extra-base hits over that period.

**BOUNTY HUNTER:** Third baseman **Hunter Owen** put together an eye-popping April during his first month at Double-A. He stands second in the Eastern League with seven homers while the rest of the Curve have combined for six roundtrippers. Owen's seven April home runs and 20 RBIs are each the highest April totals by a Curve player since Brad Eldred hit 10 homers and 22 RBIs to open the 2005 season. Coming off Eastern League Player of the Week for April 22-28, Owen is batting .406 (13/32) over his last eight games with six two-hit performances, four homers, eight RBIs, three doubles and one triple. His 38 homers since the beginning of the 2017 season are the most by any Pirates minor leaguer.

**BLIGH GUY:** Outfielder **Bligh Madris** has reached base in nine straight while hitting safely in seven of his last nine games with five multi-hit performances. Madris is 14-for-37 (.378) with three doubles, five RBIs and collected his first three walks of the season over his current nine-game on-base streak. The Las Vegas native is second in the league with 30 hits.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Curve roster features four of *Baseball America's* Top 30 Pirates prospects: **Jared Oliva** (No. 19), **Stephen Alemais** (No. 26), **Gage Hinsz** (No. 28) and **Dario Agrazal** (No. 29). Three of those players are also featured on MLB.com's Top 30 Pirates prospects list: Oliva (No. 12), Alemais (No. 26) and Agrazal (No. 29). Oliva was also ranked by *B.A.* as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in Pittsburgh's system.

He is in his seventh season as a manager in the Pirates organization, leading the Bradenton Marauders from 2015-16 and the West Virginia Power from 2014-15. Ryan played 15 professional seasons, including five in the majors, after he was a fifth-round draft choice by the Minnesota Twins in 1996.	Hanrahan joins the Curve in 2019 for his third season as a pitching coach in the Pittsburgh minor league system. He started his coaching career with the Bristol Pirates in 2017 and most recently oversaw pitchers for the West Virginia Power last year. Hanrahan was a two-time National League All-Star with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2011 and 2012 while he served as the team's closer. Nunnally spent the last two seasons as the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. He has served as a hitting coach in the Indians, Toronto Blue Jays and Boston Red Sox developmental systems with Eastern League stops in New Hampshire (2012, 14) and Portland (2016). As a player, Nunnally was drafted by Cleveland in the third round in 1992 and played 15 seasons. He also played six major league seasons.	Paniagua joins the Curve for his third season as a coach in the Pirates organization. He started his coaching career in 2017 with the Bristol Pirates and was the hitting coach for the Dominican Summer League affiliate last year. He played for 13 years as an international signee out of the Dominican Republic. Paniagua spent parts of six seasons as a member of the Boston Red Sox and New York Mets minor league systems that included Eastern League experience with Portland (2007) and Binghamton (2008-09). He also spent six seasons (2011-16) with the independent York Revolution and is the longest-tenured position player in franchise history.	In his eighth season as a member of the Pittsburgh organization, Ahrens returns to Altoona for a third season in 2019. In 2018, Ahrens was the trainer for the Western Division for the Eastern League All-Star Classic. He spent two years in Bradenton from 2015-16, where he was named Florida State League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2016. He spent each the last six seasons on the same staff as manager Michael Ryan. Ahrens received a bachelor's degree in athletic training from Carroll University in 2011, and a master's degree in kinesiology from Fresno Pacific University in 2016.	Schlesinger returns to the Curve for his third season, after making stops at Jamestown, West Virginia and Bradenton within the Pittsburgh system.
